AT HOME: The Brewers are 10-4 at home, going 3-1-1 in series play.....the team went 45-36 at home last season, going 14-10-2 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 10-7 on the road, going 3-2-0 in series play.....the team went 50-31 on the road last season, going 18-7-1 in series play.....their 50 road wins in 2021 broke the franchise record set by the 1982 team [47-33].

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his eighth season as Brewers manager (549-490) and seventh full season.....he is second in franchise history in managerial wins and games managed (1,039), trailing only **Phil Garner** (563 wins/1,180 games).....under Counsell, the Brewers made the postseason in four consecutive years (2018-21) for the first time in franchise history.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**.....he is signed through 2023.....only the Guardians' **Terry Francona** (10/8/12) and Rays' **Kevin Cash** (12/5/14) have longer active tenures.

COACHES: First base coach **Quintin Berry** (2nd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (4th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (7th season, 2nd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach **Walker McKinden** (3rd season) and bench coach **Pat Murphy** (7th season) all returned from the 2021 staff.....new to the staff is hitting coach **Connor Dawson**, infield/assistant hitting coach **Matt Erickson**, bullpen coach **Jim Henderson** and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons**.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 4-2.....their last challenge (won) came on 5/9 at Cincinnati as an out call at second base involving Jace Peterson was overturned.

TODAY'S STARTER: #37 - RHP ADRIAN HOUSER (5gs, 3-2, 3.42)

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 28, is making his sixth start of the season and second straight against the Reds.....Houser last started last Thursday vs. Cincinnati and earned a 10-5 win (5ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 92 pitches).....he has made 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .222 (22-for-99, 1hr).....after losing his first 2 starts despite a 2.89 ERA (9.1ip, 3er), he has won his last 3 outings, posting a 3.71 ERA (17ip, 7er).....Houser was acquired from Houston with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana in exchange for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

LAST SEASON: Houser went 10-6 with a 3.22 ERA in 28 games/26 starts last season.....the team went 18-8 in his starts.....he made 7 quality starts.....opponents batted .228.....he went 7-1 with a 2.65 ERA over his last 19 games/17 starts [98.2ip, 29er], including 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA over his last 5 games, all starts [30ip, 5er].....he was on the injured list [COVID-19] from 8/7-8/21.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS: On 5/8 at Miami, Houser became the 15th pitcher (17x) in the Modern Era (since 1900) to hit a home run, walk nobody and have 10+ strikeouts in a game..... on 9/4 vs. St. Louis, he threw the first 9-inning complete game by a Brewer since **Jimmy Nelson** on 6/18/17 vs. San Diego, a span of 612 games.....it was the first complete game shutout by a Brewer since **Kyle Lohse** on 9/24/14 at Cincinnati, a span of 1,011 games (MLB record).

CAREER: Is 20-21 with a 3.71 ERA in 89 games/60 starts (351.2ip, 145er).....is in his sixth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2015, 2018-22).....is 15-21 with a 4.06 ERA as a starter (297.1ip, 134er) and 5-0 with a 1.82 ERA in relief (54.1ip, 11er).....underwent “Tommy John” surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-10 with a 3.32 ERA in 45 games/29 starts (170.2ip, 63er).....is 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA in 3 starts this season (16.2ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 13-11 with a 4.08 ERA in 44 games/31 starts (181ip, 82er).....is 1-1 with a 4.66 ERA in 2 starts this season (9.2ip, 5er).

CAREER vs. REDS: Is 2-3 with a 5.80 ERA in 12 games/9 starts (45ip, 29er).....went 1-1 with a 5.60 ERA in 4 starts last season (17.2ip, 11er).....is 1-2 with a 6.41 ERA in 6 career starts at Great American Ball Park (26.2ip, 19er).

<div>RHP Corbin Burnes will make his seventh start of the season.....he last started last Saturday at Atlanta and took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 6h, 2r, 1er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 98 pitches).....the Brewers have scored just 17 runs in his 6 starts this season (2.8rpg).....the team is 2-4 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts, all in his last 5 outings.....opponents are batting .170 (23-for-135, 5hr).....Burnes is 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA in 3 career games/1 start against the Marlins (7.2ip, 5er).....he took an 8-0 loss last season on 4/28 at American Family Field (5ip, 8h, 5r, 4er, 0bb, 9k).....Burnes made his Major League debut against Miami on 7/10/18 at Marlins Park and earned the save in an 8-4 win.</div>
