**BIRDLAND BITES:** Baltimore continues a seven-game road trip in Cleveland (0-2, 2 to play) this week after a series loss over the weekend at Tampa Bay (1-2)...The O's have lost six of the last seven games since July 12 after winning six of seven from July 4-11 and have fallen 14.5 games behind the Blue Jays in the AL East and 8.5 games back of a Wild Card spot.

- ⚾ The Orioles have allowed a run (4 total R) in the first inning of both games in this series and have surrendered 69 runs in the opening frame this year, second most in the AL behind the Red Sox (72 R).
- ⚾ **Ramón Urías** played in his 500<sup>th</sup> career game, all with the Birds, last night.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The O's reinstated right-handed pitcher **Zach Eflin** (low back discomfort) from the 15-day Injured List, optioned righty **Brandon Young** to Triple-A Norfolk, and transferred catcher **Maverick Handley** (right wrist sprain) to the 10-day Injured List today.

- ⚾ Eflin has not pitched in an MLB game since June 28 vs. Tampa Bay (1.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R).

**SOUTHPAW SPEAK:** The Orioles have posted a .617 OPS against left-handed pitching, second lowest in the majors this year ahead of the Pirates (.609)...That number drops to .605 against left-handed starting pitchers, second lowest in MLB ahead of the Rangers (.585)...Baltimore's .729 OPS against righties ranks 15<sup>th</sup> in the majors.

- ⚾ Since June 11, Baltimore is slashing .256/.320/.397 off left-handed pitching...The O's .717 OPS ranks 16<sup>th</sup> in MLB during that time...The Birds entered that stretch with an MLB-low .555 OPS off southpaws, 40 points lower than the Guardians (.595 OPS).

**RUN AND GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** is batting .309/.384/.487 (47-for-152) with 11 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 22 runs scored, and 20 RBI in 43 games since June 1...During that time, he ranks among AL leaders in batting average (T-6<sup>th</sup>) and on-base percentage (9<sup>th</sup>).

- ⚾ In his first 50 games through May, Henderson hit .254/.315/.433 (51-for-201) with 20 extra-base hits (11 2B, 2 3B, 7 HR).
- ⚾ In 21 career games vs. Cleveland, he is batting .342/.416/.620 (27-for-79) with seven doubles, five home runs, and 15 RBI...His .342 average is the third highest against the Guardians among all active MLB players (min. 75 PA) behind DET's Andy Ibáñez (.363 AVG) and WSH's Nathaniel Lowe (.346 AVG).

**THE RAMÓN EMPIRE:** In 43 games since May 14, **Ramón Laureano** is slashing .314/.376/.535 (50-for-159) with 11 doubles, eight home runs, 28 runs scored, and 33 RBI...His .314 average during that period ranks sixth in the AL (min. 150 PA).

- ⚾ He has homered in consecutive games for the first time since September 19-20, 2024...Laureano has hit a home run in three straight games two times: May 1-3, 2021 and July 6-12, 2019...This is the 14<sup>th</sup> time this season that the Orioles have had a player go deep in consecutive games, last accomplished by **Jackson Holliday** from July 6-8...**Colton Cowser** is only Oriole to do so in three straight in 2025 (6/17-19).
- ⚾ He recorded a season-high four RBI on Monday, his most since August 4, 2022 at Los Angeles-AL (also 4 RBI)...It marked his sixth career game with 4+ RBI.
- ⚾ Eleven of his 15 career hits against Cleveland have gone for extra bases (5 2B, 6 HR).

**ACTION JACKSON:** **Jackson Holliday** has hit safely in seven of eight career games vs. the Guardians, including an active seven-game stretch, slashing .423/.483/.692 (11-for-26) in that span...He's a career .252/.323/.406 (36-for-143) hitter against the AL Central, all his best numbers against the three AL divisions.

- ⚾ Holliday ranks third in the AL since May 14 with 67 hits, trailing TB's Yandy Díaz (74 H) and NYY's Cody Bellinger (70 H).
- ⚾ His leadoff home run on Sunday at Tampa Bay was his second career game-opening blast (also 5/31 vs. CWS).

**MOUNTAIN TIME:** **Félix Bautista** has made 17 appearances since May 31, going 1-0 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP), an .073 (4-for-55) opponent average, a 0.88 WHIP, and a 44.0 percent strikeout rate (29 K/66 BF).

- ⚾ He has converted each of his last 12 save opportunities since May 26, the third-longest active run behind PIT's David Bednar (15 G) and CHC's Daniel Palencia (13 G).

**MILESTONE WATCH:** **Cedric Mullins** is one home run shy of 100 for his career...With his next long ball, he would become the third player in team history (since 1954) to hit 100+ home runs and steal 100+ bases (currently at 138 SB), joining **Brady Anderson** (209 HR, 307 SB) and **Paul Blair** (126 HR, 167 SB).

**FIREMEN:** Baltimore relievers own an MLB-best 20.3 percent inherited scored rate (30 IRS/148 IR), ahead of Los Angeles-NL (25.5%)...**Keegan Akin** (4.2%, 1 IRS/24 IR) and **Seranthony Domínguez** (5.0%, 1 IRS/20 IR) have the two best inherited runners scored percentage in the majors.

- ⚾ Both Akin's and Domínguez's marks would set the single season franchise record (since 1954), currently held by **Mark Thurmond** (10.5%, 1988)...Since 1974, only five relievers have finished a full season with an inherited scored rate below 5.0 percent during the year (excluding 2020, 1981, 1995, & 1994): SF's Josh Osich in 2016 (4.7%), HOU's Wilton Lopez in 2010 (3.0%), and AZ's Jorge De La Rosa in 2017 (3.0%).
- ⚾ As a club, the 20.3 percent mark would be the lowest in a full-season in franchise history, ahead of 2014 (24.8%).

**BIRDS ON THE FLY:** The O's have swiped 18 bags since June 27, fourth most in the AL during that period, while going 18-for-24...Since May 19, the Orioles have swiped 49 bases, fifth most in MLB.

- ⚾ The Orioles are one of five teams to have at least three players with 13+ SB (Mullins - 14 SB, Mateo - 14 SB, Henderson - 13 SB), along with the Brewers (4 players), Red Sox (4 players), Cubs (3 players), and Rays (3 players).

**TROUBLE WITH TWO:** Baltimore pitching has allowed a .191 opponent average with two strikes, the second-highest clip in the majors ahead of Colorado (.213 AVG).

- ⚾ The O's have permitted a .271 batting average with two outs, the third-highest mark in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.283 AVG) and Athletics (.277 AVG).
- ⚾ Birds batters are hitting .154 with two strikes, ranking 26<sup>th</sup> in the majors, while their .217 two-out average ranks 27<sup>th</sup> in MLB.

**DAY 'N' NITE:** Entering this season, the O's have won or split three straight road series in Cleveland, their longest such run since doing so in five consecutive series at Cleveland Stadium from September 15, 1981-August 2, 1983.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

July 23, 1971 - Pat Dobson, in his first year with the Orioles after being acquired from San Diego in the offseason, notches his 10<sup>th</sup> straight win and seventh consecutive complete game in a 4-3 walk-off win over the Angels. Dobson goes on to win 20 games for the only time in his career, one of four Orioles hurlers (also Cuellar, McNally, & Palmer) to reach that mark in '71.

July 23, 1976 - Reggie Jackson ties the AL record by homering in his sixth consecutive game, but the Orioles lose to the Brewers, 4-3, in 13 innings at Memorial Stadium. New York-AL's Don Mattingly would set the record by doing so in eight straight games in 1987 and later matched by Seattle's Ken Griffey Jr. in 1993.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his 13<sup>th</sup> start of the season...Activated from the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) prior to tonight's game...Marked his second stint on the 15-day IL this season (right lat strain; 4/9-5/11, retroactive to 4/8)...Acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26, 2024.

**LAST TIME OUT (MLB):** On June 28 vs. Tampa Bay, exited after 1.0 inning due to lower back tightness...He suffered the loss, permitting four runs on five hits (1 HR) with zero walks and zero strikeouts...Threw 28 pitches, 18 strikes.  
⚡ The 1.0-inning start marked the shortest of his career, with his previous low coming on June 19, 2022 at Washington (L, 2.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 0 BB, 2 K).  
⚡ Has lost each of his last three starts (17.00 ERA; 17 ER/9.0 IP) after winning each of his previous three outings (1.83 ERA; 4 ER/19.2 IP).

**LAST TIME OUT (MiLB):** Made his second rehab appearance on July 18 (G1) at the FCL Pirates and tossed 4.0 innings, allowing five unearned runs on three hits and one walk with five strikeouts...Threw 68 pitches, 40 strikes.  
⚡ In his first rehab appearance with Double-A Chesapeake on July 13, suffered the loss after throwing 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) and one walk with two strikeouts...Threw 58 pitches, 38 strikes.

**CLEVELAND CLIFFNOTES:** Eflin has made two career starts against the Guardians, going 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA (8 ER/9.1 IP)...Made his lone career start at Progressive Field on August 3, 2024, and earned the win after tossing 6.1 innings of two-run ball, scattering five hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts.  
⚡ In four starts against AL Central opponents since the aforementioned August 3, 2024, start at Cleveland, Eflin is 3-1 with a 1.35 ERA (4 ER/26.2 IP), including 2-0 with an 0.66 ERA (1 ER/13.2 IP) in two outings this year (5/30 vs. CWS & 6/11 vs. DET).

**MAKE 'EM EARN IN:** Eflin has walked 11 batters across 62.0 innings, producing a 4.09 percent walk rate, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB (min. 60.0 IP) behind DET's Tarik Skubal (3.32%), TB's Zack Littell (3.49%), and TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (4.02%).

**HOMER UNHAPPY:** Eflin has allowed 16 HR across 62.0 innings this season, recording a career-high 2.32 home runs per 9.0 innings...The 2.32 mark is the second-highest in MLB (min. 60.0 IP), ahead of TOR's Bowden Francis (2.67 HR/9.0 IP).

**CHANGE OF PACE:** His most effective offering this season has been the changeup, his third-most utilized pitch at a 16.2 percent clip...Eflin has held opponents to a .192 (10-for-52) average.  
⚡ Opponents have found the most success on Eflin's sweeper and curveball combination, thrown at 15.2 and 15.1 percent, respectively, and are slashing a combined .409/.429/.818 (27-for-66).

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** Left-handed hitters are slashing .347/.368/.714 (51-for-147) with 12 doubles and 14 home runs off Eflin...Over his last five starts, they are hitting .484 (31-for-64) with six doubles and seven homers after batting .241 (20-for-83) with six doubles and seven homers over his first seven starts.  
⚡ His .347 opponent average against lefties is third highest in the majors (min. 140 BF), ahead of WSH's Trevor Williams (.386 AVG) and COL's Antonio Senzatela (.359 AVG).

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** On the first pitch of an at-bat, batters are slashing .486/.474/1.000 (18-for-37) with four doubles, five home runs, and 15 RBI off Eflin this season...His opponent OPS of 1.474 off the first pitch is second highest in the majors (min. 30 BF) ahead of BOS' Hunter Dobbins (1.576 OPS).  
⚡ In 2024, opponents slashed .420/.416/.659 with six doubles, five homers, and 17 RBI off the first pitch of the at-bat.

**SLOW STARTS:** In frames one and two, Eflin owns an 8.22 ERA (21 ER/23.0 IP) with opponents slashing .347/.365/.772 (35-for-101) and 12 home runs...The 12 long balls are the most allowed by any MLB pitcher in innings one and two, ahead of LAA's Tyler Anderson (11 HR).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP CHARLIE MORTON (5-8, 5.58)

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss on July 18 at Tampa Bay after working 5.1 innings, allowing a season-high-tying seven runs (also 4/20 vs. CIN) on a season-high eight hits (2 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts...Marked his most hits allowed since August 24, 2024 vs. Washington (also 8 H).

**vs. CLEVELAND:** Set to make his ninth career start opposite the Guardians, having gone 4-3 with a 3.21 ERA (17 ER/47.2 IP)...Faced Cleveland earlier this year on April 15 in Baltimore and took the loss, permitting five runs on seven hits (1 HR) and three walks with two strikeouts across 5.0 innings.
