POND SCUM: The St. Louis Cardinals and New York Mets wrap up their three-game series this afternoon at Citi Field as the Redbirds seek their fourth series sweep of the season and first of the Mets since Sept. 13-15, 2021 at Citi Field ... The Cardinals continue their six-game road trip this weekend with a three-game Interleague series with the Minnesota Twins at Target Field ... The Cards have won the season series over the Mets for the first time since going 5-2 in 2019, also coinciding with the last time they won four in a row over New York (April 20-June 14, 2019) ... The last time St. Louis topped the Mets in five straight was May 14-Sept. 10, 2005 between Shea Stadium and Busch Stadium II.

TARPS OFF: Winners of six in a row (MLB's longest active win streak), St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games back of Milwaukee.

- St. Louis has won a season-best six straight for the second time in 2026 (also April 27-May 2), marking their first season with multiple winning streaks of 6+ games since 2022 when they last made the post-season ... The last time St. Louis won seven straight was during a nine-game winning streak from May 4(G2)-12, 2025.

- The Cardinals have won 37 or more of their first 65 games of a season for the first time since the 2022 Redbirds also started 37-28 and ended with 93 wins en route to the NL Central Division Championship.

- St. Louis has reached a season-best nine games above .500 for the third time this season ... The last time the club was 10 games above .500 was the end of the 2022 season (93-69 record).

GREAT COMPANY: Last night **Jordan Walker** crushed his career high 17th homer while crossing the 50-RBI threshold ... With 10 stolen bases, the 24-year-old Walker became just the 31st player in MLB history and 2nd Cardinal (**1922 Rogers Hornsby** - 17 HR-58 RBI-12 SB) with 17+HR, 50+ RBI, & 10+ SB in any team's first 65 games of a season ... The last two Major Leaguers to do so were **Pete Crow-Armstrong** in 2025 (17 HR-54 RBI-21 SB) and **José Ramírez** in 2024 (18 HR-62 RBI-11 SB) ... The last right-handed batter was 2015 **Paul Goldschmidt** (17 HR-52 RBI-10 SB).

FIVE ALIVE: St. Louis has scored five or more runs in every game of their six-game win streak (1 of 9 MLB teams this season to plate 5+ runs in six consecutive games) ... With another five runs today, the Cards will become the first Major League team this season to score 5+ runs in seven straight contests ... St. Louis is 30-5 (.857) when scoring 5+ runs this season; Only the Braves (35) and Brewers (32) have more victories than the Redbirds when recording 5+ runs.

EVERYDAY IVÁN: **Iván Herrera** and New York's **Marcus Semien** and **Bo Bichette** are three of the 22 Major Leaguers to have played in every one of their team's games this season ... **Curt Flood** and **Ken Boyer** (162 games in 1964) are last Cardinals to play in every team game of a full non-shortened season ... **Paul Goldschmidt** played in all 58 games of the COVID-19-shortened 2020 sprint, while **Keith Hernandez** and **Tommy Herr** appeared in all 103 games of the strike-shortened 1981 season ... **José Oquendo** holds the franchise single-season record for games played, appearing in 163 of 164 Cardinals games in 1989.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY: Happy 28th birthday to injured Cardinals reliever **Ryan Fernandez** ... Other notables born in this date include **José Reyes** (43), Hall of Fame Quarterback **Joe Montana** (70), Goodfella and former FBI informant **Henry Hill** (1943-2012), actor **Gene Wilder** (1933-2016), Hall of Fame Football Coach **Vince Lombardi** (1913-70), and former Cardinals catcher and Hall of Fame Manager **Roger Bresnahan** (1879-1944).

NEW YORK METS CONNECTIONS

Masyn Winn made his MLB debut against the Mets at Busch Stadium III (Aug. 18, 2023).

Ryne Stanek pitched parts of the previous two seasons with the Mets (2024-25).

Oliver Marmol was born in Elizabeth, NJ.

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft... pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of five seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

Devin Williams was born in St. Louis and is a Hazelwood West High School graduate.

Jeff Albert worked nine seasons in the Cardinals organization as a St. Louis hitting coach (2019-22) and minor league hitting coach (2008-12).

Mets Baseball Ops Special Asst. **Carlos Beltrán** played two All-Star seasons with St. Louis (2012-13).

Kyle Discoll is a native of Toms River, NJ... played collegiately at Rutgers University...held multiple roles with the Mets organization from 2019-2023, including Pitching Data and Movement Analyst, Rehab Coordinator, Assistant Pitching Coordinator, and Triple-A pitching coach.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y...graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)... attended Spring Training with New York before being released (March 13, 2002).

Jared Young played in 75 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2024.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons of his MLB career with the Mets...traded by NY with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets VP of Amateur & International Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals.TV reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Cardinals Asst. GM **Moisés Rodríguez** is from the Lower East Side of Manhattan...formerly worked for MLB in New York (1998-2007).

The Mets made their National League debut in St. Louis on April 11, 1962, losing to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium I on Opening Day, 11-4...The day prior before the season opener was rained out, a dozen Mets players were trapped in the Chase Park Plaza elevator for about an hour.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 2nd start of the season and 4th appearance.
- Last appearance was a 5.0 IP win in relief vs. CIN (6/5), longest relief outing by a Cardinal since **Michael McGreevy** hurled 5.2 scoreless vs. NYM (5/4/25-G2).
- Cardinals have won all three games he's appeared in this season.
- Began the season on the 15-day injured list (recovery from right knee surgery).
- Acquired by the Cardinals along with minor league RHP **Blake Aita** and RHP **Yohoiker Fajardo** from the Boston Red Sox in a four-player deal for 1B **Willson Contreras**, Dec. 21, 2025.
- Was 3-0 with a 3.43 ERA over nine starts at Memphis (AAA). Pitched 44.2 innings with 33 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP.
- Of Cardinals pitcher with 13.0 innings or more, has the highest GIDP/9 IP at 2.08.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, June 5 vs. Cincinnati): W (relief), 10-3; 5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO; 78 pitches

- Posted season-highs in innings pitched, pitches and strikeouts tossing the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- Scattered four singlss in his outing without a runner advancing past second base.

2026 NOTES:

LONGHAUL DRIVER: Pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering four singles for the win vs. CIN (6/5), his first win since 6/8/25 vs. NYY w/BOS. It was the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in 2026 and since Michael McGreevy threw 5.2 IP vs. NYM (5/4/25-G2).

CLOSING TIME?: Last two outings in St. Louis have been in relief and finishing the game; tossing 4.0 innings or more resulting in a save vs. CHI (5/31) and 5.0 for a win vs. CIN (6/5).

HUNTING RARE FEATS: *Became the first Cardinals pitcher in franchise history to record a save and a win in his first two relief outings with the club pitching 3.0 innings or more in each.*

EARLY RISER: His first three starts at Memphis (AAA) were 5.0 innings or more.

THREE OUTTA FOUR AINT BAD: Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings at Iowa (5/20) in a no decision the Redbirds lost 3-2

SEVENS: Struck out a season-high seven batters twice (4/7 at Charlotte & 5/26 at Omaha).

CAREER:

- Was an 8th round pick in the 2021 Draft by the Boston Red Sox out of Texas Tech University, the same alma mater of Cardinals first base coach **Stubby Clapp**.
- Posted a career 21-16 record with a 3.88 ERA over 71 minor league appearances (68 starts).

DOBBINS vs. NEW YORK-NL

- Making his 2nd career start vs. the Mets, appearing as a starter at Fenway Park on May 19, 2025 in a 3-1 Red Sox win.
- Threw 4.2 innings allowing just one run on five hits in a no decision.
- Allowed his one run as Tyrone Taylor singled home Francisco Alvarez in the 3rd inning.
