Postseason Bound [Again]
The Brewers will be competing in the postseason for the seventh time in the last eight seasons and for the third season in a row....the team was just two games away from qualifying for the postseason in pige straight for the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing by only a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

Division Champions

The Brewers have won the division title for the third straight season and for the fourth time in the last five seasons....the team has also secured a first-round bye and a berth in the National League Division Series.

Lookin' Out for No. 1

The Brewers' magic number to clinch the best record in the Major Leagues and home field advantage throughout the postseason is 1....a Phillies loss or a Brewers win will clinch the best record in MLB for the second time in franchise history (also 1982).

Quinning Streak

Quinn Priester has won a franchise-record 12 straight decisions, covering 19 games and 16 starts.

Quinn for the Win
The Brewers have won each of the last 19 games in which Quinn Priester has pitched....this includes 16 starts, the longest winning streak for any starting pitcher in franchise history.... the previous record was 12 straight wins in starts made by **Corbin Burnes** in 2021.....this also marks the longest winning streak in the majors by a team for a starting pitcher since the Dodgers won 16 consecutive games started by **Clayton Kershaw** in 2017..... the last longer winning streak by a team for a starting pitcher is the Cardinals winning 17 straight games started by **Chris Carpenter** in 2005.

20-20 Vision
Entering today at 21 years, 199 days,
Jackson Chourio needs 1 SB to
become the youngest player in MLB
history with multiple 20 HR/20 SB
campaigns.....the current youngest
player with multiple 20 HR/20 SB seasons is Mike Trout, who notched the feat on his 22nd birthday in 2013.

Rebel Yeli
Christian Yelich has recorded the second 100-RBI season of his career (110 in 2018).....he needs 1 HR to reach 30 in a season for the third time in his career (36 in 2018 and 44 in 2019).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 1 of a 3-game homestand against Cincinnati to end the son.....the team is coming off a 2-4 trip to St. Louis (1-2) and San Diego (1-2).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (192 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 78*, SECOND: 57, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 7.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).....the team clinched the NL Central on Sept. 21.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 30-18-3 in series play.

AT HOME: The team has gone 51-27 at home, going 17-7-1 in series play.....the Brewers have won 50+ home games for the eighth time in franchise history and first time since going 51-30 in 2018.....had a season-high 7-game winning streak from 8/8-8/22.

ON THE ROAD: The team went a Major League-best 45-36 on the road, going 13-11-2 in series play....went 35-18 in the last 53 road games.....had a franchise-record-tying 9-game winning streak from 7/23-8/16.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 25 replay challenges this season, going 17-8....their last challenge (won) came 9/24 at San Diego as an out call at second base involving Jackson Chourio was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have now made the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three straight seasons....the team has won the NL Central four times in the last five seasons and three years in a row.....Milwaukee was just two games away from qualifying for the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers have 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25).....this does not include 2020.....entering 2025, the Brewers, Dodgers and Astros were the only teams with 86+ wins in the last seven full seasons..... the Brewers have 762 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

SUMMARY: Are 236-219-1 all time, including 7-3 this season....went 9-4 last season and are 44-17 in the last 61 games.....Milwaukee has won the last 13 series vs. Cincinnati.

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 25, will make his 29th appearance and 24th start of the season.....Priester last pitched on 9/18 vs. Los Angeles-AL and had no decision in a 5-2 win (5.2ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 10k, 1hr, 93 pitches)....he became the first pitcher in franchise history to strike out the first six batters of a game....he notched the third double-digit strikeout game of his career, all this season.....the team is 17-6 in his starts....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .238 (136-for-571, 18hr).... he is 10-2 with a 2.86 ERA as a starter (125.2ip, 40er) and 3-0 with a 5.06 ERA in relief (26.2ip, 15er)....he is on a franchise-record 12-game winning streak over his last 19 games/16 starts while posting a 2.84 ERA (107.2ip, 95h, 36r, 34er, 26bb, 96k, 13hr).....Priester was acquired from Boston on April 7 for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named (RHP John Holobetz on May 5)....he began the season at Triple-A Worcester (1 start).

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts with Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1gs).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts..... opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/0F Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 19-11 with a 4.43 ERA in 49 games/38 starts (252ip, 124er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24), Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025).....has gone 13-10 with a 4.14 ERA as a starter (202.1ip, 93er) and 6-1 with a 5.62 ERA as a reliever (49.2ip, 31er).....Priester was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 8-2 with a 3.97 ERA in 15 games/11 starts (81.2ip, 36er).....is 7-1 with a 3.70 ERA in 12 games/9 starts this season (65.2ip, 27er).
