**RAY REPORT**—The Rays open a brief three-game road trip in Cleveland tonight at Progressive Field...are coming off a 4-2 homestand against the Reds (1-2) and Twins (3-0)...have won four straight games to improve to a season-high five games above .500 for the first time since July 19, 2025 (52-47)...ties the Mariners for the longest active winning streak in the majors...are an AL-best 14-6 (.700) in their last 20 games since April 4, second in the majors behind the Padres (16-4/.800), on the heels of a 2-5 start...are 6-2 in their last eight road games since losing five of their first seven...have gone 8-4 on a stretch of 27 games in 29 days from April 14-May 13, with off days coming on April 23 and 30...are 1.5 GB behind the Yankees for first place in the AL East...have spent six days in first, 13 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth, including 13 straight days in first or second.

- ★ The Rays scored all of their runs on back-to-back hits by **Jonathan Aranda** (2-run 1B) and **Yandy Diaz** (2-run HR) in the 4th inning of yesterday's 4-2 win to complete a sweep over the Twins, their third of the campaign, tying the Dodgers and Yankees for the most in the majors.
- ★ They have recorded three sweeps before the end of April for the fourth time, joining 2023 (5), 2012 (3), and 2010 (3)...last season, they didn't record their third series sweep until June 3-5 vs. TEX.
- ★ The victory also ensured the Rays will hold a winning record at the end of April for the ninth time, first since 2023 (23-6)...they went on to qualify for the postseason in six of the previous eight occurrences (2023, 2022, 2019, 2012, 2010, 2008).
- ★ The Rays have outscored opponents, 22-6 (+16), during their four-game winning streak, yielding two runs or fewer in four consecutive games for the first time since May 23-26, 2025...they have not had a longer streak since June 3 (G2)-8, 2023 (6G)...they have limited opponents to a 2-for-22 (.091) clip with RISP during the current run and have not trailed at any point.
- ★ Rays starters have turned in a 0.84 ERA (21.1IP, 2ER) during the winning streak to lower their season-long ERA from 4.22 to 3.67, second in the AL to the Yankees (2.90)...they have yielded one or zero runs in four straight outings for the first time since June 21-26, 2025 (6 starts).
- ★ The Rays are 4-1 (.800) when opposed by left-handed starting pitchers, the best winning pct. in the AL...they have won four straight games against southpaw starters since an Opening Day loss to the Cardinals (March 26 at STL).
- ★ This marks the fifth time this season the Rays are facing an opponent that enters the series leading its division (also: at MIL, vs. NYY, at PIT, vs. CIN)...they have lost three of the previous four sets, with the lone win coming against the Yankees (3-0 from April 10-12).
- ★ With a victory tonight, the Rays would record multiple winning streaks of five games or more before the calendar flips to May for the fourth time, joining 2023, 2019, and 2010...they won six straight games from April 10-16.

**BLAST OFF**—The Rays have homered in five consecutive games for the first time since Sept. 5-10, 2025 (5G), with their last longer streak coming from Aug. 27-Sept. 2, 2025 (6G)...they have 8 HR in that span compared to 7 HR in their previous 12 games (April 7-20)...the club has scored 46.2 pct. (12) of its 26 runs over that stretch via the long ball compared to 25.0 pct. (26 of 104) in its first 22 games...six of the Rays 8 HR in that span have traveled 400 feet or farther, and their average home run distance of 396 feet on the season ranks third in the AL behind the Orioles (401 ft.) and Blue Jays (399 ft.)...the Rays have not lost a game (7-0) in which they out-homered opponents, making them one of three clubs to remain undefeated in such contests along with the Guardians (9-0) and Giants (6-0)...they are 3-3 when home runs are even and 6-8 when being out-homered.

★ Each of **Junior Caminero's** 8 HR have come in his last 19 games since April 5, tied with **HOU Yordan Alvarez** for the AL lead in that span.

**ALL-AMERICAN**—The Rays are the ninth team to win 11 of their first 12 games vs. AL opponents, joining Kansas City in 2003, Cleveland in 2002 and 1996, Milwaukee in 1987, Detroit in 1984 and 1911, Oakland in 1981, and Baltimore in 1966...15 NL clubs have gone 11-1 or better in their first 12 intraleague games, most recently Los Angeles-NL in 2021 (11-1)...with a win tonight, the Rays would become the seventh team to win 12 of their first 13 games vs. AL opponents, joining Milwaukee in 1987 (13-0), Detroit in 1984 and 1911 (both 12-1), Oakland in 1981 (12-1), and both Cleveland (12-1 and Baltimore (12-1) in 1966.

- ★ The Rays have claimed each of their first four series vs. AL opponents for the second time in franchise history, joining 2019.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** has hit safely in 12 straight games vs. AL opponents, tied with **Delmon Young** (2007) for the second-longest season-opening streak by a Ray behind **Rocco Baldelli** (13G) in 200...his .491 intraleague on-base pct. ranks second among AL hitters to **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (.511), and his .357 (24-for-42) average is fifth.
- ★ **Richie Palacios** (6-for-14/.429) and **Taylor Walls** (9-for-23/.391) are batting a combined .405 (15-for-37) against AL competition.

**MILESTONE WATCH**—Several Rays can achieve notable franchise/career milestones this series:

- ★ **Yandy Diaz** needs five hits to tie **Rocco Baldelli** (40H, 2003) for the most during a single March/April in Rays history (table to the right)...Diaz needs to reach base safely once to tie **Tommy Pham** (52TOB, 2019) for the most times on base in March/April in club history.
- ★ Diaz's 51 times on base are tied with **Jonny Gomes** (2006) for most in team history through the Rays first 27 games...he needs to reach safely once tonight to match Pham (53, 2019) for the most TOB through 28 games.
- ★ Diaz is 1 XBH shy of 300 for his career and 283 with the Rays, which would tie **Carlos Peña** for seventh most in franchise history.
- ★ Diaz needs 1 HR to match **Carl Crawford** (104HR) for seventh on the Rays all-time list.
- ★ **Chandler Simpson** needs 4 SB to tie Crawford (12SB, 2004) for most in March/April by a Ray and six hits to tie Baldelli (40H, 2003) for the club record over such a span.
- ★ **Junior Caminero's** 8 HR are tied for fourth most in franchise history during March/April, 3 HR shy of Gomes' team record (see table to the right).
- ★ **Jonathan Aranda's** 23 RBI are tied for seventh most by a Ray before the end of April, 5 RBI shy of **Randy Arozarena's** franchise record (28RBI) established in 2023.

**AT THE CORNER**—The Rays and Guardians open a six-game season series tonight, reconvening from July 24-26 at Tropicana Field in Tampa Bay's first home set following the All-Star break...the Rays lost five of seven matchups in 2025, with three of the five setbacks coming by one run...it was their first season series defeat since 2022 (4-2), but they are still 4-2-1 in the last seven season sets since 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020)...the Rays are 2-5-1 in their last eight series with the Guardians dating back to 2022 on the heels of six straight series victories from 2018-21, with their last win coming from July 12-14, 2024 at Tropicana Field...they are seeking their first series win at Progressive Field since July 22-25, 2021, going 0-3-1 in the last four seasons...their .384 (38-61) winning pct. in this ballpark is their second-worst in any current AL venue, better than only Texas' Globe Life Field (.250/4-12).

- ★ The Rays lost each of their final three meetings with the Guardians last season and need to win tonight to avoid their first four-game losing streak vs. Cleveland since Aug. 11, 2017-Aug. 31, 2018...they have lost seven of the last nine matchups overall (Sept. 14, 2024-pres)...the clubs have split 66 games (33-33) since **Kevin Cash** took the helm in 2015 following a two-year stint as Cleveland's bullpen coach under **Terry Francona** (2013-14).
- ★ Rays pitchers have yielded 3 ER or fewer in a franchise-record eight straight games vs. CLE (Sept. 15, 2024-pres), tied for their fifth-longest streak vs. a single opponent in club history and their longest since another eight-game run against the Marlins from Sept. 24, 2021-July 25, 2023...their 2.29 ERA (70.2IP, 18ER) against the Guardians in that span is their lowest vs. any AL opponent...the starting rotation has a 1.13 ERA (16.0IP, 2ER) over the last four meetings.
- ★ The Rays have won eight straight games over AL Central opponents, tied for the third-longest streak in franchise history (also: July 24-Aug. 3, 2010) and one game shy of the club record, which has been accomplished twice: March 30-April 29, 2023 & June 29-July 11, 2013.
- ★ Since his tenure with the Rays began in 2019, **Yandy Diaz** has hit .340 (19-for-50) with 8 XBH, 4 BB, 4 SO, and a 1.029 OPS in 13 games at Progressive Field, his home ballpark over his first two major league seasons (2017-18)...it marks his second-best average and OPS at any AL ballpark over that stretch behind Houston's Daikin Park (.370/1.132).

**X GON' GIVE IT TO YA**—INF **Xavier Isaac**, the Rays No. 13 prospect (MLB.com), was named Southern League Player of the Week for April 20-26 after hitting .412 (7-for-17) with 4 HR, 5 RBI, and 6 R in Double-A Montgomery's series win over Pensacola...the 4HR tied for third most in the minors during the week...it marks his second career weekly award, joining his South Atlantic League POTW honor in May 2024 with Class-A Bowling Green, and the third by a Rays farmhand this season, joining **OF Theo Gillen** (BG) and **INF Daniel Pierce** (Class-A Charleston) during the week of April 6-12.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Steven Matz takes the ball for his sixth start of the season and fourth on the road...marks his 178th career start and fifth opposite the Guardians...is in his 12th major league season and first with the Rays...is one of 15 active left-handed pitchers to cross the 1,000-inning mark for his career (1,028.2) and one of five in the AL along with NYY Max Fried (1,121.0), LAA Yusei Kikuchi (1,017.0), NYY Carlos Rodón (1,282.0), and DET Framber Valdez (1,115.0)...signed a two-year deal with the Rays on Dec. 16, 2025, 2022.

- ✦ He has accounted for three of the eight wins by Rays starting pitchers this season.
- ✦ The Rays are 4-1 in games started by Matz, tied for the best record among Rays starters, alongside Nick Martinez (4-1).

**LAST TIME OUT**—Suffered his first loss of the season on April 21 vs. CIN after working 3.0 innings, allowing four earned runs on four hits and four walks while striking out four batters...gave up a career-high-tying three home runs, joining May 7, 2022 at SF (w/STL) in his shortest start since that outing, when he pitched 2.0 innings and allowed eight runs on five hits, three walks, and three strikeouts in the loss at Oracle Park.

**GUARDING THE ZONE**—Matz will be making his ninth career outing and fifth start opposite the Guardians, owning a 3-0 record...of those four starts, two were quality, and he pitched to a 1.71 ERA (31.2IP, 6ER) with 30 strikeouts...his team has won five of his eight appearances vs. Cleveland.

- ✦ In his most recent outing on Sept. 3, 2025 vs. CLE (w/BOS), he pitched 1.0 inning in relief and allowed two runs (one earned) on two hits in the team's 8-1 loss at Fenway Park.
- ✦ In his last start on Aug. 4, 2021 vs. CLE, he picked up his ninth win and fifth quality start of the year after firing 6.0 scoreless innings, giving up six hits and a walk against eight strikeouts...marked his third scoreless start of the season, but first scoreless outing of at least 6.0 innings or more.
- ✦ At Progressive Field, Matz is 1-0 with a 1.32 ERA (13.2IP, 2ER) and 13 strikeouts in three appearances (2GS)...of the 36 major league ballparks he's pitched in, Progressive Field is one of eight where he has at least one win and no losses.
- ✦ The Guardians are the only team Matz has recorded three wins or more against without a loss...his next-best records are 2-0 against both Minnesota and Texas.

**AL GREATNESS**—Against AL opponents, Matz is 23-15 with two saves, turning in a 3.72 ERA (329.0IP, 136ER) with 299 strikeouts across 86 games (52GS)...with a strikeout tonight, Matz will become one of 29 active left-handed pitchers with 300 strikeouts or more against AL teams.

- ✦ Has posted an 8-1 record against AL Central foes, boasting a 2.33 ERA (120.0IP, 31ER) with 103 strikeouts...his ERA, opp. batting average (.216), and winning pct. (.889) are all his best among any other division in his career.

**STACKING K'S**—Matz became the third-oldest pitcher (34.327) in franchise history to strike out 25 batters or more in his first five starts with the franchise to begin the season, younger than Corey Kluber (36.024, 25SO in 2022) and Charlie Morton (35.159, 34SO in 2019).

- ✦ Is one of two AL starters to record 25 strikeouts or more in 25 IP or fewer this season (also teammate Shane McClellan) and is one of six to turn the trick among all major league starters (also: WSH Cade Cavalli, MIL Kyle Harrison, PIT Carmen Mlodzinski, and LAD Shohei Ohtani)
- ✦ Matz's 2.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 1.23 WHIP rank 15th among AL southpaws this year.

**SPRINGING HIS BEST STUFF**—Matz holds a 19-12 (.613) career record in March/April, marking his second-best monthly winning pct. behind Sept./Oct. (9-3, .750)...his 216 strikeouts in the March/April window are his most of any month, with the next closest being 161 in July.

- ✦ His three wins this March/April are his second most during those months in any season of his career behind 2021 (4-1).
- ✦ Matz was one of three MLB pitchers to win each of his first three starts this season (also: LAA José Soriano, AZ Michael Soroka)...is the first Ray to turn the trick since Taj Bradley, Zach Eflin, and Shane McClellan in 2023...seven MLB pitchers accomplished the feat last year.

**BEEN AROUND THE BLOCK**—At 34 years and 322 days old, Matz became the oldest Rays pitcher to earn three wins in the span of his first four games with the franchise to begin a season, becoming the 11th-oldest MLB arm to turn the trick (last: BAL Kyle Gibson in 2023) since the Rays inaugural season (1998)...Matz entered the 2026 season with 10 years, 99 days of service time, most among Rays...he reached the 10-year mark last June and was one of 16 left-handed pitchers to appear in the majors last season to conclude the year with a decade of service time.

**MLB CAREER RUNDOWN**—In 2023, pitched to a 2-1 mark with a 2.14 ERA (42.0IP, 10ER) in eight appearances (3GS) with the Dodgers...began the year on the 15-day IL (left oblique strain) and was transferred to the 60-day IL on April 21 before making his season debut on Aug. 19 vs. MIA...from his debut through season's end, led the NL in WHIP (0.76) while ranking third in ERA behind SD Blake Snell (1.02) and NYM Kodai Senga (2.06).

- ✦ In 2022, went 3-0 with a 3.47 ERA (36.1IP, 14ER) in nine appearances (7GS) spanning seven stints with the Dodgers...made his MLB debut on May 11 at PIT and earned his first win on July 5 vs. COL...went 9-1 with a 2.56 ERA (91.1IP, 26ER) over 19 outings (17GS) with Triple-A Oklahoma City.
- ✦ In 2021, posted a 5-9 record and 4.62 ERA (101.1IP, 52ER) in 26 games (22GS) between Triple-A Oklahoma City and Double-A Tulsa.
- ✦ Did not pitch in 2020 following the cancellation of the minor league season...was not part of the Dodgers initial 60-man player pool, but reported to the alternate site in Rancho Cucamonga on July 10.
- ✦ In 2019, split his first professional season between Rookie-level AZL Dodgers Mota and Class-A Great Lakes, posting a 1.93 ERA (23.1IP, 5ER) across 13 outings (10GS).
