THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JULY 19
2013 - CF Brandon Barnes hits for the eighth cycle in club history, collecting a homer (2nd inning), a triple (4th inning), a single (6th), a double (8th) and another single (9th) in consecutive at-bats...after Barnes, the Astros went 10 years between cycles, until 2B Jose Altuve had the ninth cycle in franchise history in 2023.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will play the finale of their three-game weekend series against the Orioles this afternoon at Daikin Park...**RHP Hunter Brown** (1-0) will make his 100th career start today and the fourth of his career against the Orioles, as he faces off against **RHP Brandon Young** (7-2), who was announced as today's starter last night.

THE DIESEL: **RHP Hunter Brown** will make his eighth start of the season today and his sixth since returning from a lengthy stint on the IL with a right shoulder strain...he has shown some rust upon his return, posting a 4.74 ERA (13ER/24.2IP) in his five starts, but has managed to keep the Astros in games, with the club going 3-2 in those starts.

FAMILIAR FOE: The Astros have seen fellow Texan **RHP Brandon Young** in each of their last three series against the Orioles with him combining for a 1-2 record and a 5.71 ERA (11ER/17.1IP) in those games...in their first matchup on Aug. 15, 2025 in Houston, Young carried a no-hitter into the 9th, but in his next two starts against the Astros, they clobbered him for 17 runs (11 earned) in 9.1 innings.

KIDS DAY: Today is Kids Day, presented by Pluckers, at the ballpark...families can arrive early to explore a variety of kid-friendly activities in the Union Station Lobby from gates open until first pitch...as part of Kids Day, 10,000 fans will receive an **Orbit Keychain**.

TODAY'S TELECASTS: Today's game will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas, Geoff Blum** and **Lauren Callender** on the call...sideline reporter **Julia Morales** will rejoin the broadcast tomorrow night.

THE LINEUP: The Astros have used 99 different lineups in their 100 games, repeating a lineup just once on the season...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 87 times.

GET 'EM EARLY: The Astros rank first in the AL and second in the Majors in 1st-inning runs (67)...overall, the Astros rank fifth in the AL in runs (453) immediately behind the Orioles (454).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in fielding pct. (.988) and their 42 errors are the second-fewest in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 96 games played at 1B...dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 124 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Astros dropped a heart breaker yesterday, losing 4-2 to the Orioles in 11 innings...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (1ER/5IP) started for Houston, allowing just one hit with six strikeouts in his 5.0 innings...**LF Zach Dezenzo** (2x5) and **CF Lucas Spence** (2x4) had multi-hit games coming from the 8th and 9th place spots in the lineup.

INJURY BUG: The Astros removed both **SS Jeremy Peña** and **1B Christian Walker** from yesterday's game due to injury...Peña left with a right ham-string cramp and Walker with right hip tightness.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have recalled **IF Raynel Delgado** from Triple A Sugar Land and have designated **RHP Nate Pearson** for assignment.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong MVP candidate, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.065), OBP (.430), SLG (.635), and total bases (226)...additionally, he is the Triple Crown leader in the AL, ranking first in batting average (.320), HR (31), and RBI (72) entering play today...Alvarez also ranks first in the AL in hits (114), first in XBH (50), tied for second in runs (65), and fourth in walks (66).

ALL-STAR ALVAREZ: **DH Yordan Alvarez** started and hit second for the AL in last week's All-Star Game, going 1x2 with a single and a run scored...this marked the fourth All-Star selection for Alvarez (2022-24, 2026) and the second time that he was voted as a starter (also in 2024).

WHAT A HALF!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit 31 homers prior to the break, which are the most in a first half in club history, topping **OF Lance Berkman**, who hit 29 homers in the first half of the 2002 season...Alvarez is on pace to hit 50 homers on the season, which would represent a new franchise record, topping the 47 homers hit by **1B Jeff Bagwell** in 2000.

KEYSTONE FLIGHTS: **2B Jose Altuve** has 246 career homers as a second baseman and per Elias that ties him with **2B Joe Gordon** and **2B Ian Kinsler** for eighth all-time in homers by a second baseman in MLB history...on that all-time list, the trio immediately trails **2B Bret Boone** (251), who happens to be the father-in-law of **IF Nick Allen**.

TAP FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 70 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (60%)...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-22 challenges (68%), ranking second in the Majors in challenges won...**3B Isaac Paredes** (11-for-12) has been the most efficient regular challenger for the team and was successful in his first 11 challenges this year.

SPENCE DEBUTS: **OF Lucas Spence** is off to a strong start to his MLB career, going 3x7 with a walk in his two games as an Astro...Spence is the 15th player in franchise history to reach base safely four times in his first two Major League games, a feat most recently accomplished by **OF Zach Cole** (2025) and **DH Yordan Alvarez** (2019).

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-1 with 10 saves (in 10 chances), has a 1.10 ERA (2ER/16.1IP), 28 strikeouts in 16.1 innings, a .109 (6x55) opponent average, and a 0.86 WHIP in 18 appearances...he has not allowed a hit in 14 of his 18 appearances.

DOWN ON THE FARM: **RHP Bryce Mayer** started at Double A last night, working 5.0 scoreless innings, while allowing two hits with eight strikeouts...Mayer, 24, who's considered the top pitching prospect in the Astros system per MLB.com, has had a strong season at Double A Corpus Christi, posting a 3.46 ERA (20ER/52IP) with 74 K's in 14 games (11 starts).

LAST START, JULY 4 VS. TB: In his 4th start since being activated from the IL, he allowed 7 runs (6 ER) on 6 hits with 4 walks and 3 strikeouts...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 10-8 come-from-behind win that night over the Rays, finished by Yordan Alvarez's walkoff homer...were his most runs allowed in a start since surrendering 7 runs on July 6, 2024 vs. MIN...marked just his 4th start among his 37 starts since the beginning of the 2025 season in which he allowed 5+ runs.

THE DIESEL: The Astros 2026 Opening Day starter, Brown has been limited to just 6 Major League starts on the season due to a 2-plus month-long IL stint due to a right shoulder strain...has gone 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (11ER/29.1IP) with 35 strikeouts and a .213 (23x108) opponent average...had posted a 1.78 ERA (5ER/25.1IP) through his first 5 starts of the season prior to his last outing.

VS. TEX: Has an extensive history with the intrastate and division rival, beginning with his MLB debut on Sept. 5, 2022 at Daikin Park, and will be making his 1st start of the season vs. the Rangers...has gone 4-4 with a 2.82 ERA (16ER/51IP), 53 strikeouts, a .240 opponent average and a 1.20 WHIP in his 9 career starts vs. TEX...in 5 career starts at Globe Life Field, he's posted a 3.33 ERA (10ER/27IP)...his 9 starts vs. TEX are tied for his most vs. an opponent and are tied for the 6th-most among all MLB pitchers since 2022.

FOUR SEAMS: Has held opponents to a .129 batting average (4x31) with his 4-seam fastball and has tossed the pitch at a 34.7-percent rate, the highest of all his pitches...his .129 opponent batting average with his 4-seamer ranks 8th among AL pitchers (min. 30 BF).

ON THE MEND: After his 2nd start of the season, was placed on the 15-day IL on April 2 with a right shoulder strain...on the way back, he made 4 rehab appearances between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

ALL-STAR SEASON: A 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...in 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft (No. 28 overall), which begins on Saturday...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.78 ERA (7ER/22.2IP) with 24 strikeouts, a 1.15WHIP and a .197 opponent batting average in his last 24 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak).

VS. BAL: Has been scoreless in 12 of his 14 career appearances vs. the Orioles...outside of appearances on Aug. 23, 2024 at BAL (5ER/0.1IP) and Game 2 of this year's doubleheader on April 30 at BAL (1ER/1IP), he's tossed 12.2 scoreless innings vs. the Orioles.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has recorded 352 career relief appearances with the Astros...recorded his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history...now trails RHP Brad Lidge (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (488) and 10th in IP (361.2).

CAREER: In 352 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.91 ERA (117ER/361.2IP) with 488 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP, a 12.14 K/9 and a 0.80 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

TWO STRONG: Ranks 1st among MLB relievers with 11 scoreless outings of 2.0+ innings this season ...are also the most scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings in a single season by an Astros reliever since RHP Chris Devenski logged 11 such appearances in 2017.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 62.0 IP and 24 multi-inning apps...among AL relievers, ranks T-4th in K's (63).
