METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets enjoyed a day off on Thursday...On Wednesday, the Mets fell to the Pirates, 4-0...New York is in a stretch where they play 18 of 21 games in the state of New York (4-2)...The Mets finished a six-game homestand (4-2) against the Cubs (2-1) and Pirates (2-1)...Tonight, the Mets head to The Bronx for three games before shipping up to Boston for a three-game set.

ROSTER MOVE: Yesterday, the Mets acquired LHP José Castillo from Arizona in exchange for cash considerations...In a corresponding move, RHP Kevin Herget has been designated for assignment.

SUBWAY SERIES: The Mets went 4-0 in the Subway Series in 2024...The Mets earned their second series sweep against the Yankees in franchise history, also accomplished in 2013 (4-0)...In 2023, the Mets went 2-2 against the Yankees, splitting the series in The Bronx and in Queens...The Amazin's are 66-80 vs. the Yankees all-time during the regular season...The Mets are 114-150-2 vs. the Yankees combined in the regular season, World Series, Spring Training, 2020 Summer Camp, Mayor's Trophy Games, Mayor's Challenge Games and the Big Apple Series.

ON THE MARK: On June 25, 2024 at Citi Field, Mark Vientos became the 12th player in franchise history to record a multi-homer game in the Subway Series, joining Pete Alonso, Francisco Lindor, José Reyes Jason Bay, Carlos Delgado, David Wright, Carlos Beltrán, Cliff Floyd, Ty Wigginton, Kaz Matsui and Richard Hildago... He hit safely in each of his first seven career games vs. the Yankees, which is a franchise record.

YOU LOOK FAMILIAR: There have been 167 players who have played for both the Mets and Yankees...Carlos Mendoza managed his first game against the Yankees on June 25, 2024...The Mets skipper spent 15 years in the Yankees system, serving most recently as the team's bench coach...There have been five managers who have guided both teams - Buck Showalter, Casey Stengel, Yogi Berra, Dallas Green and Joe Torre...Courtesy of Elias.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Mets will play American League teams in nine of their next 12 games...This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 7-5 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 285-281 record in Interleague play.

INTERGALACTIC: Pete Alonso has hit a franchise-record 59 home runs in Interleague Play...His 59 home runs are the eighth-most all-time...It is tied for third among active players with Manny Machado...Only Aaron Judge (69) and Kyle Shwarber (60) have hit more.

YANKEES-METS NOTES: The Mets are 19-23 since the Yankees moved to their new home in 2009.

23 AND ME: The Mets have won the last 23 games in which Francisco Lindor has homered...The streak that goes back to July 9, 2024 is the longest streak in team history...Prior to Lindor's streak, the longest was 21 straight wins when George Foster homered between July 3, 1985, and June 29, 1986...The next-longest active streak by any major leaguer is Boston's Ceddanne Rafaela at 17 straight wins... Courtesy of Stats Perform.

LINSANITY: Francisco Lindor has safely reached base in 17 of his last 18 games... In his last 27 games dating back to April 16, has a .333/.408/.577 slashline with 19 runs, three doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and nine walks...Lindor is batting .395 (17-43) in the first inning this year...As the first batter of the game, his 17 hits are tied for the most in the majors, while his eight extra-base hits are the second-most...Lindor has hit six lead-off homers as a member of the Mets...That is tied with Mookie Wilson for the seventh-most in team history...Michael Conforto is next with seven leadoff homers.

PITCHING IN: The Mets lead the majors with a 2.84 ERA and are tied for fourth with 400 strikeouts...They are tied for fourth with five shutouts...New York's starting staff has posted an MLB-best 2.74 ERA this year...The bullpen ranks fourth in the majors with a 2.98 ERA.

- Didn't allow an earned run and earned his second win of the season on May 12 against the Pirates (W, 1.0 IP, 2 H, R)...His 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP) is the best among all Major League pitchers (min. 25.0 IP).
- Entered in the seventh inning on May 7 at Arizona and stranded a runner while picking up the final two outs (0.2 IP, K)...It was his sixth hold of the season and he now has 13 scoreless relief appearances this season.
- In 10 road games this season he has posted a 0.69 ERA (ER/13.0 IP) with one save, four holds, and 12 strikeouts.
- He has made five relief appearance of at least 2.0 innings and all five of those outings have been scoreless (one of five relievers to record as many appearances).
- Has been used as an opener twice this season and he hasn't allowed a run over 3.0 innings total innings as an opener...Had a season-high three strikeouts on April 30 vs. Arizona as a opener.
- Has gone 2-0 with one save, six holds and a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP) through 19 appearances this season, holding batters to a .157 average (13-83)...With runners on base, has held batters to a .077 average (3-39).
- Has produced a run value of four with his sinker this season, tied for the eighth-best among qualified Major League pitchers.
- Got the final two outs and picked up the save in the Mets 6-5 win on April 2 at Miami...It was his first career save after not recording one in his first 118 career appearances.

- Tossed a scoreless seventh inning on May 12 against the Pirates (1.0 IP, BB, K)...Was his ninth scoreless appearance of the season.
- Threw 2.0 innings without allowing an earned run on May 6 against Arizona (3 H, R, BB)...It was the 11th time since the start of 2024 season that he pitched at least 2.0 innings without allowing an earned run in relief.
- Has completed 1.1 or more innings in 10 of his 15 appearances this season, which is tied for the most such outings among major league relievers...His eight wins since the start of the 2024 season are tied for the 13th-most among major league relievers (tied for sixth-most in the NL).
- Has allowed one or zero runs in 33 of his last 37 appearances, including scoreless outings in 25 of those contests, dating back to July 6, 2024...In that span, has gone 7-0 with three saves, five holds and a 2.53 ERA (16 ER/57.0 IP)...Has held batters to a .204 average (40-196) in that span...Over that range, the Mets are 29-8 in games he has pitched in.
- In 2024 he completed 36.0 innings in 23 relief outings and allowed eight runs (2.00 ERA), going 6-0 with three saves and 41 strikeouts...Was 1-3 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in seven starts.

- Threw 2.0 scoreless innings on May 14 vs. Pittsburgh and recorded a season-high four strikeouts (2.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 4 K)...It was the second time this season that he has thrown at least 2.0 innings and not allowed a run, and it was the 17th time in his career he has had such an outing.
- Entered in the seventh inning and recorded the final two outs of the inning on May 10 against the Cubs (0.2 IP).
- Pitched 2.0 scoreless innings on May 4 (G1) against St. Louis (2.0 IP, 2 H)...It was the first time he had pitched 2.0 or more innings scoreless innings since July 25, 2023, at Los Angeles-NL.
- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Syracuse prior to the game on May 1.
- Last season he pitched for Toronto, and he ranked fourth among AL left-handed relief pitchers with 69 appearances...He posted a 3-3 record with 3.59 ERA (25 ER/62.2 IP) 50 strikeouts, and two saves...Over his last 44 appearances of the season, posted a 2.50 ERA (11 ER/39.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts.

- Recorded his 125th save with the Mets on May 13 vs. Pittsburgh and moved into third place all-time in front of Jeurys Familia (124)...Now he only trails John Franco (276) and Armando Benítez (160)...He now has nine saves on the season which are tied for the seventh most in the majors.
- Tossed a perfect ninth inning on May 11 against the Cubs (1.0 IP)...He hasn't surrendered an earned run in seven straight appearances (7.1 IP) dating back to April 23 vs. Philadelphia.
- Struck out Trea Turner in the ninth inning and Kyle Schwarber on April 23 vs. Philadelphia in the 10th inning to record his 456th and 457th strikeout as a Met...His 457 strikeouts passed Armando Benitez (456) for the fifth-most strikeouts by a reliever in franchise history.
- In 10 career appearances against the Yankees, he has posted a 1.59 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) and recorded seven saves.
- His 12.71 K/9.0 IP is sixth in the NL.
- Hitters have posted a .186 (11-59) average against Díaz this season, including a .161 (5-31) average to left-handed batters.
- Finished last season with a 6-4 record, a 3.52 ERA (21 ER/53.2 IP), 20 saves, and 84 strikeouts... Was unscored upon in five of six postseason games in 2024...He finished the postseason with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER/8.2 IP), one win, two saves, one hold and one blown save.
- Was named the Trevor Hoffman NL Reliever of the Year in 2022...Finished ninth in the NL Cy Young Award balloting.

- Walked two batters but recorded the final out of the sixth inning on May 13 vs. the Pirates (0.1 IP, BB)...He has a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) this season which is seventh in the NL among relievers (min. 15.0 IP).

- On May 9 against the Cubs, he came on in the eighth inning with two men on and stranded them both (0.1 IP)...He has stranded 12 of his 16 inherited runners and he is only one of seven relievers to inherit at least 16 runners this season.
- He earned his 10th hold of the season on May 5 at Arizona (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 K)...His 10 holds are tied for the sixth-most in the majors.
- Hasn't allowed an earned run over 8.0 innings on the road this season...Has nine strikeouts and has held opponents to nine hits in those appearances.
- Has not allowed an earned run in 17 of his 19 outings this season and in 30 of his last 33 games dating back to August 22, 2024...Opponents have batted .194 (12-62) against Garrett this season, including a .174 average (4-23) with runners in scoring position...In the larger span, he has gone 1-1 with 16 holds and a 1.84 ERA (6 ER/29.1 IP), 12 walks and 33 strikeouts...Has held opponents to a .202 (21-104) average in those games and also has recorded a 10.13 K/9.0 IP ratio.
- Set career highs in games (53), innings pitched (57.1), wins (8) and strikeouts (83) in 2024...Ended the 2024 season with a 3.77 ERA (24 ER/57.1 IP), this was also a career best...In 2024 he became one of four pitchers in team history to post seven first-half wins as a reliever (Skip Lockwood, 1978, Roger McDowell, 1986 and Dennis Cook, 1999).
