**BIRDLAND BITES:** Baltimore rallied for a 6-4 win last night in Cleveland to snap a three-game losing streak...The road trip continues tonight with game three of four against the Guardians...The club travels to Kansas City for a three-game set beginning Monday.

⚾ The Orioles scored six runs in the eighth inning last night, their first six-run frame of the season and the most scored by the team in the eighth inning or later since June 27, 2025 vs. Tampa Bay (8<sup>th</sup>, 7).

⚾ Baltimore became the first team in MLB history to give up a grand slam to snap a scoreless tie in the seventh inning or later but still win the game, per *Stats Perform*.

⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** hit a go-ahead three-run home run with two outs in the eighth inning...It marked his first career go-ahead homer in the eighth inning or later and was the second go-ahead home run in the eighth inning or later by an Oriole this season, joining **Gunnar Henderson** on April 7 at Chicago-AL (8<sup>th</sup>, tied 2-2, 2-run HR)...The homer was the first go-ahead shot with the team trailing in the eighth inning or later since Henderson on August 2, 2025 at Chicago-NL (8<sup>th</sup>, down 3-1, 3-run HR) and the eighth such homer by an Oriole (since 1954) from the nine-hole, last accomplished by Rio Ruiz on August 11, 2019 vs. Houston (9<sup>th</sup>, down 7-6, 2-run walk-off HR).

⚾ **Weston Wilson** delivered a pinch-hit two-run double...Entering last night, he was 3-for-21 with one double, one walk, and no RBI as a pinch hitter in his career.

**ACTION JACKSON:** Since the beginning of the previous homestand on April 10, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .406/.406/.938 (13-for-32) with two doubles, five homers, six runs scored, and 13 RBI in eight games...During that time, he leads the majors in hits, total bases (30), and slugging percentage while ranking among MLB leaders in home runs (T-1<sup>st</sup>), OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, 1.344), and RBI (T-2<sup>nd</sup>).

⚾ Jackson is the first Oriole to hit five home runs in a seven-game span since Anthony Santander from July 14-25, 2024...No Oriole has hit six in an eight-game stretch since Santander did so from July 14-26, 2024.

⚾ Among players with at least 60 plate appearances this season, his 3.06 pitches per plate appearance is tied for the second lowest in the majors with SEA's Josh Naylor, ahead of TOR's Ernie Clement (2.94)...The Orioles are averaging 3.94 pitches per plate appearance as a team, ranked seventh in the AL and 10<sup>th</sup> in the majors this season.

⚾ Jackson's five home runs have all come as the second baseman, second in the majors behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (7).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 18 of the last 19 games while slashing .307/.411/.440 (23-for-75) with 10 doubles, 10 runs scored, eight RBI, 13 walks, and one hit by pitch during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on Wednesday.

⚾ His 10 doubles this season are tied with SF's Willy Adames for the MLB lead despite recording none in the last seven games.

⚾ Ward enters play today as the only player in the majors to have four hits in two separate games this season...In 704 career games entering the 2026 season, Ward's career high in hits was three, done 37 times.

**LEAVE IT TO LEODY:** **Leody Taveras** is batting .400/.526/.500 (12-for-30) with three doubles, six runs scored, seven RBI, and eight walks in 10 starts this season...He's recorded a hit in nine of those games and tallied an RBI in five.

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has yet to allow a hit in a career-high 10 straight appearances (10.0 IP) to open the season, the longest active stretch in the majors and the longest season-opening hitless streak by a Baltimore pitcher in team history...Garcia has also stranded all five inherited runners, only the second pitcher in MLB history to begin a season with 10+ scoreless appearances of no hits and no inherited runners scored along with TB's Scott Aldred, who did so in 11 straight from April 8-May 1, 1999.

**'PEN PALS:** The Orioles bullpen ranks fourth in the AL with a 3.45 ERA behind the Rangers (2.78), Mariners (3.16), and Tigers (3.41)...That number drops to 1.82 on the road, which leads the AL and is fourth in the majors behind the Braves (0.70), Reds (1.26), and Phillies (1.50).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning last night...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**WALKING IT OUT:** The Birds have drawn 4+ walks in 14 games this season, tied with the Cubs and White Sox for the most such games in the majors.

⚾ Baltimore has drawn at least four free passes in nine of the last 10 games...The team has walked multiple times in 10 straight games since April 7.

**GUARDIANS OF THE GALAXY:** The Orioles have not won a season series against Cleveland since 2016 (5-1)...During that time, the team is 21-36 (.368)...The O's are 39-78 (.333) all time at Progressive Field since 1994.

⚾ Cleveland Assistant Hitting Coach **Dan Puente** played two seasons in the Orioles organization from 2004-5 between Rookie Bluefield and Class-A Delmarva.

⚾ The largest road crowd Baltimore has ever played in front of during the regular season came on April 10, 1987, when 64,540 fans watched Cleveland's Home Opener against the O's at Cleveland Stadium.

April 18, 1975	- Lee May hits two homers and drives in seven runs to lead the Orioles to a come-from-behind 9-7 win at Boston. The O's trail 6-2 after four innings, but May hits three-run homers in the fifth and seventh innings to propel a 9-7 comeback win. May's seven RBI remain the most by an Oriole at Fenway Park and are still tied for the most by a visiting player at the ballpark since 1970.

**QUICK HITS:** Kremer is scheduled to make his second start of the season and 125<sup>th</sup> of his career tonight vs. Cleveland at Progressive Field...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on April 13 and is in his seventh MLB season, having pitched parts of six seasons with Baltimore from 2020-25...Went 11-10 in 2025 with a 4.19 ERA (80 ER/171.2 IP) and 1.21 WHIP on 163 hits (22 HR), 45 walks, two hit batters, nine wild pitches, and one balk with 142 strikeouts in 31 appearances (29 GS)...Led the Orioles in innings pitched...Was acquired by Baltimore on July 18, 2018, from Los Angeles-NL along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera in exchange for INF Manny Machado.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his season debut on April 13 vs. Arizona and didn't factor in the decision, allowing four runs (2 ER) in 5.0 innings on six hits (3 HR) and no walks with nine strikeouts...The three home runs tied a career high (5x, last: 8/23/25 vs. HOU) while the nine strikeouts were one shy of his career best (3x, last: 5/12/24 vs. AZ)...Threw 80 pitches, 55 strikes.

⚾ Marked the first start of his career in which he struck out 9+ batters without issuing a free pass...Was the first Oriole pitcher to accomplish the feat since **Kyle Bradish** on August 26, 2025 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 0 BB, 10 K).

**WHAT'S THE STORY:** Kremer is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA (14 ER/23.1 IP) over five career starts opposite Cleveland...He snapped a three-decision losing streak vs. the Guardians in his last start on April 16, 2025 at Camden Yards with 5.1 innings of one-run ball on four hits (1 HR), one walk, and two strikeouts to earn the win...Had allowed three earned runs or more in each of his previous four starts vs. Cleveland.

⚾ He's 0-2 with a 6.59 ERA (10 ER/13.2 IP) in three starts at Progressive Field and 6-11 with a 4.77 ERA (59 ER/111.1 IP) in 21 career games (20 GS) vs. the AL Central.

**MEANT TO BE BROKEN:** Kremer has issued at least one walk in each of his last 13 road starts since April 27, 2025, matching the longest such streak of his career from April 19, 2024-March 29, 2025.

**WHIFFIN':** Kremer's 39.4 percent whiff rate on his splitter in 2025 ranked third in MLB (min. 500 P), trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (42.1%) and NYM's Kodai Senga (41.8%)...Held batters to a .206 average (32-for-155) on his split finger and recorded 51 strikeouts with it, the most with any of his pitches.

⚾ In his first start of the season, he limited the opposition to a 1-for-9 (.111) clip with six strikeouts and a 44.4 percent whiff rate on the offering.

**IN THE ZONE:** During the 2025 season, Kremer's 65.7 first-pitch strike percentage was the second-highest mark by a qualified Oriole since tracking began in 1988, trailing **Wei-Yin Chen** (68.3%, 2015)...That mark also ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in MLB and fifth in the AL behind DET's Tarik Skubal (71.5%), TOR's Kevin Gausman (68.8%), SEA's Bryan Woo (66.5%), and MIN's Joe Ryan (66.0%).

⚾ His 65.7% first-pitch strike percentage was a 3.1% increase from his 62.6% mark in 2024, which ranked 60<sup>th</sup> in MLB (min. 125.0 IP).

**THE DISTANCE:** Kremer's 171.2 innings led the Orioles in 2025 and were 1.0 inning shy of his career high set in 2023...Became the seventh pitcher in as many seasons to lead the Orioles in innings, marking the first seven-season span with seven different pitchers leading the club in innings since the first eight seasons in franchise history (1954-61), per *Stats Perform*.

⚾ Made six starts in 2025 in which he threw 7.0+ innings while allowing three hits or fewer, tied for the second-most such outings in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Wally Bunker** (7 GS, 1964)...Tied with BOS' Garrett Crochet and SD's Nick Pivetta for the second-most such starts in MLB behind DET's Tarik Skubal (8 GS).

**vs. CLEVELAND:** Rogers is 0-1 with a 5.79 ERA (6 ER/9.1 IP) in two career starts vs. Cleveland, including a start at Progressive Field on August 1, 2024 when he suffered the loss after allowing five runs in 4.1 innings...Has given up a home run in each of his two starts against the Guardians.
