**RAYSPORT**—The Rays continue a brief three-game homestand against the Athletics (0-1, two to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...marks their final home games before embarking on a 10-game road trip through Minnesota, Detroit and Boston leading into the All-Star break...have dropped consecutive games for the first time since June 10-11, but have still won 11 of 17, 17 of 26, 26 of 38, 28 of 43, and 38 of their last 62 games following a 9-14 start...own the majors' best record since May 20 (26-12)...are 11-6 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 13-July 2...are third in the AL/fifth in MLB in run differential (+69)...have the 11th-easiest remaining schedule in the majors by opponent winning pct. (.498)...three of their four series before the All-Star break will come vs. sub-.500 clubs (ATH, MIN, BOS)...are 1.5 GB the first-place Yankees (48-36) in the AL East and have been within 1.5 games for seven straight and nine of the last 10 days...have had sole possession of second for 17 consecutive days, and have been in second or third for the last 38 days...on the season, they have spent two days in first, 34 in second, 23 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays lost last night's series opener, 6-4, after yielding a go-ahead, two-run triple in the 9th inning...it marked their first last at-bat loss since June 7 vs. MIA (11-10).
- ★ Five of the Rays last six losses have come against teams in last place in their division, and eight of the last nine have been against clubs under .500...they are a majors-best 24-14 vs. 500 or better teams and 23-24 against sub-.500 clubs, 24th in MLB.
- ★ Tampa Bay is 16-6 (.727) over its last 22 home games since May 20 after a 12-18 start, third in the majors behind Houston (17-5/.773) and Toronto (13-4/.765).
- ★ The Rays have won five of six, 10 of 12 and 14 of their last 18 games following a loss...they have won each of **Shane Baz's** last seven starts, outscoring opponents, 58-24.
- ★ The Rays need to win each of the next two games to avoid their first series loss to the Athletics since April 11-14, 2022 at Tropicana Field...a loss would snap a streak of eight consecutive unbeaten home series (7-0-1), marking their first defeat in Tampa since May 6-8 vs. PHI (3-0)...it would also mark their second time this season losing consecutive series, home or road, joining April 14-20 (vs. BOS, vs. NYY).
- ★ Tampa Bay has been defeated by the same opponent in consecutive games twice since May began: a three-game sweep from May 6-8 vs. PHI and June 10-11 at BOS.

**JUNE RECAP**—The Rays went 17-10 in June, tied with the Dodgers for third in the majors behind the Astros (19-7) and Brewers (16-9)...it tied 2023 (17-10) for their third-most wins during the month in club history, trailing 2004 (20-6) and 2009 (19-7), and marked their most wins in any calendar month since August 2023 (17-8)...the Rays offense led MLB in runs (151), batting average (.280), on-base pct. (.345), RISP average (.336) and hits (T1st, 259), while the starting rotation turned in the AL's fifth-best ERA at 3.87 (144.1IP, 62ER)...the 151 runs scored were also their most since August 2023 (152R).

- ★ **Yandy Diaz** (.400/40-for-100), **Jonathan Aranda** (.340/34-for-100) and **Brandon Lowe** (.337/32-for-95) accounted for 40.0 pct. (106 of 259) of the Rays hits in June...min. 75 AB, they are the second trio of Rays to all hit .335 or better in a month, joining a group of four who did so in June 2006...**Aubrey Huff** (.359), **Rocco Baldelli** (.355), **Julio Lugo** (.349) and **Carl Crawford** (.344).
- ★ Rays 7-8-9 hitters led the majors with 51 RBI in June, tied for sixth most in a calendar month in club history and their most since April 2023 (53RBI)...the bottom-third hit a combined .342 (27-for-79) with RISP last month.

**YANDY MAN CAN**—**Yandy Diaz** finished the month of June with an MLB-best .400 (40-for-100) average, becoming the third player in franchise history to hit .400 or better over a calendar month (min. 75AB) along with **Fred McGriff** in July 1999 (.422) and **Matt Joyce** in May 2011 (.414)...under the same parameter, only **NY Y Aaron Judge** (.415 in April) and **LAD Freddie Freeman** (.410 in May) have had better months this season...Diaz has an active 24-game on-base streak, over which he is batting .417/.486/.635 (40-for-96) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 13 RBI, 11 BB, 14 SO and 14 multi-hit efforts...it marks the second-longest active run in MLB behind ATL **Matt Olson** (30G) and the second longest of his career behind a 29-game streak from May 26-June 28, 2024...he has eight multi-hit efforts in his last 12 games (21-for-49/.429), and his team-leading 28 multi-hit games rank eighth in the AL.

- ★ He hit .350 or better against all three pitch categories in June: fastballs (.420/21-for-50), breaking pitches (.387/12-for-31) and offspeed pitches (.353/6-for-17).
- ★ Diaz leads the majors with 150 hard-hit balls (95 mph or more), fourth most by any player before July under Statcast (since 2015), trailing ATL **Ronald Acuna Jr.** in 2023 (157), TOR **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** in 2024 (154) and LAD **Shohei Ohtani** in 2024 (152).

**KID CAMI**—**Junior Caminero**, who has homered in three straight games at Steinbrenner Field, clubbed his 21st home run last night, third most in the AL behind SEA **Cal Raleigh** (33HR) and **NY Y Aaron Judge** (30HR)...the 21 HR before July rank fourth in Rays history, trailing **Jose Canseco** (28HR) in 1999, **Carlos Peña** (23HR) in 2009 and **Logan Morrison** (22HR) in 2017...he is one of six players since 1901 to reach 21 HR before July at age 21 or younger, joining LAD **Cody Bellinger** (24HR) in 2017, STL **Albert Pujols** (21HR) in 2001, the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** (22HR) in 1953 and NYG **Mel Ott** (22HR) in 1929.

**MAY THE FOURS BE WITH YOU**—The Rays scored all four of their runs in the 4th inning last night...they have recorded four runs or more in a frame 29 times, second most in the majors behind the Cubs (31)...the Rays have accomplished the feat in three of four and six of their last 12 games...yesterday's loss dropped them to 22-3 in games they record at least one four-run inning, joining setbacks on June 27 at BAL (22-8) and June 7 vs. MIA (11-10).

- ★ The Rays have scored four runs (or more) in the 4th inning four times, tied with the Twins for third most in the majors behind the Diamondbacks (6) and Brewers (5).

**FAMILIAR FACES**—The Rays are being opposed by two of their former southpaws this series in **Jacob Lopez** and **Jeffrey Springs**...both pitchers were traded to the Athletics on Dec. 14, 2024 in exchange for **RHP Joe Boyle**, **INF Will Simpson**, **RHP Jacob Watters** and a Competitive Balance Round A selection...if Springs makes his scheduled start this evening, it would mark the fourth series in Rays history they were opposed by multiple starting pitchers who appeared for them the previous season—the other three instances occurred in 2022, when BOS **Rich Hill** and BOS **Michael Wacha** started games against Tampa Bay in three separate series (April 22-24, Aug. 26-28, Sept. 5-7) after pitching for the Rays during the 2021 season (Stats Perform)...the Rays have won four of five and seven of their last 10 games against left-handed starting pitchers.

**DAWG POUND**—**Brandon Lowe's** career-best 16-game hitting streak is the longest active run in the majors and is tied for seventh longest in franchise history...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since **Yandy Diaz's** club-record 20-game streak from June 7-28, 2024...Lowe, who is 25-for-62 (.403) with 2 2B, 5 HR and 13 RBI during the streak, has homered three times in his last four starts and has an RBI in four straight starts...he extended his career-best on-base streak to 19 games last night after being intentionally walked as a pinch hitter.

- ★ With a hit tonight, Lowe would become the seventh Ray with a hitting streak of 17 games or more, joining Diaz, **Jason Bartlett** (19G, 2009), **Quinton McCracken** (18G, 1998), **Wilson Ramos** (18G, 2018), **Tommy Pham** (17G, 2018) and **Aubrey Huff** (17G, 2002).

**BAG BANDITS**—**José Caballero** (29SB) and **Chandler Simpson** (22SB) rank first and tied for second in the AL, respectively, in stolen bases despite Simpson appearing in less than half (42G) of the Rays 85 games...Simpson's 22 SB are third most by a rookie in Rays history, behind **Rocco Baldelli** (27SB) in 2003 and **Randy Winn** (26SB) in 1998...over a full 162-game season, his current pace would result in 84 SB...meanwhile, Caballero is 1 SB shy of 100 for his career...with a steal tonight in the Rays 86th game, he would become the fastest Ray to reach 30 SB since **Carl Crawford** (48G) and **B.J. Upton** (83G) in 2009.

- ★ The Rays lead the majors with 109 SB, ahead of the Cubs (100SB), and have stolen a base in five straight games.

**ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS**—The Rays and Athletics continue a six-game season series tonight, with the clubs also meeting from Aug. 11-13 in Sacramento on the third leg of a four-city, West Coast road trip (Aug. 4-17)...the Rays have won three straight season series over the Athletics since 2022, the longest streak in franchise history, and have won five of the last seven season sets since 2017 (clubs did not meet in 2020), going 29-21 in that span, including 12-6 in the last 18 matchups...last season, the Rays took four of seven games, scoring the winning run in the 7th inning or later in each victory, including back-to-back walk-off wins May 29-30...they averaged 2.3 runs against the Athletics in 2024, the lowest mark in team history...their .430 (92-122) all-time record against the Athletics is their worst vs. any AL opponent.

**TONIGHT’S START**–Shane Baz will toe the rubber this evening for his 17th start of the season and 10th at Steinbrenner Field...marks his 40th career start and 20th at home...the Rays have won each of his last seven starts and are 12-4 in his outings overall...he has a personal five-decision winning streak, matching a career high, and has earned the win in three straight starts...was originally acquired from the Pirates as a player to be named later (Aug. 14, 2018) along with **RHP Tyler Glasnow** and **OF Austin Meadows** for **RHP Chris Archer** on July 31, 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT**–Baz picked up his team-leading eighth win and third in as many starts after firing a career-high eight scoreless frames in a 4-0 victory on June 26 at KC (W, 8.0IP, 3H, 0R, BB, 9SO)...after **Jonathan India’s** leadoff double, he retired each of the next 19 batters, keeping the Royals off the basepaths until back-to-back one-out singles in the 7th inning...he escaped the frame with a GDP before retiring three of four batters in the 8th, stranding a two-out walk.

- ✦ He became the first Ray to throw eight scoreless frames or more since **Tyler Glasnow** (8.0IP) and May 26, 2021 vs. KC and the first to turn the trick on the road since **Ryan Yarbrough** (8.2IP) on Aug. 11, 2019 at SEA.
- ✦ Baz recorded his 200th career strikeout against **Maikel Garcia** to conclude the 4th inning.
- ✦ He has an active 14.2 scoreless inning streak on the road.

**A’s ADDENDUM**–Baz has made one career start opposite the Athletics, earning the win after twirling 7.2 scoreless frames in a 1-0 win on Aug. 20, 2024 during the Rays final series at Oakland Coliseum (W, 7.2IP, 3H, 0R, 3BB, 4SO)...that outing represented the longest of his career until his eight-inning effort in his last start on June 26 at KC...he became the fourth Ray to throw seven scoreless innings or more in his first career start against the Athletics, joining **Tyler Glasnow** (7.0IP, 2021), **Matt Andriese** (9.0IP, 2016) and **Cory Lidle** (7.0IP, 2000).

- ✦ He is 2-2 with a 3.30 ERA (43.2IP, 16ER) over seven career starts vs. AL West opponents, allowing three runs or fewer in each outing.
- ✦ The Rays have not lost a Baz start vs. an AL club since May 1 vs. KC (8-2), winning each of his last seven.

**SHANE AT THE STEIN**–Since posting a 1.42 ERA (19.0IP, 3ER) over his first three home starts, Baz is 3-2 with an 8.58 ERA (28.1IP, 27ER) across his last six dating back to April 19...despite this, the Rays have won his last three outings at Steinbrenner Field, backing him with 9.56 runs of support per 9.0 IP...on the season, his 5.70 ERA (47.1IP, 30ER) at home is third highest among qualified pitchers, better than only **ATH Luis Severino** (6.79) and **AZ Zac Gallen** (6.29)...meanwhile, his 2.91 ERA (43.1IP, 14ER) on the road ranks 10th in the AL.

**ALL I DO IS WIN**–The Rays have won each of Baz’s last seven starts, with the right-hander going 5-0 with a 3.24 ERA (41.2IP, 15ER) in that span...the club has posted a plus-34 (58-34) run differential during the steak, providing him with 7.13 runs of support per 9.0 IP...it marks the second-longest team winning streak in a Rays pitcher’s starts this season behind **Zack Littell** (8GS, April 27–June 6) and the 17th winning streak of seven games or more in a pitcher’s starts in franchise history...if the Rays win tonight, he would become the sixth Tampa Bay pitcher to reach eight consecutive team wins in his starts, joining **Littell**, **Matt Moore** (11GS, 2012-13), **Blake Snell** (10GS, 2018), **Tyler Glasnow** (9GS, 2020-21) and **Shane McClanahan** (8GS, 2023).

- ✦ Baz has received three runs of support in all seven starts during the winning streak, the longest streak of his career.
- ✦ When Baz receives three runs of support or more in his career, he is 13-1 with a 3.07 ERA (117.1IP, 40ER), and the Rays are 19-3 (10-1 in 2025)...in 17 starts with two runs or fewer, he is 2-7 with a 4.74 ERA (93.0IP, 48ER), and Tampa Bay has gone 5-12 (2-3 in 2025).

**CUT IT OUT**–Baz fully introduced a cutter to his arsenal on June 15 and has held opponents to a 2-for-18 (.111) clip with 8 SO on the offering...the cutter has been his most utilized pitch across his last two starts, throwing it 39.1 pct. of the time (79 of 202 pitches)...in his last outing on June 26 at KC, he held the Royals hitless (0-for-8) against the cutter with 4 SO...he has recorded a 2.25 ERA (20.0IP, 5ER) and held opponents to a .147/.256/.206 (10-for-68) line in three starts since he began throwing the cutter regularly.

- ✦ Baz allowed 2 HR in June, both on his changeup, after permitting 9 HR in May, four of which came off his slider...his usage rate on the slider dropped from 8.2 pct. in May to 0.6 pct. in June.

**RUNNING OUT OF GAS**–Over the first three innings, Baz has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (48.0IP, 12ER), 0.98 WHIP and .195 (33-for-164) opp. average... he has held opponents scoreless in the opening frame in 15 of his 16 starts this season and 33 of his 39 career starts...Baz has not permitted a run in the first two innings since April 19 vs. NYY, going 12 starts since...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 6.75 ERA (42.2IP, 32ER), 1.57 WHIP and .276 (45-for-163) opp. average...12 of his 44 runs allowed (27.3%) have come in the 4th frame.

**10 FOR 10**–Baz struck out a career-high 11 batters on April 14 vs. BOS...paired with his start on April 1 vs. PIT, he became the fifth pitcher since 1901 to record 10 SO or more with no walks in two of his first three starts of a season, joining **MIL Corbin Burnes** and **CWS Lance Lynn** in 2021, **WSH Stephen Strasburg** in 2010 and **AZ Randy Johnson** in 2000 (Stats Perform).

TOMORROW’S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP RYAN PEPIOT (5-6, 3.36)

**LAST START**–Allowed four runs while failing to escape the 2nd inning in the shortest start of his career on June 27 at BAL (ND, 1.2IP, 5H, 4ER, 2BB, 1SO)...still has a 2.48 ERA (40.0IP, 11ER) and 0.92 WHIP across his last seven starts, four of which were quality.

**vs. ATHLETICS**–In two career starts against the Athletics, both of which came last season, Pepiot is 1-0 with a 3.09 ERA (11.2IP, 4ER)...he is 1-0 with a 3.04 ERA (23.2IP, 8ER) over four starts vs. AL West opponents this season, allowing only 2 ER over 12.0 IP in his last two (1.50 ERA).
