THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JULY 3
2020 - In a year unlike any other, the Astros begin Summer Camp workouts at Daikin Park and the University of Houston...it was the first workout day for all clubs as MLB returned following nearly a three month shutdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic...it was the club's first day back on the field since Spring Training was halted on March 13.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will welcome in the top team in the AL, the Rays, for a three-game holiday weekend series at Daikin Park beginning tonight...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (7-4) will get the Friday night start for the Astros opposite the veteran **RHP Nick Martinez** (7-2) and the Rays.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** is 7-4 in his 13 starts, leading the club in wins and ranking 10th in the AL in opponent batting average (min. 70IP)...he has allowed just 56 hits in his 72.0 innings, averaging 7.00 hits per 9.0, which ranks eighth in the AL...Arrighetti had a rough June (9.00 ERA), but was the AL Pitcher of the Month for May, posting a 4-1 record with a 0.93 ERA.

TONIGHT'S SUPPLY DRIVE: The Astros Foundation will hold a supply drive tonight at the ballpark to collect items needed for victims of last week's earthquakes in Venezuela...supplies will be collected at all gates and proceeds from tonight's Share2Care 50/50 Raffle will also be raised in support of the Venezuela relief efforts.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 23-15 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

RECENT 'STROS: The Astros have won six of nine, seven of 11, and are 10-5 in their last 15 games...the Astros 16-11 record in June tied as the best in the AL, along with their rival Rangers.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: Prior to the Astros losing two of three to the Twins earlier this week, the club had won five consecutive series dating back to June 12...the last time the Astros won five straight series was from June 20-July 6 of last season.

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-5 in one-run games and 19-10 in two-run games...each of the Astros last seven wins and 12 of their last 13 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

NEYENS ADDED TO FUTURES GAME: IF Xavier Neyens has been added to the 2026 All-Star Futures Game, which will be played on July 12 in Philadelphia...Neyens, the Astros first-round selection last year, joins the club's top prospect **OF Kevin Alvarez** on the American League squad.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP: The Astros dropped the rubber game of their three-game series against the Twins on Wednesday night by a score of 8-3...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x4) had another great game, reaching base four times on the night...**RHP AJ Blubaugh** (2.2IP) and **RHP Miguel Ullola** (2IP) both made scoreless appearances out of the bullpen.

MY BOY BLU: **RHP AJ Blubaugh** worked another 2.2 scoreless innings on Wednesday vs. MIN, giving him 56.1 innings pitched on the season, which leads all Major League relievers...Blubaugh has been on a strong run since April 11, going 3-0 with a 2.06 ERA (11ER/48IP) in his last 29 appearances.

ASTROS ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have reinstated **RHP Cristian Javier** from the 60-day IL and have transferred **LHP Bennett Sousa** to the 60-day IL to make room for Javier on the 40-man roster...postgame on Wednesday, the Astros optioned **RHP Miguel Ullola** to Triple A.

ALL-STAR UPDATE: Full All-Star rosters (starters and reserves) will be announced tomorrow night beginning at 6:30 p.m. CT on FOX...**DH Yordan Alvarez** was a finalists on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot and is a strong candidate to be the AL starter at the DH position...Alvarez has been an All-Star three times in his career.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid first half to his season, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.053), OBP (.433), SLG (.620) and total bases (194)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (42), tied for first in homers (26), tied for first in hits (100), second in batting average (.319), second in RBI (60), tied for second in runs (59) and fourth in walks (59).

TAP FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 63 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (60%)...**3B Isaac Paredes** (9-for-9) has the most successful challenges in the Majors without losing one...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-21 challenges (71%), ranking second in the Majors in challenges won.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 2-0 with eight saves (in eight chances) and a 0.69 ERA (1ER/13IP) in 13 appearances this season...he has 21 strikeouts in his 13.0 innings with a .049 (2x41) opponent average and a 0.54 WHIP...Hader has not allowed a hit in six consecutive appearances (6IP since June 21).

WORKHORSE: **RHP Bryan Abreu**, now in his eighth MLB season, made his 349th career appearance on Wednesday, which moved him into fifth place in franchise history in relief appearances.

OUT ON ASSIGNMENT: The Astros have several players on minor league rehab assignments:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) started on Wednesday for Double A Corpus Christi at NW Arkansas, tossing 4.1 innings, allowing three runs on five hits with four strikeouts...he tossed 60 pitches (45 strikes) in what was his third minor league rehab start.
- **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) started on Wednesday for Triple A Sugar Land at OKC, tossing 4.0 innings of one-run ball, fanning three...he tossed 60 pitches (41 strikes) in what was his second minor league rehab start.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) began a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday for the FCL Astros, tossing 3.0 innings (0ER) on 25 pitches.
- **IF Braden Shewmake** (rt. adductor strain) had his rehab assignment transferred to Triple A on Wednesday and has started two games for the Space Cowboys, one at shortstop and one at second base.
- **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (rt. hamstring strain) began a rehab assignment at Triple A on Tuesday and has started two games so far for the Space Cowboys, one at first base and one in left field.

LAST START, JUNE 26 at DET: Surrendered 8 runs on 5 hits with 5 walks and 7 strikeouts through 3.0 innings last Friday vs. the Tigers at Comerica Park...the 8 runs marked a career high while the 5 walks matched his career high for the 4th time.

RE-HEAT THE SPAGHETTI: Was dominant to open the season, going 7-1 with a 2.21 ERA (14ER/57IP), 53 strikeouts, a .185 (37x200) opponent batting average and a 1.19 WHIP through his first 10 starts of the season...despite posting a 10.80 ERA (18ER/15IP) over his last 3 starts, he's struck out 7+ batters in each start and has struck out 7+ batters in a career-best 4 consecutive games (since June 8 at LAA)...is seeking to become the 1st Astros pitcher since **RHP Hunter Brown** to strike out 7+ batters in 5 consecutive starts (April 21-May 15, 2025).

SPAGHETTI DAY: The 3rd-year starter has gone 7-4 in 13 starts with a 4.00 ERA (32ER/72IP) in his Major League action this season, fanning 75 in 72.0 innings and allowing a .215 (56x261) opponent batting average...has allowed 1 or fewer earned runs in 7 of his 13 starts this season...leads Astros pitchers in wins (7), which also ties his career-high (also, 2024).

50/50: Is making his 50th career appearance tonight and currently has 277 career strikeouts while averaging 9.9 SO/9...he currently ranks 4th in strikeouts among Astros pitchers within their first 50 career apps., trailing **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (332), **RHP Bud Norris** (291) and **RHP Roy Oswalt** (278).

ON THE LEADERBOARDS: Despite making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks T-7th in the AL in wins (7)...among AL pitchers with 65+ innings pitched, Arrighetti ranks 9th in opponent batting average (.215).

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 98th percentile among MLB pitchers this season with 7.4 feet of extension...also ranks in the 88th percentile in hard-hit percentage (31.2).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Has thrown his curveball at a 33.6-percent rate this season, which would mark a career-high usage of the pitch...has held opponents to a .156 batting average with his curveball, ranking 2nd among AL pitchers (min. 50 batters faced)...tossed 41 curveballs in each of his starts on June 20 at CLE and June 3 vs. PIT, which are both tied for the 3rd-most curveballs tossed in a single game by an MLB pitcher this season.

VS. TB: Set to make his 2nd career start vs. the Rays...struck out 12 batters through 6.0 innings while allowing 1 run on 5 hits on Aug. 4 vs. TB, but was still saddled with the losing decision in a 1-0 Astros loss...the 12 strikeouts are his 2nd most in a single game, behind only 13 strikeouts on Aug. 10, 2024 at BOS.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named American League Pitcher of the Month for May...marked the first Pitcher of the Month Award and second monthly award overall for Arrighetti...was also named AL Rookie of the Month for August of 2024...was outstanding in the month of May, posting a 4-1 record in his 5 starts with an 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent batting average...led the AL in ERA and opponent batting average and was tied for first in wins...allowed just three earned runs in his five May starts, allowing one or no earned runs in all five starts...is the first Astros hurler to earn Pitcher of the Month honors since **RHP Hunter Brown** won the award for June of 2025...is also the Astros second monthly award winner in 2026 as **Yordan Alvarez** was named AL Player of the Month for March/April of this season.

A START FOR THE BOOKS: Made the best start of his career on May 15 vs. TEX at Daikin Park, where he allowed 1 hit and 4 walks with 5 strikeouts in 7.1 scoreless innings...also carried a no-hit bid through 7.1 innings prior to allowing a single...was Arrighetti's longest career no-hit bid and his longest since tossing 7.0 no-hit innings on Aug. 28, 2024 at PHI.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/1 vs. MIN): Worked the final 2.0 innings Wednesday night vs. MIN and struck out 3 batters while allowing 1 run on 1 hit (solo HR by **IF Luke Keaschall**)...tossed a season-high 34 pitches (24 strikes) and matched his season high of 2.0 innings for the 2nd time (also, May 3 at BOS)...were his most pitches since tossing 44 pitches on Sept. 27, 2023 at SEA.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Made his 349th career appearance on Wednesday vs. MIN, surpassing **LHP Joe Sambito** for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros franchise history...now trails **RHP Brad Lidge** (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (485) and 10th in innings pitched (358.2).
