## Boston Red Sox (13-21) at Detroit Tigers (18-17) Monday, May 4, 2026 • Comerica Park, Detroit, MI • 6:10 p.m. ET LHP Payton Tolle (0-1, 3.38) vs. LHP Tyler Holton (0-1, 5.27)

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** Fresh off a series win vs. the Texas Rangers (2-1), the Detroit Tigers tonight continue their six-game homestand with the first of three games against the Boston Red Sox ... the Tigers last night improved to 5-0 through their first five home series for the second year in a row, a feat they had not accomplished since 1942 prior to these past two seasons.

- The Tigers are 12-3 at home, the best home record in all of baseball and the second year in a row that the club has won 12 of its first 15 games at Comerica Park, matching their best home start through 15 games in Comerica Park history.
- The Tigers have started off a home campaign 12-3 (or better) for only the third time in the 126-season history of the franchise: last year at an indential 12-3 and 115 years ago in 1911 when the club started off 13-2 through 15 games at Bennett Park ... that's literally it.
- After starting the season with 20 of their first 32 games on the road, the Tigers this homestand began a stretch in which they play 16 of 25 games (64 percent through May 28) and 32 of 53 games (60 percent through June 28) here at Comerica Park.

**HOME OWNERS:** The Tigers are batting .271 (130-for-480) with a .345 on-base percentage, .452 slugging percentage and a .797 OPS at home this season, the third-best home slugging percentage in all of baseball, the fourth-best OPS and the fourth-best batting average ... the Tigers are averaging 5.20 runs per game at home, the seventh-most in the big leagues.

- Detroit has an extra-base hit in 43-straight home games dating to July 27, 2025, the longest active home streak in all of baseball ... Atlanta is next at 33-straight home games ... it's Detroit's longest home extra-base hit streak since a 50-game run from April 16-August 9, 2019.

**IT'S NOT EASY BEING GREENE:** Riley Greene is now batting .357 (25-for-70) with four doubles, four homers, 13 RBI, a .475 on-base percentage, a .612 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS in his last 20 games over the last three weeks starting April 11 ... he leads the majors in on-base percentage, is fourth in the majors in batting average and is seventh in the majors in OPS in this span.

**CATCH ME IF YOU CAN:** Dillon Dingler has become only the eighth different catcher in franchise history to record at least six home runs and 23 RBI through his first 29 games of a season, just the third this century ... the last two Tigers backstops to do so were Alex Avila (six homers and 23 RBI in 2011) and Ivan Rodriguez (six homers and 29 RBI in 2004).

**HE'S JUST THE ROOKIE OF THE MONTH:** Kevin McGonigle today was named the American League Rookie of the Month for March/April, the seventh-ever Tiger to win the award, the first Tiger since Colt Keith in July of 2024 and only the second Tiger to ever win it in the first month of the season, joining Austin Jackson who did so in April of 2010.

- While the award recognized March/April, McGonigle wrapped up April alone with a .327 batting average in 115 plate appearances ... he is only the third different 21-year-old or younger Tiger to finish *any* calendar month with at least 100 plate appearances and a .327 batting average or better, joining Al Kaline (four different months, 1955-56) and Ty Cobb (once, 1908).
- McGonigle is only the fourth different 21-year-old or younger Tiger to finish *any* calendar month with at least 100 plate appearances and a .426 on-base percentage or better, joining Al Kaline (June 1955 and August 1956), Donie Bush (September 1909) and Ty Cobb (July 1908).
- With 32 hits in April, McGonigle became the first 21-year-old or younger Tiger with 32 or more hits in any calendar month since 21-year-old Howard Johnson with 34 hits in September 1982.
- With nine doubles, McGonigle is the first 21-year-old or younger Tiger to do so in any calendar month in 110 years when 21-year-old Harry Heilmann also had nine doubles in April 1916.

**IT'S GOOD FOR SOMETHING:** Kevin McGonigle has a 2.1 bWAR through his first 34 major league games, tied with Aaron Judge for the best mark in the American League this season and trailing only Atlanta's Matt Olson (2.3 bWAR) and St. Louis' Jordan Walker (2.2 bWAR) for best in the majors.

**IT'S NIGHT AND DAY:** Friday night began a stretch of 11-straight night games for the Tigers through Wednesday, May 12 in New York ... it is Detroit's longest stretch of consecutive night games in nearly 27 years since an 11-game run from August 16-28, 1999 ... the Tigers are 11-3 during day games this year, good for a .786 winning percentage, the best mark in all of baseball ... the Tigers are 7-14 at night, which is a .333 winning percentage, fourth-lowest in all of baseball.

**A LEAGUE OF OUR OWN:** After beginning the season by playing 21 of their first 32 games against the National League, the Tigers this homestand began a stretch during which they will play all but three games (59 of 62 contests) against American League competition through July 9, including 50 games in a row from May 15-July 9 against intraleague foes (barring postponements).

**AND FINALLY:** Riley Greene is batting .392 (20-for-51) with a .475 on-base percentage, .588 slugging percentage and 1.063 OPS at home this season ... he has the second-best home batting average in all of baseball while his on-base percentage ranks fourth.

- Making his second start in as many games after opening last night's rubber match against the Texas Rangers on Sunday Night Baseball...will be his 18th career start and first timing starting back-to-back days...made six starts last year and nine in the 2024 regular season.
- In his six starts last year, he allowed seven earned runs on nine hits including four home runs while striking out 11 over 8.1 innings...Detroit went 2-4 in those games.
- Has allowed two or more earned runs in three of his last four outings, totaling seven earned runs on 12 hits and four walks in his last 3.2 frames.
- Spun 7.0 scoreless innings (seven games) to start the year for the Tigers before allowing a run on April 16 to Kansas City.
