TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets will today continue their final scheduled series of the 2026 campaign – a three-game midweek series...With yesterday's loss, the Braves have dropped the season series to the Mets for the first time since 2017 (7-12, .368).

 Atlanta was unable to surmount a five-run, first-inning deficit yesterday, ultimately losing to the Mets, 8-5...Drake Baldwin, Michael Harris II and Sean Murphy each recorded an extra-base hit.

 The Braves and Mets are slated to play all 13 of their regular season games during the summer months for the second consecutive season...Each of the contests between these two clubs will be played between June 12 and August 12...In that span, 24% of Atlanta's total games will be against New York.

 Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-2 mark here at Truist Park.

 RH Nolan McLean is set to make his fourth career start against Atlanta...The 6-foot-2, 214-pounder has limited the Braves to exactly two earned runs in each of his previous three turns, equating to a 2-0 record and a 3.18 ERA (6 ER/17.0 IP)...His club is undefeated when he faces the Braves...A native of Willow Spring, NC, McLean owns a 2.40 ERA (11 ER/41.1 IP) in his last seven turns.

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Will take the hill for Atlanta today riding a 12.0-inning scoreless streak, the sixth-longest active by an MLB starting pitcher...Only two starters in the National League have longer active streaks: Miami's Sandy Alcantara (20.0 IP) and teammate Grant Holmes (12.2 IP).

 The southpaw has not allowed a run since the third inning of his start on July 27, when he faced these New York Mets at Citi Field...That day, he completed 5.0 innings, allowed three earned runs, struck out four and walked one in a no-decision.

 Since June 13, one-third of Pérez's starts have been against the Mets...This season, he's 1-1 against the club with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP)...Today, he makes his 10th career start and 13th career appearance against New York...The 6-foot-0, 210-pound Venezuelan enters play 5-1 with a 3.55 ERA (23 ER/58.1 IP) all-time versus the Mets...His only loss against the team occurred on July 5 here at Truist Park.

 Pérez has accumulated 2.4 bWAR already, standing as the second-highest single-season total of his career...He posted 5.1 bWAR during his All-Star 2022 campaign while with Texas.

 His 2.4 bWAR are the fifth-most by an active starting pitcher aged 35-or-older...He trails Zack Wheeler (PHI, 4.6), Chris Sale (ATL, 4.1), Nick Martinez (TB, 3.4) and Sonny Gray (BOS, 3.0).

 Pérez is in pursuit of the 100-win milestone, currently situated at 98-99 in his career.

SEASON SERIES: The Braves lost to the Mets yesterday, 8-5, and fell to 4-7 against them this season...Atlanta has lost the season series to New York for the first time since 2017...The Braves had won the season slate for eight consecutive seasons from 2018-25.

 Within that timeframe, Atlanta's .608 winning percentage against New York was its fifth best against any NL club...The Braves only played to a better mark against Miami (.680), Pittsburgh (.652), St. Louis (.636) and Washington (.616).

 When the Mets clinched the season series over the Braves on September 25, 2017, Seth Lugo earned the win, Max Fried shouldered the loss, and Jeurys Familia earned the save...Travis d'Arnaud homered for New York in the contest.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Went 2-for-5 out of the leadoff spot last night...He doubled, scored a run and recorded an RBI...Baldwin has recorded 11 extra-base hits from the first spot in the batting order, the most by an NL catcher since John Jaso (PIT) had 24 of them (16 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR) in 2016.

 Baldwin's 11 extra-base hits from the leadoff spot are the most in franchise history by a primary catcher...Johnny Oates held the previous record, recording four extra-base hits in that fashion during the 1973 season.

 In his last 26 games, dating to July 11, Baldwin is slashing .320/.407/.485 (33-for-103) with an .892 OPS...His .407 on-base percentage in that time ranks third in the National League and seventh in MLB.

 Baldwin has hit safely in six consecutive games against the Mets since July 6, including five multi-hit efforts...He is slashing .429/.455/.524 (9-for-21) with two doubles, an RBI and a .978 OPS against the club in that stretch.

 He has logged multiple hits in 30 games, already surpassing his total from last season...The last Braves backstop to exceed that number was Brian McCann, who had 33 multi-hit games during the 2011 season.

MAURICIO DUBÓN: His lone hit yesterday came with the bases loaded in the firsting inning, a groundball-single through the left side that scored two runs...Among players with at least 10 at-bats with the bases loaded, Dubón's .667 batting average (8-for-12) in such situations leads MLB.

 Overall, his eight bases-loaded knocks this season are tied for the second most in baseball...Milwaukee's Brice Turang (9) is the only player with more.

 With two outs and runners in scoring position, Dubón's 19 hits are tied for the MLB lead alongside Xavier Edwards (MIA) and Dillon Dingler (DET)...His .380 batting average with two outs and RISP is fourth-best in MLB behind Yordan Alvarez (HOU, .458), Jung Hoo Lee (SF, .385) and Cole Young (SEA, .381).

Today's Game

Makes his 19th start of the season and the 298th of his career in the second game of a three-game series against New York (NL) at Truist Park...Atlanta is 10-8 in his 18 turns this year.

Will make his 10th career start and 14th appearance against the Mets, and is 5-1 with a 3.55 ERA (23 ER/58.1 IP) against the club...all five of his career victories over New York have come at Citi Field, where he has never been charged with a loss.

Is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP) in three starts against the Mets this season, winning June 13 at Citi Field, taking a loss July 5 at Truist Park and going without a decision July 27 at Citi Field.

The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters 7-6 with a 3.14 ERA (35 ER/100.1 IP) over 22 appearances - 18 starts and four relief outings - with 78 strikeouts against 40 walks.

His 3.14 ERA over his first 22 games this season is the second-lowest through the opening 22 games of a season in his career, trailing only a 2.85 mark (43 ER/136.0 IP) to begin 2022 with Texas.

Since the All-Star break, Pérez is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER/19.0 IP) over four starts, the sixth-lowest ERA among major league pitchers with at least four starts in that span.

Opponents are batting .208 (75-for-360) against him this season, the lowest mark among National League left-handers with at least 15 starts...teammate Chris Sale is third in that group at .216.

Right-handed batters are hitting .199 (50-for-251) with seven homers off the southpaw and a 2.89 ERA (23 ER/71.2 IP), the lowest average against right-handed hitters among National League left-handers with at least 15 starts, with teammate Chris Sale second at .209...left-handers are batting .229 (25-for-109) with four homers and a 3.77 mark (12 ER/28.2 IP).

His 48.4 percent ground-ball rate is the fourth-highest among National League left-handers with at least 15 starts...opponents are hitting .157 (21-for-134) on ground balls against him.

Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 11 of his 18 starts this season and three-or-fewer in 14 of them.

Is 3-2 with a 4.30 ERA (21 ER/44.0 IP) in nine road appearances (eight starts) and 4-4 with a 2.24 mark (14 ER/56.1 IP) in 13 outings at Truist Park...opponents are batting .253 (42-for-166) away from Atlanta and .170 (33-for-194) at home.

Has worked to a 2.47 ERA (19 ER/69.1 IP) in 16 night outings and a 4.65 ERA (16 ER/31.0 IP) in six daytime turns.

Batters are hitting .148 (19-for-128) against his changeup with 33 strikeouts, more than he has recorded with any other pitch...they have hit .228 (28-for-123) against his sinker and .247 (19-for-77) against his cutter.

Has held opponents to a .173 average (30-for-173) in two-strike counts and .187 (20-for-107) on pitches out of the strike zone.

Opponents are batting .204 (46-for-225) with the bases empty and .215 (29-for-135) with men on...27 of the 35 earned runs he has allowed have scored with a runner aboard, a 5.88 ERA (27 ER/41.1 IP) in those situations against a 1.22 mark (8 ER/59.0 IP) with nobody on.

Is 98-99 in his career, two victories shy of the 100-win milestone.

2026

Tossed 3.0 hitless, scoreless innings with three strikeouts on 35 pitches in a no-decision August 6 against Miami, pulled after the outing was cut short by a rain delay in an 11-3 Atlanta win.

Allowed just one hit over his last two starts, a span of 32 at-bats (.031)...became the third Braves starter in modern baseball history to allow one hit across two starts spanning at least 10.0 innings, joining Kent Mercker (11.0 IP, September 4-9, 1993) and Jim Tobin (18.0 IP, April 23-27, 1944)...the last major league pitcher to do so was Tampa Bay's Ryan Pepiot, August 30-September 4, 2025.

Earned the win August 1 against Washington, allowing one hit over 7.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts in an 8-3 victory...retired the first 20 batters he faced and did not allow a hit over his first 6.2 innings, the longest no-hit bid of his career and the longest by a Brave since AJ Smith-Shawver's 7.0 no-hit innings May 5, 2025 against Cincinnati.

Allowed five hits or fewer in 20 consecutive starts from March 31, 2025 to June 13, 2026, the second-longest such streak by a left-handed starting pitcher since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game run from 2013-14...the streak ended June 19 against Milwaukee.

Logged the first 10-strikeout game of his career May 19 at Miami, in his 285th career start - the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start)...at 35 years, 45 days, he was the first pitcher aged 35-or-older to record a first career 10-strikeout game since Colin Rea on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).

Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings in a 9-0 win at Citizens Bank Park.
