The Brewers (53-31) are looking to climb to a season-high 23 games over .500 with a win this afternoon.

Well Red

The Brewers are 51-19 (.729) in their last 70 games against the Reds with a current 7-game winning streak.

For Starters

In the last 19 games, Brewers starters have a 2.16 ERA (108.1ip, 26R) while producing 130 strikeouts against just 24 walks along with a 0.83 WHIP and opponents batting .175 (66-for-377).

Jacob Misiorowski has gone 8-1 with a 0.54 ERA (66.1ip, 4er) over his last 10 starts....he has 95 strikeouts against just 14 walks during this stretch while posting a 0.60 WHIP with opponents batting .117 (26-for-223).

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the IL....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (408g, 243-165, .596) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (98 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 60, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 5.5 games....the team has held first place for the last 44 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 29-17 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 24-14 on the road, going 8-4-1 in series play....the team is 16-6 in its last 22 road games, including a current 4-game winning streak....had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 24 replay challenges this season, going 16-8....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/1 vs. Cincinnati as a no blocking of the plate call was confirmed and an out call involving Garrett Mitchell stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 816 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (909), Astros (849) and Yankees (836).

SUMMARY: Have gone 243-221-1 all time, including 6-0 this season....went 8-5 last season and are 51-19 (.729) over the last 70 games with 7 consecutive wins.

MISIOROWSKI AT A GLANCE: Jacob Misiorowski, 24, will make his 17th start of the season and first against the Reds.....Misiorowski last started last Friday vs. Chicago-NL and earned a 6-2 win (6ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 4bb, 6k, 1hr, 2wp, 107 pitches).....the team is 10-6 in his starts.....he has 11 quality starts (nine in a row).....opponents are batting .144 (49-for-341, 5hr).....he has 146 strikeouts in 99.0 innings (13.27 K/9IP).....he is 8-1 with a 0.54 ERA in his last 10 starts (66.1ip, 26h, 5r, 4er, 14bb, 95k, 1hr).....he was named National League Player of the Week for 5/25-5/31 and 6/8-6/14 (co-winner).....Misiorowski was selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from Crowder (MO) College, where he pitched one season (2022) and became the highest drafted player in school history.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RAO-skee."

LAST SEASON: Misiorowski made his Major League debut and went 5-3 with a 4.36 ERA in 15 games/14 starts.....the team went 9-5 in his starts.....he had 3 quality starts.....opponents batted .213 (51-for-239, 8hr).....he had 87 strikeouts in 66.0 innings (11.86 K/9IP).....Misiorowski was named an All-Star after just five games, the fewest in MLB history.....he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/3-8/14 with a left tibia contusion, retroactive to 7/31.....he went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in 2 games in the NLDS against the Cubs, both coming in relief (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 7k, 1hr).....he appeared in Game 3 of the NLCS against the Dodgers out of the bullpen and took the loss (5ip, 3h, 2r, 1er, 1bb, 9k).

CAREER: Is 14-6 with a 2.62 ERA in 31 games/30 starts with Milwaukee (165ip, 100h, 53r, 48er, 58bb, 233k, 13hr).....made his Major League debut last season.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 8-0 with a 2.30 ERA in 17 games/16 starts (94ip, 24er).....is 5-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 9 starts this season (57.1ip, 10er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 6-6 with a 3.04 ERA in 14 starts (71ip, 24er).....is 4-3 with a 1.30 ERA in 7 starts this season (41.2ip, 6er).

CAREER vs. REDS: Is 0-0 with a 14.73 ERA in 2 games/1 start (3.2ip, 7h, 7r, 6er, 6bb, 6k, 0hr).....started on 8/15/25 at Great American Ball Park and had no decision in the Brewers' 10-8 win (1.1ip, 4h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hbp).....his other outing came in relief on 9/27/25 at American Family Field (2.1ip, 3h, 2r, 1er, 3bb, 3k).

ODDS & ENDS: Misiorowski graduated from Grain Valley (MO) High School.....he got engaged to his fiancée, Elle, this past January and is scheduled to be married this coming winter.....he is a supporter of the Wisconsin Parkinson Association.....his father, Tom, was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease when Jacob was growing up.....Misiorowski enjoys hunting, fishing and collecting baseball and Pokémon cards.....he is a Kansas City Chiefs fan.
