TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand (1-3) with the 2nd of 3 games against the Los Angeles Angels (0-1)...Seattle opened the homestand with a 3-game series vs. the Houston Astros (1-2) over the weekend...following an off day Thursday, the Mariners will begin a 6-game road trip at Chicago-AL (3 G, July 26-28) and Boston (3 G, July 29-31)...tonight's game against the Angels will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims**, **Mike Blowers** and Mariners Hall of Famer **Dan Wilson** on the call... the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith**.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners lost yesterday's game by a 3-1 score against the Angels...the Mariners are 38-6 (.864) when out-hitting their opponent this season...Seattle is 34-30 in night games and 19-19 in day games.

- Start Your Engines The Mariners starting rotation has posted a 1.63 ERA (7 ER, 38.2 IP) with 3 walks and 35 strikeouts over their last 6 games (7/13-c), while holding opponents to a .163 average during that span.
- The Muny Effect Andrés Muñoz has not allowed a hit over his last 6.0 innings (7/5-c)...he has not allowed a run over his last 8.0 innings (6/28-c).
- **Defending Home** The Mariners have allowed 4-or-fewer runs in 41 of their 52 games at T-Mobile Park this season...the 41 are <u>most in the Majors</u>...Seattle is 30-11 (.732) in those contests.
- Yesterday's Roster Moves The Mariners yesterday selected INF Jason Vosler from Triple-A Tacoma and optioned INF Ryan Bliss to Tacoma.

WHAT'S THE VECTOR, VICTOR...Victor Robles went 2-for-4 in last night's game, reaching base safely for the 6th-consecutive game (7/13-c) and hitting safely for the 4th-consecutive game (7/19-c)...Robles is batting .462 (12x26) with 4 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run, 2 RBI and 6 stolen bases, getting on base at a .533 clip and slugging .692 (1.226 OPS) in July, ranking 7th in the Majors in OPS during the month...since joining the Mariners, Victor is batting .400 (18x45) with 5 runs, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 7 stolen bases with a .471 on-base percentage, .578 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS...Robles' 1.048 OPS is the highest over a player's first 26 games with the Mariners since Nelson Cruz had a 1.178 OPS in his first 26 games with Seattle (April 6-May 4, 2015).

THE NEWLY MINTED ALL-STAR...Logan Gilbert is set to make his first start since the All-Star break in tonight's game...Gilbert had a brilliant first half, going 6-5 with a 2.79 ERA (41 ER, 132.1 IP), 25 walks, 124 strikeouts and a 0.87 WHIP...Gilbert ranks among the MLB leaders in WHIP (1st), ERA (9th), Opp. AVG (5th, .190), innings pitched (2nd, 132.1) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (10th, 4.96)...Gilbert is the only pitcher in the Majors with 3 starts of at least 8.0 scoreless inning this season and 4 starts of at least 7.0 scoreless innings...Gilbert tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with 2 hits, 0 walks and 9 strikeouts against the Angels in his last start before the All-Star Break on July 14.

HISTORIC HURLERS AT HOME...Seattle pitchers are 31-21 with 16 saves and a 2.73 ERA (144 ER, 474.0 IP) with 104 walks and 486 strikeouts in 52 games at T-Mobile Park this season...among teams pitching at home, the Mariners lead MLB in ERA (2.73), opponent batting average (.202), WHIP (0.95), hitsper-9 innings (6.61), walks-per-9 innings (1.97), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.67), FIP (3.02) and opponent OPS (.574)...the 4.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio is on pace to be 3rd-best at home in MLB history, trailing the 2017 Guardians (4.81), and the 2019 Dodgers (4.75)...the 0.95 WHIP is on pace to be 3rd-best at home in MLB history, trailing the 1910 White Sox (0.92) and 1908 White Sox (0.93).

<u>PITCH PERFECTS</u>...the Mariners pitching staff is 53-49 with 27 saves and a 3.45 ERA (346 ER, 902.0 IP) with 242 walks and 856 strikeouts this season...Seattle leads the Majors in ERA (3.45), ranking ahead of Atlanta (3.46) and Philadelphia (3.48)...Mariners pitchers <u>lead the Majors</u> in opponent batting average (.218), WHIP (1.07), walks-per-9 innings (2.41), hits-per-9 innings (7.22) and rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.54) behind Minnesota (3.62).

SHAKE YOUR MUNY MAKER...right-handed reliever Andrés Muñoz, who was named a 2024 American League All-Star for the first time in his career, has recorded 16 saves, 6 holds and a 1.35 ERA (6 ER, 40.0 IP) with 18 walks and 49 strikeouts in 40 appearances this season...Muñoz sports a 1.00 WHIP and 11.00 strikeouts-per-9 innings...Muñoz is tied for the MLB lead with 6 saves of 4+ outs and is 1 of only 3 MLB pitchers with 10+ saves and 5+ holds, joined by José Alvarado-PHI and Jason Foley-DET...Muñoz is 1 of 3 AL relievers with a sub-2.00 ERA and 10+ saves, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE and Kirby Yates-TEX.

<u>CAL DOES IT ALL</u>...Cal Raleigh has 20 home runs, 62 RBI and 5 stolen bases this season...Cal leads MLB catchers in both home runs and catcher caught stealing (18), while he is tied for the lead in stolen bases...Cal could become the first player to lead catchers in HR, CCS and SB since they began tracking catcher caught stealing in 1974...Cal could also become the first player to lead catchers in both HR and SB in a season since JT Realmuto-PHI in 2020 and the first to lead catchers in a full 162-game season since Carlton Fisk-CWS in 1985.

2024 MLB DRAFT RECAP... the Mariners drafted 20 players in the 2024 MLB First-Year Player Draft from July 14-16... Seattle selected 14 pitchers, 5 position players and 1 two-way player... the class includes 1st rounder (15th overall), switch-pitcher **Jurrangelo Cijntje** (jurr-angelo SAIN-jah) from Mississippi State University and 2nd rounder, right-handed pitcher **Ryan Sloan** from York High School in Elmhurst, Illinois... both Cijntje and Sloan will be at T-Mobile Park tonight.

<u>DEFENSIVE STAND OUTS</u>...the Mariners defense has excelled in turning batted balls into outs, leading the Majors in air ball out percentage (71.8%) and ranking 3rd in groundball out percentage (75.4%) according to *Sports Info Solutions*...Seattle also ranks T-6th in the AL and T-8th in the Majors with 30 defensive runs saved this season.

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues with 61 quality starts this season, ranking ahead of Philadelphia (54 QS) and Kansas City (52), and... YOU MAY ALSO KNOW?...that the Mariners and the Phillies are the only teams to have 4 pitchers with 10+ quality starts, with Seattle starters Logan Gilbert (16 QS), George Kirby (14), Luis Castillo (13) and Bryce Miller (10) each reaching double-digits, but... DID YOU KNOW?...that since the start of the 2022 season, Mariners pitchers have tossed 214 quality starts, the most in the Majors during that span?...Gilbert leads Mariners pitchers and ranks 5th in the Majors with 50 quality starts since 2022.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- The 27-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 21st start of the season and 2nd against Los Angeles-AL..he will also make the 109th start of his MLB career and 10th career start against the Angels.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Was named the 2022 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
- LAST TIME OUT...ND on 7/14 at Los Angeles-AL...he spun 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed 2 hits with 9 strikeouts...his 16th quality start of the season and 7th in his last 8 outings.
- ALL-STAR CALIBER...on July 7, was named to the 2024 American League All-Star team, his 1st All-Star selection...among qualified AL pitchers this season, Gilbert ranks T-1st in quality starts (16), 1st in WHIP (0.87), 2nd in innings pitched (132.1), 3rd in Opp. AVG (.190), 6th in ERA (2.79) and 8th in strikeouts (124).
- THE FIRST 20...through his first 20 starts of the season, opposing hitters are batting .191 (90x471) against Gilbert...Randy Johnson is the only pitcher in franchise history has ever finished a season with a sub-.200 opponent average against (1997, .194)...so far this season he has allowed 120 baserunners, 2nd-fewest in franchise history through 20 starts...teammates **George Kirby** (3rd, 123) and Bryce Miller (2nd, 121) also rank inside the top-5 this season.
- SPLIT SECOND DECISION...hitters this season are batting .082 (5x61) against Gilbert's splitter with 2 doubles and 1 home run...the .082 average is the 2nd-lowest in the Majors and the lowest in the AL against a splitter (min. 50 PA)...he is also putting up a 60.0 K%, the 4th-best in MLB and best in the AL...since 2019, there have only been 2 pitchers in the AL to finish a season with an average against below .100 and a K% above 50%, Shohei Ohtani-LAA in 2021 (.086, 56.5%) and Félix Bautista-BAL in 2022 (.087, 63.4%).
- **FAR FROM HOME...** has gone 6.0+ innings in 9 of his 11 away starts this season...in those 11 starts, he has a 2.57 ERA (21 ER, 73.2 IP) with 9 quality starts and 63 strikeouts...9 quality starts on the road is tied for the most on the road this season in MLB, (also: Jake Irvin-WSH and Seth Lugo-KC).
- HEART OF SUMMER...Since the beginning of June, the right-hander is 3-2 with a 2.10 ERA (13 ER, 55.2 IP) and 53 strikeouts to 5 walks...over the 8 starts in that time frame, he has 7 quality starts, a 0.68 WHIP and opposing hitters are batting .168 (33x197).
- ALL I DO IS WIN ... over his career has made 57 starts away from T-Mobile Park...in those starts he is 26-7 for a .788 win percentage, the best in MLB history (min. 50 GS)...the next closest is Shane Bieber-CLE (37-14, .725).
- FEELING SUPPORTED ... Gilbert is 35-0 in his career when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game...in those games the Mariners are 43-9.
- SHUTDOWN STARTER...made back-to-back starts with 8.0 scoreless innings pitched from 6/16-6/22...since the beginning of the 2020 season, only Nathan Eovaldi-TEX (3 G, 4/29-5/11/21) has gone 8.0+ scoreless innings in consecutive starts...he became the first Seattle pitcher since Mike Montgomery (6/23-6/30/15) to do so.
- MID-SEASON FORM...over 5 starts in June, he posted a 2-1 record with a 1.51 ERA (6 ER, 35.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts to 1 walk...his ERA marked the 2nd-lowest of his career during a single month (March/April 2022, 0.40 ERA)...Gilbert's 0.62 WHIP was the best mark in the Majors during
- June...his WHIP was also the lowest during a single month in his career. GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD...he is posting a 68.0% 1st pitch strike rate, the highest of his career...among pitchers with 100.0+ IP, this is the 4th-highest in the AL behind Tarik Skubal-DET (71.2%), Joe Ryan-MIN
- (70.2%) and Bailey Ober-MIN (69.5%). MARINERS MILESTONES ... currently is 12th in franchise history with 615 strikeouts... James Paxton is 11th
- in the ranking with 619 strikeouts...he moved into the top-15 after striking out 5 batters on 6/5 at Oakland. 100 AND COUNTING...made his 100th career start on 5/30 vs. HOU...he had the 4th-most strikeouts (562)

in a players' first 100 games with the franchise...behind only James Paxton (603), Randy Johnson (593) and Félix Hernández (575)...only 14 pitchers in franchise history have had each of their first 100 appearances be starts.
