THE TWINS: Have gone 0-2 to begin their seven-game, eight-day homestand, losing consecutive games to the Tigers on Thursday and Friday nights...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the third of four against the Tigers and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.
 ☞ Twins are 32-27 at home this season...Twins have just 22 home games remaining.

MOTOWN SHUT DOWN: The Twins were shut out the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 7-0...Pierson Ohl (0-3) was the opener, allowing seven runs (3 earned) on eight hits in 2.1 innings pitched, with two walks and one strikeout...José Ureña pitched 5.2 scoreless innings of relief, with four hits, with one walk and three strikeouts, while throwing 76 pitches...the offense recorded just two hits, a Brooks Lee second-inning double and a Luke Keaschall sixth-inning infield single...Keaschall reached three times, also drawing two walks.

OUTMAN IS THE IN MAN: The Twins have placed outfielder Alan Roden on the 10-day Injured List with a left thumb sprain...Roden, who was acquired from Toronto at the trade deadline, played in 12 games for the Twins, hitting .158 (6-for-38) with one double, one home run, one RBI, one stolen base and five runs scored...to replace Roden on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder James Outman from Triple-A St. Paul...Outman, 28, was acquired from Los Angeles-NL at the trade deadline and played in 12 games for the Saints, hitting .235 (12-for-51) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, three stolen bases, nine runs scored and an .806 OPS...the Redwood City, California native was selected by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2018 Draft out of Sacramento State and has played in parts of four major league seasons with Los Angeles (2022-25), hitting .224 (150-for-671) with 23 doubles, three triples, 30 home runs, 88 RBI, 90 walks, 18 stolen bases, 112 runs scored and a .730 OPS in 230 games.
 ☞ Outman homered in three-straight games against the Twins from May 17, 2023-April 9, 2024, including a go-ahead grand slam at Dodger Stadium on May 17, 2023, off Emilio Pagan.

EYE OF THE TIGER: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 13 games this season...Twins are 4-7 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...this series marks the final meeting between these two in 2025.
 ☞ With the defeat last night, the Twins lost the season-series vs. Detroit...first time since 2023 (5-8).
 ☞ Byron Buxton has a .987 OPS and a .648 slugging percentage in his last 14 games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and five home runs in 59 plate appearances...Buck has homered four times against the Tigers this season: April 11 off Beau Brieske, April 13 off Casey Mize, June 27 off Sawyer Gipson-Long and June 28 off Casey Mize.
 ☞ Over their last four games against the Tigers, the Twins bullpen has posted a 0.79 ERA (22.2 IP, 2 ER) with just four walks, 14 strikeouts and a .162 opponent batting average...they enter tonight having not allowed an earned run in their last 20.0 innings vs. the Tigers.

TURN KEA TO START: In 17 games to start his career, Luke Keaschall has reached base safely 29 times, with 20 hits, seven walks and two hit-by-pitch (69 plate appearances)...below is a list of Twins with the most times on base through the first 17 games of their career:

CONTACTUAL AGREEMENTS: Over their last 11 games, since August 4, the Twins have struck out 82 times in 409 plate appearances...since that date, they have posted a 20.0 strikeout percentage, fifth-lowest in the AL and ninth-lowest in baseball, trailing San Diego (15.2%), Milwaukee (17.9%), Kansas City (18.1%), Miami (19.0%), Toronto (19.1%), Houston (19.5%), Boston (20.0%) and Chicago-NL (20.0%).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need to win tonight and tomorrow to avoid losing their second-straight series and their 22nd of the season...Minnesota is 16-21-2 in series play, going 10-7-2 at home and 6-14-0 on the road.
 ☞ The Twins last series loss at home was July 28-30 vs. Boston, dropping two of three.
 ☞ Twins are 1-2-0 against the Tigers in series play this season.

GARDY PARTY: Last night, Toby Gardenhire earned his 500th career managerial victory with a 10-2 win in Omaha...Toby won 77 games in 2018 with Single-A Cedar Rapids, 74 in 2019 with High-A Fort Myers, and has now won 349 games for the Saints.

SWR REHAB: Simeon Woods Richardson (illness) made his first start on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul last night in Omaha, pitching 2.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and four strikeouts, while throwing 34 pitches...SWR has missed the club's last 10 games.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1965: Tonight, the Twins are celebrating the 60th anniversary of Minnesota's first pennant winners...in a ceremony prior to the game, the 1965 American League Champion Twins will be honored; the club won Minnesota's first AL title before falling to the Los Angeles Dodgers in an epic seven-game World Series...led by National Baseball and Twins Hall of Famer's Harmon Killebrew, Tony Oliva and Jim Kaat; Twins Hall of Famer's Bob Allison, Earl Battey, Zoilo Versalles, Jim Perry and Camilo Pascual; and the legendary Jim "Mudcat" Grant, the 1965 Twins went 102-60, setting the Minnesota record for most wins in a season.

TWINS HALL OF F-EH?-M DAY: In a special pregame ceremony tomorrow, Corey Koskie will be inducted as the 41st member of the Twins Hall of Fame...Koskie was a key part of the Twins' back-to-back-to-back American League Central Division championship clubs from 2002-04, one of just six players in the Minnesota era with at least 100 RBI and 100 runs scored in the same season (103 RBI and 100 runs in 2001), and Minnesota's all-time leader for career batting average (.280) and fielding percentage (.966) by a third baseman (minimum 425 games).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1975, the Twins set a major league mark with nine batters recording two-or-more hits in a 9-1, nine-inning victory over Cleveland...in 1990, Kirby Puckett started off in rightfield and moved to shortstop, third base and second base all in the second inning.

- ⚡ Matthews' lone start against Detroit came on August 5 where he earned the win in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

IN THE BRONX: Last pitched on August 11 at New York-AL, opposite Will Warren, where he was dealt his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 3-4 defeat...allowed three runs on six hits (career-high-tying three home runs), with one walk and a career-high-tying nine strikeouts in 5.2 innings...all three runs allowed were solo home runs...one from Cody Bellinger in the first, followed by back-to-back home runs from Giancarlo Stanton and Ben Rice in the third...the hit from Rice also marked Zebby's 100th career hit allowed...recorded a career-high 99 pitches.

⚡ Fanned Giancarlo Stanton in the sixth, marking his 100th career strikeout...is the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 100 strikeouts in his first 18 career games.

TIGER KING: Pitched on August 5 at Detroit, opposite former Twin Chris Paddock, and earned his third win of the season and fourth of his career in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...sole run allowed came on a Kerry Carpenter RBI double in the third inning.

⚡ Has recorded four-or-more strikeouts in each of his last 15 starts...is one of 11 pitchers to have an active streak of four-plus strikeouts in their last 15-plus starts.

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 100 strikeouts through his first 18 career major league games, the most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 17 games:

⚡ Matthews' 57 strikeouts so far in 2025 are the second most by a Twins pitcher in their first nine starts this season, behind Joe Ryan (63).

MOTOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews is facing the Tigers for the second time in his career...faced Detroit for the first time on August 5 at Comerica Park...allowed one run on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts...in five starts against division opponents (Kansas City x3, Cleveland x1, Detroit x1), Matthews has gone 2-1, posting a 3.80 ERA (23.2 IP, 10 ER) with four walks, 29 strikeouts and a .293 (29-for-99) opponent batting average.

TWO-OUT TRAFFIC: Here are Matthews' career opponent batting numbers with zero, one and two outs:

⚡ With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have gone 9-for-38 (.237) with two doubles, one home run, four walks, 14 RBI and 12 strikeouts.

⚡ All six of Matthews' hits allowed during his last start against the Yankees came with two outs.

HOME SWEET HOME: Zebby has gone 2-3 with a 7.44 ERA (32.2 IP, 27 ER), six walks, 47 strikeouts and a .322 (46-for-143) opponent batting average in eight career major league starts at home, compared to 2-5, 4.78 ERA (49.0 IP, 26 ER) with 16 walks, 53 strikeouts and a .273 (54-for-198) opponent batting average in 10 career major league starts on the road.

⚡ In three major league starts at home this season, Matthews has gone 1-1, posting a 4.40 ERA (14.1 IP, 7 ER) with one walk, 20 strikeouts and a .263 (15-for-57) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first nine major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .267/.309/.444 in 90 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .287/.326/.448 in 87 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph and a whiff rate of 31.0 compared to righties' 90.4 mph and 27.3 percent.

⚡ His hard-hit rate against lefties is 39.0 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties is 41.3 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup and cutter against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:

⚡ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sliders, Zebby ranks second in strikeout percentage at 52.2 percent and has the 21st lowest opponent batting average (.143).

⚡ Holds the highest average fastball velocity among all Twins starters this season at 96.5 mph... followed by José Ureña (96.3), Pablo López (94.4) and David Festa (94.1).

⚡ His 11.66 SO/9 leads Twins starters...followed by Joe Ryan (9.91), Pablo López (9.05), David Festa (8.94) and Simeon Woods Richardson (7.70).

⚡ Added a sinker to his pitch arsenal in his start against Detroit on August 5.
