The Mariners and Rays meet today for the last of 6 total matchups this season. Year Home Road Totals 2021 4-0 2-1 6-1 2022 1-3 1-2 2-5 2023 2-1 1-3 3-4 2024 1-1 1-2 2-3 All-Time 60-46 54-46 114-92

<u>TODAY'S TILT</u>...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand (3-2) tonight with the 3rd of 3 games against the Tampa Bay Rays (1-1)...Seattle is coming off a series win against the San Francisco Giants (2-1)... following an off day tomorrow, the Mariners embark on a 10-game road trip against the Los Angeles Angels (3 G, 8/30-9/1), Oakland Athletics (4 G, 9/2-9/5) and St. Louis Cardinals (3 G, 9/6-9/8)...today's game against the Rays will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports** (710 AM) with **Rick Rizzs** and **Dave Sims** on the call.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners lost last night's game to the Rays by a 3-2 score and are now 3-2 to begin **Dan Wilson**'s managerial career...the Mariners are 7-2 over their last 9 home games and 40-28 at T-Mobile Park this season.

- Hold Me Closer Seattle is 23-20 in 1-run games this season...the 23 one-run wins are tied for 3rd-most in MLB...the 43 one-run games are 4th-most in MLB.
- Yard Cards The Mariners are 54-36 when they hit at least 1 home run this season, compared to 13-30 when they do not homer.
- Feliz Cumpleaños RHP Gregory Santos celebrates his 25th birthday today.
- Happy Birthday Mariners Hall of Famer Lou Piniella celebrates his 81st birthday today.
- Taylor of Troy Troy Taylor has not allowed a run over his last 5 appearances and has allowed just 1 run in 6.1 innings to begin his Major League career...he has held opponents to a .167 (4x24) average while recording 8 strikeouts to just 2 walks.
- Lit like Vic Victor Robles stole 2 bases in yesterday's game and is now 16-for-16 in stolen base attempts with the Mariners...his 16-consecutive stolen bases without a caught stealing are the most in franchise history to begin their Mariners career.

<u>CAMP ROCK</u>...Luis Castillo is 10-12 with a 3.66 ERA (65 ER, 159.2 IP), 43 walks, 163 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 27 starts this season...Castillo is 16-10 with a 2.88 ERA (73 ER, 228.0 IP), 52 walks, 275 strikeouts and a 0.99 WHIP in 38 career starts at T-Mobile Park, including going 6-5 with a 3.15 ERA (32 ER, 91.1 IP) in 15 home starts this season.

**ON THE RUN**...the Mariners have recorded a stolen base in each of the last 6 games dating back to Aug. 21, racking up 11 total steals during that span: **Dylan Moore** (4 SB), **Randy Arozarena** (3), **Victor Robles** (2) **Josh Rojas** (2) and **Jorge Polanco** (1)...the Mariners 6-game streak is tied for the longest active stolen base streak in MLB with Cincinnati (6 G, 8/21-c)...overall this season, the Mariners are 45-24 (.652) when stealing at least 1 base, compared to 22-42 (.344) when they don't record a steal...Seattle is 109-for-133 (82.0%) on stolen base attempts this season, highest success rate in the American League...defensively, the Mariners have held opponents to a 73.5% stolen base success rate, 4th-lowest in MLB.

POLO'S SECOND HALF...in 32 games since the All-Star Break, Jorge Polanco has an .854 OPS, batting .252 (29x115) with 19 runs, 6 doubles, 8 home runs, 19 RBI and 15 walks, with a .341 on-base percentage and .513 slugging percentage...the second baseman's .854 OPS in the second half <u>leads AL second basemen</u>, ranking 4th in the Majors.

OFF THE TOP RALE...first baseman/outfielder Luke Raley has a 1.032 OPS in 19 August games, hitting .275 (14x51) with 11 runs, 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 13 RBI and 11 walks, with a .424 on-base percentage and .608 slugging percentage during the month...Raley's 1.051 OPS during the month ranks 9th-best in the Majors (min. 50 PA) and 6th in the AL, behind Aaron Judge-NYY (1.486), Vladimir Guerrero Jr.-TOR (1.182), Bobby Witt Jr.-KC (1.107), Yordan Alvarez-HOU (1.069) and Matt Wallner-MIN (1.047) in the AL.

STRIVE FOR FIVE, FOUR AND SOAR...in 46 games this season when scoring 5+ runs, the Mariners are 42-4 (.913) which is the best such record in the Major Leagues...in 65 games when scoring 4+ runs, the Mariners are 54-11 (.831), which is the 2nd-best record in the Majors behind San Diego (.851/63-11).

MUÑOZ: ONE OF THE BEST...Andrés Muñoz recorded his 19th save of the season on Sunday...in 50 appearances this season, the 2024 All-Star has a 1.80 ERA (10 ER, 50.0 IP) with 24 walks and 63 strikeouts, sporting a 1.000 WHIP and 11.3 strikeouts-per-9 innings rate...he's also held opponents to a .154 batting average (26x169)...among pitchers with at least 50.0 IP this season, Muñoz's .154 opponent batting average ranks 4th-lowest in the Majors, while him and fellow All-Star Mason Miller-OAK are the only pitchers to hold their opponents to a .155 batting average with a strikeouts-per-9 rate of at least 10.

THE THRILL ON THE HILL...the Mariners pitching staff <u>leads the Major Leagues</u> in ERA (3.51), opponent batting average (.223), WHIP (1.09), fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.34), fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.50), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.77), opponent OPS (.654) and quality starts (81)...Seattle's pitching staff has 13 shutout wins, tied for most in the Majors with Atlanta and Philadelphia.

QUALITY IN QUANTITY...the Mariners <u>lead the Majors</u> in quality starts (81) by a wide margin, with next-closest Philadelphia (68), Kansas City (65), Atlanta (58) and Pittsburgh (57) rounding out the top-5...Seattle has 4 pitchers with 14+ quality starts and 5 with 9+: **Logan Gilbert** (21 QS, most in MLB), **Luis Castillo** (17, T-9th), **George Kirby** (16, 12th), **Bryce Miller** (14, T-15th) and **Bryan Woo** (9), making them the only starting rotation in the Majors to meet both those criteria.

WILSON NAMED MANAGER, MARTINEZ NAMED HITTING COACH...last Thursday, Dan Wilson was named Mariners manager (21st manager, 18th full-time in franchise history) and last Friday, Edgar Martinez was named the team's hitting coach (through the 2024 season)...the pair of Mariners Hall of Famers were Seattle teammates for 12 seasons (1994-2005) and appeared together in each of Seattle's first 4 Postseason appearances (1995, '97, 2000-01) as a franchise.

AS YOU KNOW...Mariners starting pitchers have tossed 6.0+ scoreless innings 28 times this season, most in the Majors by a wide margin, ranking ahead of Philadelphia (21) and New York-AL (20), and...YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...Bryce Miller and Logan Gilbert have each done so on 7 occasions, the only two pitchers in the Majors this season with 7 starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings while Bryan Woo (5 G, T-5th), Luis Castillo (5, T-5th) and George Kirby (4) have contributed to Seattle's MLB-leading total, but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Miller and Gilbert could join Félix Hernández as the only Mariners pitchers to lead the Majors in most 6+ scoreless inning starts?...King Félix finished the 2009 season in a 3-way tie for the MLB-lead with 7 starts of 6.0 innings and 0 runs along with Tim Lincecum-SF and Clayton Kershaw-LAD.

### **ABOUT CASTILLO...**

- The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his 28th start of the year and 2nd against Tampa Bay...he is also making his 209th Major League start and 5th career start against the Rays.
  Has been named an All-Star in 2019, 2022 and 2023.
- Originally signed as an international free agent by the San Francisco Giants on 12/23/11.
- Made MLB debut on 6/23/17 vs. Washington (w/ Cincinnati).
- Signed a 5-year contract extension with the Seattle Mariners on Sept. 24, 2022 after being acquired in a trade with Cincinnati on July 30, 2022.
- LAST TIME OUT...ND on 8/23 vs. San Francisco...he threw 6.0 innings and allowed 5 runs on 6 hits (3 home runs) with 0 walks and 9 strikeouts...his 3rd 9 strikeout game in the month of August and 5th this season.
- THE LAST BAKERS DOZEN...over his last 13 games at T-Mobile Park (4/14-c), he is 6-3 with a 2.68 ERA (24 ER, 80.2 IP) and 91 strikeouts to 13 walks...12 of the 13 outings he has through 6.0 singings, with each of those 11 hair

ings he has thrown 6.0+ innings, with each of those 11 being quality starts... he has also posted a 10.15 SO/9 over that span.

9x5...in his last start on 8/23 vs. SF, he tallied up 9 strikeouts tying his season-high...he also struck out as many against the Mets (8/11), Tigers (8/6), Rockies (4/20) and Cubs (4/14)...this season 54.6% (89) of his 163 strikeouts have come off his 4-seam fastball, 25.2% (41) on his slider, 11.7% (19) on his sinker and 8.5% (14) from his changeup.

QUALITY STRETCHES...twice this season, the right-hander has made 7 consecutive quality starts...his first span came between April 14-May 18 and the second span between July 5-Aug. 11...he is the first player to have multiple 7-game quality start streaks in the same season since Walker Buehler-LAD in 2021...he is the first Mariners pitcher to do so since Félix Hernández in 2013 and 2009...the 3rd different Mariner in franchise history to do so (also: Joel Piñeiro, 2002).

FUN IN THE SUMMER SUN...during July, the right-hander went 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA (7 ER, 31.2 IP) and 27 strikeouts to 8 walks in 5 starts...his 1.99 ERA was the 5th-lowest during the month in the Majors and the 3rd-lowest in the AL...it was his lowest ERA over a month since March/April 2023 (1.82)...all 5 of his outings were quality starts.

100 PITCHES AND STILL GOING...he is 1 of 7 pitchers in 2024 to record 12+ games with at least 100 pitches thrown...since he made his Major League debut, he has thrown 100+ pitches in 77 outings, 5th-most in the Majors during that time.

**GETTING AHEAD AND STAYING AHEAD...** the right-hander has a 64.9% 1st pitch strike rate so far this year...this marks his best 1st-pitch strike rate in his career.

WHIFF ARTIST...currently ranks in the top-15 in the AL in strikeouts this season with 163 (6th) and in swings-and-misses (11th, 332) this year...since he made his Mariners debut on 8/3/22, Castillo is 2nd the Major Leagues, 1st in the AL, with 1,003 swings-and-misses and 1st in the AL in strikeouts (459).

FOR CLUB & COUNTRY...in MLB history, he ranks highly among Dominican-born pitchers in various categories...minimum 1100.0 innings pitched, he ranks 2nd in SO/9 (9.78), 2nd in SO/BB (3.27), 7th in ERA (3.56) and 14th in strikeouts (1319)...among active Dominican-born pitchers, he is 2nd in games started (208), wins (72), innings pitched (1214.1), strikeouts (1319) and quality starts (116)...in each he trails Johnny Cueto-LAA...Castillo was born in Bani, Dominican Republic.

PITCHING WITH THE LEAD over his two full seasons with the Mariners, op-
posing hitters are slashing .223/.282/.400 against him when the Mariners are leading in

posing hitters are slashing .223/.282/.400 against him when the Mariners are leading in the game...he has pitched with the lead in 35 separate games across that time and the Mariners are 27-8 in those contests, including winning 21 of the last 24.

CRITICAL MOMENTS...in 2024, he is holding opposing hitters to a .173 (9x52) average with runners in scoring position with 2 outs...has allowed 11 runs in such situations this season, with 15 strikeouts and 2 walks.

**BARNSTORMING**...since 9/25/22, he has thrown 5.0+ innings in 28 consecutive road starts...marks the 2nd-longest active streak in the Majors, behind, Corbin Burnes-BAL/MIL (33)...this is the longest such streak by a Mariners pitcher in franchise history.

4-SEAM DREAM...hitters this season are batting .195 (47x241) against Castillo's 4-seam fastball...the .195 average against his fastball is the 6th-best in the Majors (min. 200 PA)...he is also posting a 33.6% SO% this season with his 4-seamer, 3rd-best in the Majors.
