Similarities

Atlanta and Tampa Bay enter this midweek series with their records differing by just half a game.

The two clubs are each winning their respective divisions and leading by the same margin (+4.0 games).

In their last 10 games, the Braves and Rays are both 6-4. They also have matching win/loss "streaks" (L1).

Their home records only differ by 1.0 game, as Atlanta is 48-24 while Tampa Bay is 47-25. Their road records differ by 1.5 games, with Atlanta playing to a 37-35 tally, compared to the Rays' 38-33 mark.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Tampa Bay Rays today commence their only scheduled series of the season – a three-game, midweek set...Both clubs are leading their respective divisions by a 4.0-game margin.

 Atlanta split a four-game wraparound series with Philadelphia over the weekend...The Braves won the opener and then alternated victories through the rest of the set.

 Tampa Bay defeated Atlanta in a three-game set last season at George M. Steinbrenner Field, two games-to-one.

 The Rays have played 10 total games at Truist Park since the venue opened in 2017, tied for the fourth most of any AL club...Only Boston, Toronto and Houston have played more here...Tampa Bay is 4-6 (.400) within these confines.

 RH Freddy Peralta is set make his 11th start (12th appearance) against the Braves...He will face Atlanta for the third different team (MIL, NYM, TB) in his last four starts against the club, dating to 2025...All-time, Peralta is 6-2 with a 3.83 ERA (23 ER/54.0 IP) versus the Braves, and has allowed exactly one earned run in each of his last three starts against them.

 RH AJ Smith-Shawver, a right-hander from Fort Worth, TX, has made just two prior interleague starts, one of which was against Tampa Bay..He faced the Rays on April 12, 2025, and allowed just two earned runs across 5.0 innings in a no-decision...The 6-foot-3, 205-pounder set his career high with seven strikeouts that day.

STARTING PITCHING: RH Grant Holmes went 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision yesterday afternoon at Citizens Bank Park...Since the All-Star break, the Braves' 3.12 ERA (91 ER/262.2 IP) from their starting rotation leads the National League and ranks second in baseball.

 Only the Yankees (2.84) have been better in that span...The Braves' 262.2 innings from their rotation since the break rank fourth.

 In 49 total games since the All-Star break, Atlanta's rotation has logged 15 starts without an earned run and has allowed no more than one earned run in 25 of its turns (51%)...Braves starters have allowed more than three total runs just nine times in that span.

 Since September 2, Atlanta starting pitchers have surrendered just six earned runs across five games, tied for the second-fewest in MLB behind Philadelphia (5).

 In 2026, Braves starters have allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 117 games, tied for the third most in baseball behind the Milwaukee Brewers (123) and New York Yankees (118).

 The Braves' 15 starts without an earned run since the All-Star break are the most by any staff in baseball.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves will face an American League club for the first time since August 20 (at Chicago)...Atlanta played 16 straight games against the National League, its second-longest such streak of the season.

 The Braves are 23-19 (.548) in interleague matchups this season, tied for the eighth-best in the majors...Against the AL East specifically, the Braves' 9-6 record (.600) is tied for the second-best in baseball behind Milwaukee (8-4, .667).

 Through play on June 3, Atlanta was 17-9 (.654) against the AL...Since then, the club's 6-10 tally (.375) is the fourth-worst interleague record in the majors behind the Athletics (.321), Angels (.333) and Giants (.333).

 MLB-wide this season, the National League holds the edge over the American League with a 349-300 (.538) record.

NOT WALKING: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. drew Atlanta's only walk yesterday afternoon, securing a free pass in the ninth inning...The Braves have drawn exactly one walk in back-to-back games.

 Atlanta's 415 bases on balls are the third-fewest in the majors, and only surpass the totals of the San Francisco Giants (402) and Toronto Blue Jays (403)...The team's 7.7% walk rate also ranks third behind those clubs.

 Atlanta is pacing for 467 walks this year, which would stand as its fewest over the course of a 162-game season since 1988...That club drew only 432 free passes while finishing last in the NL West (55-106).

 Across the 139 qualified batters in MLB, the average individual walk total is 52.3...The average walk total of the Braves' six qualified hitters is 40.8...Only one qualified Brave exceeds the major-league average on Atlanta's club: Matt Olson (60) .

AT HOME: Through 144 games this season, the Braves have played exactly the same number of home and road games: 72 apiece...Atlanta's 48-24 record (.667) at Truist Park is the best of any major-league club at its home venue...The team's 37-35 (.514) road record ranks 11th in MLB.

 The Braves are 18-6 (.750) in home series openers, also the best mark in MLB...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second in that regard (17-7, .708).

LOSS: Philadelphia left-hander Jesús Luzardo yesterday shut out Atlanta, becoming the first pitcher to do so since Chris Bassitt (TOR) on May 12, 2023.

 It marked Atlanta's ninth offensive shutout of the season, matching the team's total from the entirety of last season.

 It was also the second time this year that the Braves lost, 1-0...They were also defeated by such a margin on June 22 at San Diego.

Makes his fifth start of the season and the 20th of his major league career, in the opener of a three-game series against Tampa Bay...Atlanta is 1-3 in his four turns.
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His lone previous meeting with the Rays came April 12, 2025, in Tampa Bay, when he tossed 5.0 innings of two-run ball with seven strikeouts in a no-decision Atlanta won, 5-4...The seven strikeouts tied his career high.
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That outing began a run of 10 consecutive starts without a loss, a stretch that ended September 1 at Washington.
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Took the loss in his last turn, September 1 at Washington, allowing five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings...It was his first career decision against the Nationals and Atlanta's 9-5 defeat.
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Has pitched to a 2.70 ERA (13 ER/43.1 IP) over eight career starts at Truist Park, compared to a 5.96 mark (32 ER/48.1 IP) across 11 starts on the road.

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Makes his second start at Truist Park this season...The first came August 26 against Los Angeles (NL), when he covered 5.0 innings in a 6-5 Atlanta win.

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Eleven of his 15 strikeouts this season have come on the splitter, against which opponents are hitting .242 (8-for-33)...Thirty-three of his 42 strikeouts came on the pitch in 2025, when hitters managed a .143 average (10-for-70) against it.

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Thirteen of the 14 earned runs charged to him this season have scored with men on base, where opponents are hitting .282 (11-for-39)...He has allowed one earned run over 7.2 innings with the bases empty.

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Has not been scored upon in the first or fourth innings, holding opposing hitters to .071 (1-for-14) and .214 (3-for-14) in those frames...Ten of the 14 earned runs have come in the second and fifth, and hitters are 4-for-8 against him in the fifth.

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Left-handed batters have hit .239 (11-for-46) against him this season, compared to .346 (9-for-26) for right-handers.

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Opponents are batting .321 (17-for-53) against pitches in the strike zone this season and .158 (3-for-19) on pitches outside it...Hitters are 6-for-38 in two-strike counts.

Was placed on the 15-day injured list March 25 with right elbow reconstruction and transferred to the 60-day injured list April 3.

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Did not appear in a spring training game.

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Made five rehab starts from June 30 to July 23, going 1-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) with 21 strikeouts and five walks...Built his pitch count from 41 in the first outing to 86 in the last.

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Made his season debut July 29 at New York (NL), allowing two runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision, his first major league start since May 29, 2025.

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Was optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett on July 30 and recalled by Atlanta on August 18.

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Made two starts for Gwinnett during the option, going 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts...Fanned seven over 5.1 innings in his most recent outing, August 11 against Norfolk, allowing one hit.

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Received a no-decision August 19 at Minnesota, allowing five hits and four runs over 4.1 innings...Retired 12 of the 16 batters he faced over the first four innings before four of the five he faced in the fifth reached base.

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Tossed 5.0 innings August 26 against Los Angeles (NL), allowing three runs on five hits and three walks with three strikeouts in a 6-5 Atlanta win...It was his first start at Truist Park since May 15, 2025, and Tommy Edman's two-run homer in the third was the first he has surrendered this season.

Career Recap

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Became the youngest pitcher to make his first start for Atlanta since Julio Teheran on May 7, 2011...Just one pitcher in baseball started at a younger age in 2023, with Eury Pérez making five such starts for Miami.

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Just one Atlanta pitcher has started any playoff game at a younger age...Steve Avery made four starts in the 1991 playoffs, including two in the World Series, between 21 years, 179 days and 21 years, 195 days old.

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At 20 years, 207 days old, he became the youngest Braves starting pitcher to earn a win since Steve Avery (20 years, 132 days) on August 24, 1990 against Chicago (NL).

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Beat Colorado on June 15, 2023...It was just the sixth time in Atlanta franchise history (since 1966) that a pitcher his age or younger was credited with a win.

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Drafted by Atlanta in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Colleyville Heritage High School in Colleyville, Texas...Born in Fort Worth, Texas.
