**BIRDLAND BITES:** Today, Baltimore continues a nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles-NL (1-1, 1 to play), and Los Angeles-AL (3 G)...The Birds are coming off a seven-game homestand, splitting a four-game set with the Mariners before dropping two of three to the Padres...The O's enter play today 2.5 games back in the Wild Card and 11.5 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

👉 **Trevor Rogers** earned the victory after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering one hit and two walks with six strikeouts...He became the first Oriole to throw 7.0+ scoreless innings on one or zero hits since **Brandon Young** on August 15, 2025 at Houston (W, 8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 6 K)...Rogers became the first pitcher in MLB to accomplish the feat against the Dodgers since Max Scherzer did so with the Mets on July 16, 2023 at Citi Field (7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 6 K)...Prior to Rogers, the last pitcher in the majors to do so against the Dodgers at UNIQLQ Field at Dodger Stadium was AZ's Zac Gallen on September 2, 2020 (7.0 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 7 K).

👉 Prior to yesterday's victory, the Birds had lost 13 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer...Their last such win came on May 11 vs. New York-AL (also 3-2).

**YOUNG MONEY:** **Brandon Young** has made five straight quality starts since May 24 (G1), going 2-1 with a 2.20 ERA (8 ER/32.2 IP)...He is the first Oriole to make five straight quality starts since **Trevor Rogers'** 10-outing stretch from July 6-August 30, 2025.

👉 He has limited the opposition to a .134 (11-for-82) clip on his four-seam fastball this season...The .134 average off the offering is the lowest mark in MLB (min. 80 AB ending in pitch) ahead of BOS' Payton Tolle (.149, 15-for-101).

**INSIDE THE MATCHUP:** Since May 1, **Blaze Alexander** is batting .414 (12-for-29) with three doubles, one triple, and one home run off four-seam fastballs, while **Pete Alonso** is 13-for-45 (.289) with one double and eight home runs off such offerings.

👉 Of his four pitch mix, opponents have had the most success off Emmet Sheehan's four-seam fastball, hitting .274 (23-for-84) with six doubles and nine home runs.

👉 Thirteen of Alonso's 17 long balls have come off fastballs this season, nine of which have been off four-seamers...He has three homers off sinkers and one off a cutter.

**START ME UP:** Through five games of the current nine-game road trip, Baltimore starters have posted a 2.76 ERA (10 ER/32.2 IP) and a .190 (22-for-116) opponent average.

👉 Prior to this period, O's starters owned a 5.56 ERA (99 ER/160.1 IP) and .284 (178-for-626) opponent average across 32 road games.

**NOT SO DODGER BLUE:** The Orioles have scored multiple runs in 22 straight games against the Dodgers, their second-longest active streak against a single opponent, trailing the Guardians (24)...It marks the longest active streak by any MLB team against Los Angeles-NL.

**WALKING IT OUT:** Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 69 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind St. Louis (74).

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

👉 Baltimore is 28-25 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 8-17 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

**HOLLYWOOD PETE:** **Pete Alonso** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games against the Dodgers since April 21, 2024, batting .304 (14-for-46) with one double, five home runs, seven runs, 13 RBI, three walks, and three hit-by-pitches.

👉 In 24 career games at UNIQLQ Field at Dodger Stadium, Alonso is slashing .320/.364/.710 (32-for-100) with four doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 17 runs, and five hit by pitches...His career 1.074 OPS at the venue, which opened in 1962, is the fourth highest by any player in MLB history (min. 100 PA), trailing HOU's Christian Walker (1.197), NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (1.086), and DET's Al Kaline (1.082).

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .379/.420/.544 (39-for-103) with nine doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 runs, 20 RBI, six walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 40 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1<sup>st</sup>), on-base percentage (5<sup>th</sup>), and OPS (6<sup>th</sup>, .963).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 63), times on base (4<sup>th</sup>, 138), and on-base percentage (10<sup>th</sup>, .390)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 The only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

👉 Ward recorded 63 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the Orioles...The only other player to have at least 60 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) was Ken Singleton (64 BB, 81 H).

👉 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

**TROUBLE WITH THE 2'S:** Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to slash .261/.352/.411 with two outs...The batting average is second highest in MLB ahead of the Rangers (.262)...The on-base percentage is third highest in MLB ahead of the Angels (.363) and Reds (.353)...Their .769 OPS is fourth highest in the majors ahead of the Royals (.781), Rangers (.766), and Reds (.765).

👉 Baltimore hurlers own a .554 opponent OPS with two strikes, the fourth-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.606), the Athletics (.568), and Washington (.556).

👉 Orioles hitters own a .153 batting average with two strikes, tied for the lowest clip in the majors along with the Mets and Tigers.

**RISPY BUISNESS:** Over its last 13 games since June 6, Baltimore owns a .178 (16-for-90) RISP average, the second-lowest mark in MLB during that time ahead of Arizona (.159, 17-for-107).

**QUICK HITS:** Young is set to make his 12<sup>th</sup> start of the season and the 24<sup>th</sup> of his career today in the series finale at Los Angeles-NL...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston... Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his second loss of the season on June 16 at Seattle after allowing three runs on four hits and a season-high four walks across 6.0 innings pitched with two strikeouts...Snapped a seven-game stretch dating back to May 6 in which the O's went 7-0 in Young's starts...Threw 92 pitches, 52 strikes.

📌 Has recorded a quality start in a career-high five consecutive games since May 24 (G1), the second-longest active streak in the majors this season behind MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (8).

**CALIFORNICATION:** Young is scheduled to make his first career start against the Dodgers and his first opposite the NL West, the only division he's never faced...Is 1-1 with a 5.46 ERA (17 ER/28.0 IP) over six career Interleague starts, including 1-0 with a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) across three such outings on the road.

**TO THE LEFT:** Over his last five starts since May 24, Young is holding left-handed batters to a .169 (11-for-65) clip with two doubles and one home run...During that stretch, his .169 opponent average vs. lefties is the fourth-lowest mark (min. 60 AB) in the majors behind MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (.109), DET's Troy Melton (.153), and CWS' Sean Burke (.156).

📌 Young uses his four-seam fastball 45.4 percent of the time against lefties, who are batting 8-for-64 (.125) with one double and two home runs on the offering.

**VELO UPTICK:** Young's average fastball has climbed to 93.9 mph in 2026, up 1.4 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.4 mph increase is the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season, trailing LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.1 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.9 mph), ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph), and CWS' Sean Newcomb (+1.6 mph).

📌 He has limited the opposition to a .134 (11-for-82) clip on his four-seam fastball this season...The .134 average off the offering is the lowest mark in MLB (min. 80 AB ending in pitch) ahead of BOS' Payton Tolle (.149, 15-for-101).

**THEM CHANGES:** Young is averaging 82.9 mph and 1,333 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last five starts since May 24, during which opponents are hitting .129 (4-for-31) with no extra-base hits on the pitch...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.

📌 Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 21.0 percent this season, marking a 3.2 percent increase in usage.

📌 Young used his curveball 7.6 percent of the time in his last start on June 16 at Seattle, his lowest usage rate on the pitch since April 30 (4.9%).

**SWEET VICTORY:** Baltimore is 9-2 (.818) in games started by Brandon Young this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...That included a seven-game winning streak by the Orioles from May 6-June 10, over which Young went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.

**CLEAN SHEET:** On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7<sup>th</sup> inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6<sup>th</sup> inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9<sup>th</sup> inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2<sup>nd</sup> inn.).

**HOMECOMING:** On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts... He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

📌 Young became the first Orioles rookie to throw 8.0 scoreless innings and allow one or zero hits since Chris Waters on August 5, 2008 at Los Angeles-AL (8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K).

📌 The victory snapped a streak of 10 starts without a win to begin his career, marking the second-longest winless streak to begin a career in franchise history (since 1954), trailing Jimmy Yacabonis (11 GS, 6/28/18-8/4/19).
