BURNING RUBBER: The Orioles fell to the Red Sox in yesterday's rubber match, 9-5...The O's went 11-11 in rubber games in 2022...Baltimore has dropped their last two opening series; their last opening series win came in 2021, when they swept Boston in three games at Fenway Park.

TAKING ON TEXAS: The Orioles went 6-0 against the Rangers last season, their first sweep of a season series against a single opponent since 2020 against the Phillies (3-0) and their first season sweep of at least six games against a single opponent since 2010 against Los Angeles-AL (6-0)...Marked Baltimore's first season sweep of any length against Texas, and the first time the Rangers had ever been swept in a season series by an American League opponent.

STARTING WITH A BANG: O's batters have slugged seven home runs through the first three games of the season, tied for the most in team history (since 1954) with the 2006 club...The most home runs through Baltimore's first four games of a season is nine by the 1966 squad and the 2000 team...The O's have homered in each of the first three games of the season for the 10th time in club history and first since 2017 (also 3); the club record for the most consecutive games with a home run to start a season is seven by the 1966 team and the 1984 club.

RUNNIN' WILD: The Orioles stole 10 bases through their first two games, the most by a team in its first two games of a season since at least 1901, surpassing the previous record of nine stolen bases held by the 1976 Cincinnati Reds and the 1983 Los Angeles Dodgers...The 10 stolen bases are also the most in any two-game span in team history, surpassing the nine stolen bases from August 28 (G2) to August 29 (G1), 1986...**Jorge Mateo** (4 SB), **Cedric Mullins** (3 SB), and **Adam Frazier**, **Austin Hays**, and **Ryan McKenna** (1 SB) make up the 10 steals for the O's.

⚾ Mateo is the first player in O's history (since 1954) and the eighth MLB player since at least 1901 with multiple stolen bases in each of a team's first two games to begin a season (see chart at right).

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: The Orioles opened the 2023 season with 13 pitchers and 13 position players on the active roster...Six players made their first career Opening Day roster: **Kyle Bradish**, **Logan Gillaspie**, **Gunnar Henderson**, **Adley Rutschman**, **Kyle Stowers**, and **Terrin Vavra**...Fifteen of the 26 players were on Baltimore's Opening Day roster in 2022...**James McCann** begins the season on the 10-day Injured List, **Mychal Givens** and **Dillon Tate** begin the year on the 15-day Injured List, and **John Means** begins the year on the 60-day Injured List.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** returns for his fifth season...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award...Hyde was named the 20th manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018.

COACHING STAFF: The Orioles announced their 2023 Major League Coaching Staff on November 8, 2022...The club named **Cody Asche** (ASH-ee) Offensive Strategy Coach...**Ryan Klimek** (KLIM-ick) enters his first full season on the Major League Staff as Pitching Strategy Coach...All other coaches remain in their same positions: **Matt Borgschulte** (BORG-shult-ee) and **Ryan Fuller** as Co-Hitting Coaches, **Tim Cossins** as Major League Field Coordinator/Catching Instructor, **Fredi González** as Bench Coach, **José Hernández** as Major League Coach, **Darren Holmes** as Assistant Pitching Coach, **Chris Holt** as Pitching Coach/Director of Pitching, **Tony Mansolino** as Third Base Coach, and **Anthony Sanders** as First Base Coach.

NEW NUMBER, WHO DIS?: Several members of the 2022 Orioles team will have new jersey numbers for the 2023 season: **Kyle Bradish** (No. 56 in 2022) is now No. 39...**Kyle Stowers** switches from No. 83 to No. 28...**Terrin Vavra** switches from No. 77 to No. 23...Additionally, Offensive Strategy Coach **Cody Asche** will wear No. 61 after wearing No. 63 in Spring Training.

RISING TIDE: The Orioles are ranked as the No. 1 farm system by *MLB Pipeline*...Marks the fourth consecutive time between the preseason and midseason lists that the O's are in the top spot...Since *Pipeline* began ranking systems in 2015, only one other organization has claimed the top spot four times in a row, and that was the Padres (2018 pre/mid, 2019 pre/mid)...Baltimore is also ranked as the No. 1 farm system by ESPN's Kiley McDaniel, as well as in *Baseball America's* preseason rankings for the first time since the publication began their Organizational Talent Rankings in 1984...The Orioles have nine prospects in ESPN's Top 100 (see chart at right), eight in the *Baseball America*, *Baseball Prospectus*, and *MLB Pipeline* rankings, and six according to *FanGraphs*...**Gunnar Henderson** enters the season as the No. 1 overall prospect by *Baseball America*, *Baseball Prospectus*, *ESPN*, *FanGraphs*, and *MLB Pipeline*.

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE RECAP: The Orioles went 16-13-3 in Spring Training, including 10-4-3 at Ed Smith Stadium and 6-9-0 on the road, and finished in fourth place in the Grapefruit League standings...The O's drew 100,009 fans in 17 dates at Ed Smith Stadium this spring, including three sellout crowds...Marked Baltimore's first spring with a winning record since 2020 (10-9-3).

2022 IN REVIEW: The Orioles completed the 2022 season with an 83-79 record, finishing in fourth place in the AL East...The O's secured a winning season for the first time since 2016 (89-73)...The Birds eclipsed their win total from each of the previous four full seasons: 2021 (52-110), 2019 (54-108), 2018 (47-115), and 2017 (75-87)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the 2022 Orioles are the first team since 1900 to win at least 77 games in a season after losing 110+ games the previous year and only the third team in MLB history to finish with a .500-or-better record after losing 110+ games the prior campaign, joining the 1899 St. Louis Perfectos (39-111 in 1898 to 84-67) and the 1890 Louisville Colonels (27-111 in 1889 to 87-43)...The O's are the first team in MLB history to win more than 70 games after finishing each of the previous three full seasons (150+ G) with 100+ losses.

QUICK HITS: Made 23 starts in his inaugural season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston; dealt the loss after surrendering three runs (2 ER) on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Was one of 13 players and one of seven O's pitchers to make their debut in 2022...Threw to Adley Rutschman in Rutschman's debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6... Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and **RHP Isaac Mattson** from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for **RHP Dylan Bundy** on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

CAREER AGAINST TEXAS: Making his second career start against Texas...Received a no decision in his only start vs. the Rangers on August 3 at Globe Life Field, allowing one run on three hits with three walks, one hit batter, and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Will also be his second career appearance at Globe Life Field.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Making his fifth career start against the AL West...Made four starts against the division as a rookie in 2022, pitching to a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.12 IP) and a 2-0 record...Earned his first career win at Oriole Park in his last start against the AL West on September 22 vs. Houston, allowing just two hits while striking out 10 in 8.2 scoreless innings.

SPRING TRAINING: Made five Spring Training starts with the O's, going 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER/16.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts to just four walks... Earned his lone Spring Training win in his last start on March 26 vs. Philadelphia, allowing one run on one hit with one walk, one hit batter, and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Attended his second Major League Spring Training.

SAVING HIS BEST FOR THE BEST: Made 14 starts against teams that qualified for the 2022 playoffs in his debut season, going 4-4 with a 4.24 (36 ER/76.1 IP) ERA...The Orioles owned a 9-5 record in those games...He went 2-0 against Houston, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings on August 26 at Minute Maid Park and throwing another 8.2 shutout frames on September 22 at Oriole Park.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox...Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis, allowing two runs on four hits with a season-best 11 strikeouts...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24... Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs or fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP TYLER WELLS (2023 DEBUT)

Wells is scheduled to make his first start of the season and first career start (third appearance) against Texas on Tuesday...Will be his first career appearance at Globe Life Field...Did not receive a decision in either of his first two outings against the Rangers, pitching to a 9.00 ERA (1 ER/1.0 IP) in those games...Owns a 5-5 record with a 3.02 ERA (27 ER/80.1 IP) with 62 strikeouts and 13 walks in 31 career road appearances (12 GS)...Won five straight starts from June 11 to July 3, 2022 tied for the fifth-longest streak in MLB last season.
