BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles opened a 10-game homestand, their longest of the season, on Friday against the Detroit Tigers (1-0, 2 to play)...The Tampa Bay Rays (3 G) and Toronto Blue Jays (4 G) will be at Camden Yards next week...Baltimore went 1-5 on the last road trip at Washington (1-2) and Tampa Bay (0-3).

⚾ The O's snapped a three-game losing streak on Friday...The pitching staff didn't issue a walk for the second time this season (also 4/12 vs. SF).

⚾ **Jackson Holliday** hit his first home run of the season in the fourth inning, a go-ahead two-run shot...At 337 feet, the homer marked the shortest non-inside-the-park homer hit by an Oriole at Oriole Park since Tim Beckham hit a 333-foot homer on August 3, 2017 vs. Detroit.

⚾ **Pete Alonso** put the Orioles on the board with a go-ahead three-run homer in the third inning, his 10th of the season, and drove in a season-high four runs...He's homered in consecutive games for the second time this season (also 5/1-2)...Eight of his long balls this season have come against right-handed pitching and six have been hit to right field.

ROSTER MOVE: Baltimore reinstated left-handed pitcher **Grant Wolfram** (low back strain) from the 15-day Injured List and appointed him as the 27th man for today's doubleheader.

LET'S PLAY TWO: The Orioles are set to play their second doubleheader of the season today...The club split its only double dip on April 30 vs. Houston, winning 10-3 in game one and falling 11-5 in game two.

⚾ Baltimore played five doubleheaders last season: April 26 at Detroit (0-2), May 14 vs. Minnesota (0-2), May 24 at Boston (1-1), July 10 vs. New York-NL (2-0), and July 29 vs. Toronto (2-0).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .353/.389/.600 (30-for-85) with seven doubles, one triple, four homers, 13 runs scored, 14 RBI, and five walks in 24 games since April 20...Among players with at least 90 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in slugging percentage (4th), batting average (T-4th), and OPS (8th, .989).

⚾ He's hit safely in 18 of his 22 games since April 22, including a career-high 10 straight from May 1-17...He's also scored a run in nine of 13 games since May 5.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-2nd, 47), doubles (T-3rd, 15), times on base (T-4th, 94), and on-base percentage (5th, .410).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 94 times on base are the third most in a players' first 50 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing Roberto Alomar (108 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (103 in 1966).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,036 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,045)...An MLB-best 384 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count.

POLAR PETE: **Pete Alonso** is batting .276/.321/.579 (21-for-76) with five doubles, six home runs, 12 runs, 19 RBI, six walks, and one steal in 20 games this month...During that time, he is tied for third in the majors in RBI with WSH's CJ Abrams, CIN's JJ Bleday, and STL's Jordan Walker, trailing ATH's Nick Kurtz (22) and PHI's Bryson Stott (20)...He entered May hitting .198/.306/.362 (23-for-116) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 runs, 13 RBI, 17 walks, and one steal in 31 games.

⚾ Alonso's three defensive runs saved are tied for the third most among MLB first basemen with four others, trailing MIN's Kody Clemens (5) and ATL's Matt Olson (4)...Last year, his -9 defensive runs saved ranked last among MLB first basemen.

⚾ He has three outs above average, tied for fourth among first basemen...He posted -9 outs above average in 2025, second worst in the majors by a first baseman ahead of COL's Michael Toglia (-10).

HOME COOKING: Baltimore is 13-12 at Oriole Park this season...Fifteen of the team's 25 home games have been decided by three runs or less with the O's going 7-8 in those...The Orioles have split all four homestands this year.

⚾ The Birds have hit .029 points better, slugged .057 higher, and have an OPS .078 points better at home this season compared to the road...All three of those differences are in the top 10 in the league this year, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

LOUD CONTACT: In six games since May 15, the O's have recorded 63 batted balls hit at 100.0+ mph, second most in the majors during that time behind the Nationals (65)...**Pete Alonso** (12) and **Gunnar Henderson** (11) lead the Orioles during that time...On Friday, the team hit 11 balls at least 100.0 mph for the 11th time this year and sixth since the beginning of May.

⚾ Baltimore's 90.1 mph average exit velocity is the second-best mark in the majors this season behind New York-AL (90.5 mph).

TERRIBLE TWOS: Oriole pitching has allowed opponents to slash .259/.356/.420 (149-for-576) with two outs...The batting average is second worst in the majors ahead of the Angels (.276), the on-base percentage is third worst in MLB ahead of the Angels (.374) and Astros (.364), and the .776 OPS is the third highest in the majors ahead of the Astros (.790) and Angles (.780).

⚾ Baltimore hurlers own a .546 opponent OPS with two strikes, the fourth-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.584), Houston (.568), and Washington (.560).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Oriole pitching has allowed opposing right-handed hitters to bat .287, the highest clip in MLB, with the next closest club being the Rockies (.272)...Opposing righties have also posted an .817 OPS, the highest mark in the majors with the next closest being the Astros (.766).

TAKING ON THE TIGERS: The Orioles and Tigers are meeting for their first of two series this season...Baltimore travels to Comerica Park for a three-game set from July 27-29.

⚾ The Birds have lost seven of the last nine games against the Tigers dating to September 21, 2024...Since the beginning of 2022, the O's are 11-15 (.423) against Detroit, the lowest winning percentage against an AL opponent during that time...Baltimore last won a series against the Tigers in 2023, when the club won three of four at Comerica Park from April 27-30 and swept a three-game set at Camden Yards from April 21-23.

⚾ Detroit First Base Coach **Anthony Sanders** (2020-25) and Hitting Coach **Cody Asche** (2023-25) both previously worked for the Orioles.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his seventh start of the season and the 19th of his career today vs. Detroit...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston... Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 7-3 win on May 17 at Washington after tossing a season-low 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts...Exited the game with the bases loaded, after which **Anthony Nunez** recorded a strikeout to end the frame...Threw 70 pitches, 41 strikes.
 ⚡ Has allowed three or fewer runs in five of his six outings this season.
 ⚡ Registered a season-high-tying 11 whiffs (4x, last: 5/11 vs. NYY) on 70 pitches after needing 90+ pitches to reach that number in each of his other three starts.

MOTOR CITY: Young is set to make his second career start opposite Detroit...Suffered the loss on April 26, 2025 (G1) at Comerica Park after allowing three runs on four hits and a career-high five walks in 4.2 innings with six strikeouts...Marked his second career start after debuting on April 19, 2025 vs. Cincinnati...Threw 95 pitches, 55 strikes.
 ⚡ Is 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (6 ER/14.0 IP) over three career starts vs. the AL Central... Earned the win on April 6 at Chicago-AL with five shutout innings of two-hit ball.

VELO UPTICK: Young's average fastball has climbed to 94.0 mph in 2026, up 1.5 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.5 mph increase is the fourth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season behind LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+1.8mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.8 mph), and ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph).
 ⚡ He has held opponents to a .152 (7-for-46) clip on his four-seam fastball, while the opposition is 8-for-17 (.471) off his sinker.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Of the 20 runs Young has permitted this season, eight have come in the opening frame, with opponents hitting .345 (8-for-29) with four walks.
 ⚡ From the second inning on, the opposition is 20-for-89 (.225) with 10 walks.

DAZED AND CONFUSED: Opponents are hitting .147 (5-for-34) against Young's breaking balls (slider, curveball) with 11 strikeouts...Only one of his 10 extra-base hits allowed this year have come on a breaking pitch, a home run on April 30 (G2) vs. HOU.
 ⚡ Last season opponents hit .233 (10-for-43) off his breaking balls with five extra-base hits (2 2B, 3 HR) and eight strikeouts.

ROAD WARRIOR: In three road starts this season, Young is 2-0 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP), .208 (11-for-53) opponent average, and 1.30 WHIP...The O's have won all three of his road starts this season after going 1-4 in 2025.
 ⚡ In three starts at Camden Yards, he owns a 5.40 ERA (9 ER/15.0 IP), .292 (19-for-65) opponent average, and 1.67 WHIP.
 ⚡ Is 3-3 with a 3.12 ERA (14 ER/40.1 IP) in eight career road starts...He is 1-5 with a 7.66 ERA (40 ER/47.0 IP) in 10 career home starts, with the Birds going 4-6 in those contests.

CLEAN SHEET: On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7th inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6th inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9th inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2nd inn.).

HOMECOMING: On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

GAME 2 STARTER: LHP TREVOR ROGERS (2-5, 6.87)

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fifth consecutive loss on May 18 at Tampa Bay, allowing a season-high eight runs (7 ER) on eight hits and two walks in 3.2 innings with three strikeouts...Marks his longest losing streak since a six-game streak from April 6-May 10, 2024...Threw 88 pitches, 60 strikes.

vs. DETROIT: Rogers made his lone start opposite Detroit on May 15, 2024, and earned the win with five shutout innings, scattering three hits, two walks, and one hit batter with six strikeouts...Is 2-2 with a 3.62 ERA (13 ER/32.1 IP) over six career starts against the AL Central, including a 1-1 mark with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18.0 IP) this season (3 GS).

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season and 111th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fifth consecutive loss on May 18 at Tampa Bay after allowing a season-high eight runs on eight hits and two walks with three strikeouts across 3.2 innings...Threw 88 pitches, 60 strikeouts.

- ⚾ Is 0-5 with an 11.84 ERA (25 ER/19.0 IP), .375 (33-for-88) opponent average, and 2.26 WHIP over his last five starts after going 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP), .214 (15-for-70) opponent average, and 1.05 WHIP in his first three starts of 2026.
- ⚾ Opposing left-handed hitters are 5-for-15 (.333) with one double, one home run, and four RBI off Rogers over his last two starts after going a combined 2-for-22 (.091) with two doubles over his first six outings.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Rogers made his lone career start opposite Detroit on May 15, 2024 and earned the win after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits, two walks, and one hit batter with six strikeouts.

- ⚾ Has made six career starts against AL Central opponents, going 2-2 with a 3.62 ERA (13 ER/32.1 IP).
