## **ORIOLES NOTES**

- The Orioles fell to the Yankees by a score of 5-4, dropping to 14-23 and 9-9 at home...Allowed two or more home runs at Oriole Park for the second time this season (last: 5/16 vs. NYY)...Fall to 5-6 in one-run games...Baltimore has posted nine consecutive successful stolen base attempts; last time the team was caught stealing was twice on May 1 vs. Boston.
- **RHP Spenser Watkins** received a no decision...Pitched 4.0 innings and gave up two runs on four hits...Is 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (7 ER/16.1 IP) in four starts at Oriole Park this season...Matched a career-high with three walks (5x, last: 4/30 vs. BOS)...Has surrendered a home run in three straight games for the second time in his career (4, 8/24-9/14/21)...Threw 73 pitches, 44 strikes.
- **RHP Logan Gillaspie** made his Major League debut in the eighth inning...Pitched 2.0 scoreless innings...Struck out Kyle Higashioka for his first career strikeout...Became the fifth Oriole to make his MLB debut this season.
- **SS Ramón Urías** (1-for-4, HR, R, 2 RBI) hit his second home run of the season and first since May 4 vs. Minnesota...Marked his 10<sup>th</sup> career homer in the Major Leagues.
- **CF Cedric Mullins** (1-for-4, BB, SB) snapped a 0-for-10 skid with a single in the third inning...Has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games while batting .315 (23-for-73) with three home runs and seven RBI...Stole his seventh base of the season; entered play today tied for sixth in the Major Leagues with six stolen bases.
- **1B Trey Mancini** (2-for-4, 2B, R, K) is batting .392 (20-for-51) with two home runs and 5 RBI since May 3...Entered play today tied for the lead in the Major Leagues with 18 hits during that span (Bryce Harper, C.J. Cron, Jean Segura)...Recorded his 11<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game this season, the most on the team.

## **YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees defeated the Orioles by a score of 5-4, improving to 27-9 and 13-5 on the road...Are 20-3 in their last 23 games...Improve to 18-0 when scoring at least five runs...Marks the fifth time in franchise history that the Yankees won 27 of their first 36 games...Have won 10 of their last 12 games on the road...Are 14-1 when hitting two or more home runs in a game.
- **RHP Jameson Taillon** has won three straight starts...Pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits...Surrendered more than two earned runs for the first time since 9/6/21 vs. Toronto...Allowed a home run this season for the first time since April 22 vs. Cleveland (Franmil Reyes)...Is 8-3 with a 3.26 (40 ER/110.1 IP) in his last 21 starts dating back to July 6, 2021...Threw 82 pitches, 52 strikes.
- **RHP Michael King** pitched 3.0 innings and struck out six; entered play today leading Major League relievers with 31 strikeouts...Has not allowed an earned run in nine of his 12 appearances this season.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (4-for-5, 2B, 2 HR, 2 R, 3 RBI) hit his 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> home run of the season; entered play today leading the Major Leagues in home runs...Had his third multi-homer game of the season and the 19<sup>th</sup> of his career...Has hit 30 career homers against Baltimore, the most home runs hit by a Major League player against a single opponent since 2017...Marks the eighth time (5th player) in Yankees history to hit at least 14 home runs in the team's first 36 games of a season (Judge, 14 in 2017, Mickey Mantle, 17 in 1956, Babe Ruth, 16 in 1928, 15 in 1926, and 14 in 1930, Alex Rodriguez, 15 in 2007, and Tino Martinez, 14 in 1997)...Recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> career double...Matched a career-high four hits (3x, last: 7/13/19 vs. Toronto).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (2-for-5, 2B, R) has hit safely in five of his last six games while batting .409 (9-for-22) with one home run and five RBI...Recorded his second consecutive multi-hit game.
