Hitting

Despite falling last night, 5-4, nine different Braves batters recorded a hit. When receiving a hit from at least nine batters this season, the club is now 5-1.

The team last dropped such a game over a year ago, when they lost to Arizona on June 5, 2025. Ten different Atlanta hitters recorded a knock in that contest.

The Braves got a hit from nine different players, but none of them registered multi-hit games. That occurred for the first time since May 25, 2024, versus Pittsburgh.

STORIED SERIES: Atlanta and New York today conclude a three-game series at Yankee Stadium... Dating to the 1990 season, a span of over 35 years, the Yankees and Braves are the two winningest franchises in Major League Baseball.

 New York's 3,297-2,479 (.571) record is best in the majors, while Atlanta's 3,223-2,554 (.558) mark ranks second...They are the only two teams in baseball with over 3,200 wins in that span.

 The two have combined for 6,520 wins, 37 division titles, 14 pennants and seven World Series championships since 1990.

 The Braves and Yankees have met four times in the World Series, with Atlanta going 1-3 in these sets...The Milwaukee Braves won the title in 1957, before the Yankees won in 1958, 1996 and 1999.

 Atlanta (70-47, .598) enters play today tied for the third-best record in baseball, while New York (66-51, .564) sits sixth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Yankees today conclude a three-game weekend series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the teams this season...The two are playing at Yankee Stadium for the first time since the 2024 season.

 Atlanta is just 22-31 (.415) all-time against New York since the advent of interleague play in 1997, its worst record against any exclusively AL team in that span.

 Entering this series, Atlanta held a winning record here in the Bronx at 14-13 (.500)...The Braves last played here in 2024 and took two-of-three... Including this set, Atlanta is 5-4-2 in 11 total series here.

 RH Cam Schlitler, who enters play with a 10-6 record and a 2.26 ERA, is set to make his first career start against Atlanta...In five prior starts against National League East clubs, the 6-foot-6, 185-pounder has gone 3-1 with a 1.42 ERA – his best mark against any single division.

GRANT HOLMES: Has twice faced the Yankees, once as a starter and once in relief...All-time, he's 0-1 against the club with a 3.86 ERA (3 ER/7.0 IP)...In his previous turn against New York, on July 20, 2025, at Truist Park, he contributed a Quality Start after 6.0 innings pitched and three earned runs.

 Holmes has not allowed more than three earned runs in 14 consecutive starts...It's tied for the third-longest streak in MLB this season behind Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (21 games, active) and teammate Chris Sale (18 games, active).

 Atlanta is 15-6 (.714) in Holmes' starts this season, and has won each of the last six since July 3.

 Holmes has recorded 61 strikeouts with his slider this season, tied for the seventh most in MLB.

PITCHING: Braves starting pitchers have allowed three runs or fewer in 17 consecutive games, the third-longest streak in Major League Baseball this season behind Tampa Bay (22 games) and Milwaukee (18 games)...Atlanta's streak is the longest active in the majors...The club hasn't posted such a streak since August 11–September 6, 2024, when it did so across 25 games.

 Atlanta's pitching staff conceded a home run to New York's Spencer Jones in yesterday's seventh inning...It marked the first longball surrendered by Braves pitching since the ninth inning on July 31 versus Washington, a span of 61 innings and six games.

 By innings, it was the longest such streak since the Braves pitched homerless across 65 innings from September 8-14, 2011...Only four teams in the majors have posted longer streaks this season.

 Atlanta's two home runs allowed this month are half as many as the next-closest teams...Cincinnati, San Francisco and Minnesota have each conceded four homers this month...For reference, the Los Angeles Dodgers lead MLB with 16 home runs allowed in August.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Yesterday went 1-for-4 and belted his fifth home run in a nine-game span, doing so across 37 at-bats since July 30...Since that date, Acuña Jr. is tied with teammate Matt Olson for the most home runs in MLB.

 His 7.40 at-bats-per-home run ratio in that time ranks third in MLB behind Boston's Wilner Abreu (6.00) and Olson (6.60)...The outfielder has posted a barrel percentage of 34.5%, the eighth-best in MLB in that span.

 Since returning from the injured list on July 27 at New York-NL, Acuña Jr. has a home run in four of his 12 games, and a hit in 9-of-12 games.

THE SERIES: The Braves have dropped this series to the Yankees, signifying the club's second series loss in a four-series span...Regardless, Atlanta's 25 series wins are tied for the most in Major League Baseball entering play...Milwaukee has also taken 25 sets.

 Since July 17, Atlanta is 5-2-0 in series play...Both of the series losses have taken place here in the Empire State...The Braves fell to the Mets, two games-to-one, from July 27-29 at Citi Field before losing this set.

 The club is 1-4 (.200) against New York teams dating to July 17, but 14-3 (.824) outside of this state since then.

 The Braves maintain the best post-break winning percentage (15-7, .682) in the National League... The Boston Red Sox are the only team with a better record in MLB in that span (18-4, .818).
