AUG. 25

1992 - Shortstop Andujar Cedenó is called up from Triple A and promptly hits for the cycle in a 5-3 loss to the Cardinals in 11.0 innings. Cedenó's cycle marked the 4th time an Astro had achieved this milestone.

1972 - In 4-3 loss to the Expos, Jimmy Wynn hits his 200th career HR. Additionally, prior to the game, the Astros replace manager Harry Walker with Leo Durocher.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Yankees begin a 3-game series in the Bronx tonight...rookie **RHP Ethan Pecko** (0-0) will make his 2nd career start tonight as he takes on Yankees RHP Will Warren (8-6).

ASTROS-YANKEES: The Astros are 1-2 vs. NYY this season, with the Yankees taking 2 of 3 at Daikin Park, April 24-26...in their last visit to the Bronx, the Astros took 2 of 3 from the Yankees, Aug. 8-10 of 2025...**All-Time:** In the regular season, the Astros are 37-54 vs. NYY...**Postseason:** The Astros have won all 4 postseason series that they have played vs. the Yankees (2015, '17, '19, '22) and have a combined record of 13-5 (.722) in those games.

NY STATE OF MIND: Tonight is the 1st game of a 6-game road trip for the Astros, with all 6 games being scheduled in the Big Apple...after this 3-game series vs. the Yankees in the Bronx (Tues.-Thur.), the Astros will take on the Mets for a 3-game series at Citi Field in Queens over the weekend (Fri.-Sun)...**Last Time It Happened:** The Astros had a similar road series in NYC, June 23-29 of 2022, during which they played 4 games at Yankee Stadium (2-2) and 2 games at Citi Field (2-0), respectively.

YOUNG ETHAN: Tonight will be the 2nd ML start/app. for 24-year-old rookie **RHP Ethan Pecko**... he made his ML debut with a start vs. LAA on Aug. 19 (3.2 IP, 2 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO), ending with a no decision in a 3-2 Astros victory at Daikin Park...Pecko, who is a native of Darby, PA, combined to post a 4.57 ERA (42ER/82.2IP) with 86 strikeouts in 20 games (18 starts) in the minors this season, including 17 games at Triple A...the Astros 6th-round pick in 2023 out of Towson University (MD), Pecko has pitched in parts of four minor league seasons in the Astros system and currently ranks as the Astros No. 9 prospect per MLB.com.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY WISHES: To today's Astros starter **RHP Ethan Pecko**, who turns 24 years old today.

VERY HAPPY BIRTHDAYS!: With **RHP Ethan Pecko** turning 24 years old today, tonight will mark the 30th time that an Astros/Colt .45s hurler has started a game on his birthday...Pecko will be the 4th Astros pitcher to do so since 2019...in the previous 3 birthday starts, Astros hurlers were dominant, combining for a 3-0 record with an 0.43 ERA, allowing just 1 ER in 21.0 IP with 24 K's and just 7 hits allowed.

RECENT STROS: The Astros are 2-3 in their last 5 games and 4-6 in their last 10 games.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Among AL teams, the Astros rank 1st in SLG (.410) and 3rd in runs scored (596), HR (173) and OPS (.727).

MEASURING UP: The Astros are 32-20 (.615) vs. teams currently at .500 or above...they have winning records vs. BOS (5-1), CHC (3-0), CWS (2-1), CLE (4-2), MIA (3-0), TB (2-1), TEX (9-4).

TRIPLE THREAT: **Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently leads the AL in several categories, including all three Triple Crown categories...he enters tonight leading the AL in batting avg. (.320), HR (36) and RBI (90)... additionally, Alvarez also leads the Majors in OPS (1.050), SLG (.613), OBP (.436) and TB (284)...**Rare Feat:** Since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL).

SLOW AND STEADY RECOVERY: Since starting the season with a 20-31 record after 51 games, the Astros are 45-35 (.563) in their last 80 games (since May 22)...that is the 2nd-best record in the AL in that span, behind only the Red Sox (50-32).

ROAD WARRIORS: Since posting a 1-9 record on the 1st road trip of the 2026 season, the Astros have been one of the best road teams in the Majors...they are 31-22 (.585) on the road since April 14, which is 3rd-best in the AL in that span...more recently they are 15-10 (.600) on their last 4 road trips combined...overall for the season, HOU is 32-31 on the road.

THE HIT MAN: **Jose Altuve** enters tonight's game needing just 13 hits to reach 2,500 for his career... among active players, his 2,487 hits rank 2nd to **Freddie Freeman's** 2,576...**IN GOOD COMPANY:** In MLB history, Altuve is one of just 3 players with a .300 career batting avg. to reach both 250 HR and 300 SB...the other 2 are HOFers **Willie Mays** and **Derek Jeter**.

WALK OF FAME: **Yordan Alvarez's** ML-high 28 intentional walks this season have set the franchise single-season record, surpassing **Jeff Bagwell's** 27 intentional walks in 1997...Alvarez was intentionally walked 3 times on Sunday vs. ATH.

ONE OF THE BEST: **LHP Josh Hader** reached his 500th career app. recently, making him one of 12 active pitchers to reach that milestone...Hader has been stellar since returning from injury in June, going 4-1 with a 0.75 ERA (3ER/32IP), 43 strikeouts, a .119 opponent average (13x109) and a 0.75 WHIP, while converting all 18 of his save chances in 33 appearances.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Several of the Astros minor league clubs are having success this season:

- **Triple A Sugar Land:** In the second half, the Space Cowboys (34-17) are in 1st in the PCL East Division.
- **Class A Fayetteville:** For the second half, the Woodpeckers are in 1st place in the Carolina League North Division with a 32-20 (.600) record.
- **Rookie Level FCL Astros:** The Astros won the Florida Complex League championship, finishing with a 42-11 (.792) record in the regular season.

LAST START, AUG. 19 vs. LAA: Made his MLB debut last Wednesday, allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts through 3.2 innings of work vs. the Angels at Daikin Park...recorded his 1st career strikeout against **IF Vaughn Grissom** in the 2nd inning...was scoreless through his first 3.0 innings of the night before allowing a 2-run double to **IF Denzer Guzman** with 1 out in the 4th inning...became the 2nd Astro to make their MLB debut as a starter this season, joining **RHP Tatsuya Imai**.

BIRTHDAY BUMP DAY: Is celebrating his 24th birthday today...is the 1st Astros pitcher to make a start on their birthday since **RHP Hunter Brown** on Aug. 29, 2024, when he allowed 2 unearned runs on 2 hits with 4 strikeouts through 6.2 innings in a 6-3 win vs. KC...prior to Brown, the last Astros to make a start on their birthday was **RHP José Urquidy** on May 1, 2021 at TB...in club history, Astros starters have combined to go 11-7 with a 2.53 ERA (52ER/185IP) through 29 starts when pitching on their birthday, with the club going 18-11 in those games.

THE REPERTOIRE: Induced a 40.0% whiff rate and 2 of his 4 strikeouts with his sinker in his debut, tossing the pitch at a 30.3-percent rate, the 2nd-most of all his pitches...held opponents to an 81.0 mph average exit velocity and 0x4 mark with his 4-seam fastball in his debut, tossing the pitch at a 31.5% rate.

2026 MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: Has made 20 appearances, including 18 starts between the FCL Astros (3g) and Triple A Sugar Land (17g)...combined to record a 4.57 ERA (42ER/82.2IP) with 86 strikeouts, a 1.33 WHIP and a .259 opponent batting average.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Month for June...for the month he recorded a 2.48 ERA (8ER/29IP) with 29 strikeouts, 6 walks, a 0.93 WHIP and a .206 opponent batting average...tied for the PCL lead in innings for the month and led all qualified pitchers in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average...has also earned a few other accolades in his minor league career including, All-Spring Breakout Second Team in 2025 and the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month in May of 2024.

STELLAR START: On June 11 vs. Sacramento, he allowed 2 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings...also earned the win after the Space Cowboys defeated the River Cats, 2-0 at Constellation Field...prior to this start, he hadn't pitched more than 6.0 innings in a game in his professional career.

ABOUT PECKO: Currently ranks the Astros' No. 3 pitching prospect and the No. 9 overall prospect by MLB.com...has pitched in parts of 4 minor league seasons in the Astros organization (2023-26), recording a 4.08 ERA (124ER/273.2IP) with 323 strikeouts, a 1.28 WHIP and a .241 opponent batting average in 72 minor league appearances, including 55 starts...was named the Astros 2024 Minor League Pitcher of the Year...for the 2024 season, he went 4-6 with a 3.47 ERA (37ER/96IP) in 26 appearances, including 15 starts between Low A Fayetteville, High A Asheville and Double A Corpus Christi...he also recorded 125 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .219 opponent batting average.

COLLEGE: In 2023 at Towson, he went 2-2 with a 3.21 ERA and 48 strikeouts across 42.0 innings as the Saturday starter...transferred to Towson in 2022 after redshirting his freshman year at La Salle University due to undergoing Tommy John Surgery...was forced to transfer after La Salle discontinued their baseball program.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/22 vs. ATH): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 2 strikeouts in 1.2 scoreless innings Saturday night vs. ATH...marked his 7th multi-inning appearance of the season (last, Aug. 7 at SD).
VS. NYY: Including the postseason, he's made 18 career apps. vs. NYY, tied for his most vs. a non-AL West opponent (also MIN)...in 9 career apps. at Yankee Stadium (incl. postseason), he's posted a 1.00 ERA (1ER/9IP) with 14 strikeouts...has logged 8 consecutive scoreless apps. at Yankee Stadium (incl. postseason), dating back to May 5, 2021, and has held opponents to a .143 batting average (4x28) in that span.
ROAD WARRIOR: Has posted a 2.57 ERA (6ER/21IP) through his 24 road apps. this season compared to a 5.20 ERA (16ER/27.2IP) at home.
SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 96th percentile in whiff percentage (34.3%) among MLB players, per Baseball Savant...his 34.3 whiff percentage ranks 11th among AL relievers (min 45 IP).
SCORELESS STREAK: Recorded a 12-game scoreless streak that spanned 12.0 innings from July 18-Aug. 12...he recorded 17 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a .077 opponent batting average throughout the streak...was tied for the 4th-longest streak (by apps.) in his career and was his longest since a 12-game streak from Aug. 1-28, 2025.
A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 9.4 percent rate on the season...has held opponents to a .143 batting average (2x14) vs. his cutter this year.
TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 4-1-6 with a 2.06 ERA (9ER/39.1IP)...also has 47 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .167 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...his .167 opponent average since May 3 ranks 7th among AL relievers (min. 35 IP).
