HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 4-1 in their 9-game homestand vs. Rockies (2-1), Marlins (2-0) and Cubs (May 13-15).
- ♦ Arizona is 7-1 in its last 8 games and 11-3 in its last 14.
- ♦ The D-backs have won 5 straight vs. Marlins and are 7-2 in their last 9 games.
- ♦ Arizona starting pitchers are 7-0 with a 1.41 ERA (10 ER in 63.2 IP), .185 opponent average, 8 walks and 47 strikeouts in the last 11 games (6 quality starts).
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 10 straight games, batting .371 (13-for-35)/1.219 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 7 walks...had a 9-game hitting streak from April 29-May 9.

LOVULLO NOW THE WINNINGEST D-BACKS SKIPPER

- ♦ **Torey Lovullo** set the franchise record for managerial wins last night with his 354th win (739 G), surpassing Kirk Gibson (353 W; 728 G)...rounding out the Top 4 are Bob Melvin (337) and Bob Brenly (303).

TOUGH SLEDDING AT THE START OF THE SEASON

- ♦ The D-backs' .548 opponent win percentage is the highest in baseball, ahead of the Blue Jays (.545), Astros (.531), Phillies (.529) and Orioles (.526).

D-BACKS TRIO IN THE TOP 13 IN ERA

- ♦ **Zac Gallen** (2nd, 0.95), **Merrill Kelly** (4th, 1.22) and **Madison Bumgarner** (13th, 1.78) give the D-backs a Major-League-best 2 of the Top 4 and 3 of the Top 13 in ERA (min. 5 GS, 20.0 IP).

START ME UP

- ♦ D-backs starters' 2.34 ERA is second in the Majors behind the Dodgers (1.82) and ahead of the Yankees (2.75), Astros (3.01), Mets (3.04) and Padres (3.17).

LOVING THE LONG BALL AND EXTRA BASES

- ♦ The D-backs' 33 home runs are fourth in the NL behind the Brewers (38), Braves (37) and Phillies (35).
- ♦ The D-backs' 83 extra-base hits are tied for fifth in the NL with the Dodgers behind the Braves (94), Phillies (92), Brewers (91) and Rockies (87).

AT A GLANCE: Fourth season with the D-backs.

- Played 5 seasons in the Rays' system (2010-14) then 4 seasons (2015-18) with the SK Wyverns in the KBO League.
- Rays' eighth-round pick in the 2010 draft.

KELLY'S A KEEPER: Signed a 2-year contract extension through 2024 (club option 2025) on April 1.

LAST START: Won on May 6 vs. Rockies, tossing a career-high 8.2 innings with just 1 run allowed and 8 strikeouts.

VS. MARLINS: Is 0-2 with a 7.30 ERA (10 ER in 12.1 IP) in 2 career starts...tossed a quality start in last bid against Miami almost exactly one year ago @ Chase Field on May 13, 2021.

THE 1,2 COMBINATION: Leads the NL and ranks third in the Majors with a 1.22 ERA.

CAREER BEST: Has allowed 1 run or fewer in 5 of his first 6 starts this season, including 3 scoreless outings.

- His 5 total earned runs allowed are the fewest given up in his first 6 starts (previous: 14 runs in 2019).
- Boasts the 2nd lowest D-backs ERA through first 6 starts of a season.

NO LONG BALL HERE: Has not allowed a home run in a career-best 6 straight starts (137 BF) dating back to Sept. 29, 2021.

- Is 1 of 2 qualified NL starters yet to surrender a home run (also: Carlos Rodón/SF).

NUMBERS CRUNCH: Is limiting opposing hitters to a .212 average (29-for-137) and a 1.03 WHIP this season, down from the .302 (39-for-129) and 1.47 in his first 6 starts in 2021.

QUALITY CONTROL: Since May 20, 2021, ranks fourth among NL starters in walks-per-9.0 innings ratio (2.04 BB).

- ♦ The D-backs' 120 walks are second in the Majors behind the Padres (128) and ahead of the Mariners (116), Angels (115), Astros (114), Dodgers (114) and Giants (112).

STRONG DIVISION

- ♦ All 5 teams in the NL West have .500 or better winning percentages, the only division in the Majors to do so, with the Dodgers at .714 (20-8), Padres at .645 (20-11), Giants at .600 (18-12), **D-backs at .548 (17-14)** and Rockies at .533 (16-14).

AT THE DISH

- ♦ **Christian Walker** has 4 2-hit games in his last 7 games, batting .348 (8-for-23)/1.075 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- ♦ **Daulton Varsho** has a 7-game hitting streak and is batting .370 (10-for-27)/1.193 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 3 walks...in his last 10 games, is hitting .351 (13-for-37)/1.064 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 3 walks.

- ♦ The D-backs will face the Cubs for a 3-gamer this weekend then again next week for a 4-gamer.
