## **CINCINNATI REDS (75-69) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (52-91)**

September 14, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #144/HOME #74 RHP WADE MILEY (12-5, 2.89 ERA) vs. LHP DILLON PETERS (0-2, 3.38 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** had the day off yesterday...Have won four of their last six games after losing six in a row (three by one run)...Have gone 10-12 in their last 22 games after losing 13-for-14...Collected a season-high 19 hits and 14 runs against the Brewers on 8/14 (game 1)...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions (last time before and after the All-Star break from 7/11-17).

**SEEING RED:** Beginning tonight the Pirates and Reds are scheduled to play each other nine times over the final three weeks (19 games) of the regular season...The Bucs have lost five straight games to the Reds and are 1-9 in the 2021 season series, winning for the lone time on 5/11 at PNC Park.

**HOME COOKIN':** The Bucs are 4-2 on their longest homestand of the season after taking two-of-three from the Tigers last week and two-of-three from the Nationals over the weekend...The 11-day, nine-game stay in Pittsburgh concludes with this three-game series against Cincinnati...The Pirates have gone 8-5 in their last 13 home games.

**59 BUCS:** With his appearance on Sunday, RHP **Connor Overton** became the 59th different player to appear in at least one game for the Pirates in 2021, a club record for most players used in one season (previous mark was 55 players in 2016)...In addition, there has now been club record 35 different players who have pitched in at least one game in 2021, which eclipses the previous mark of 34, established in 2019.

**THE DOPE ON DILLON: Dillon Peters** is making his fifth start of the season tonight, his fourth at PNC Park...He has held left-handed batters to two hits in 12 at bats and has surrendered just one home run in his first 18.2 innings of work (Tommy Edman at PNC Park on 8/27)...Peters won his first Major League game on 9/28/17 while pitching with the Marlins and won a career-high four games with the Angels in 2019...The Indianapolis native has never faced the Reds.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** In their last four series played at PNC Park, the Pirates have gone 3-0-1...Beginning with their series win over the Indians from June 18-20, the Bucs have gone 7-4-2 in the last 13 series played on their home turf.

<u>WAIVER CLAIM MONDAY:</u> The Pirates claimed RHP **Enyel De Los Santos** off waivers from the Phillies on Monday...In 26 relief appearances with Philadelphia this season, De Los Santos posted a 1-1 record, a 6.75 ERA and 42 strikeouts in 28.0 innings of work (13.5 strikeouts per 9.0ip ratio)...He also made 10 appearances with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, where he posted a 2.70 ERA (13.1ip/4er) and 24 strikeouts.

**NEWMAN!:** Kevin Newman enters tonight's action with a six-game hitting streak (8-for-18, .444) while also hitting safely in eight of his last nine games and .321 (18-for-56) in his last 17 games played at PNC Park...Newman leads all Major League shortstops in fielding percentage (.993), having made just three errors in 408 total chances at the position.

**THE BATTLING BUCCOS:** The Pirates trailed 5-2 Saturday night before coming back to win a 10-7 decision over the Nats... The Bucs have now produced nine come-from-behind victories when trailing by three or more runs this season; tied with Milwaukee for the most such victories among National League teams.

<u>STRATTON HIS STUFF:</u> Chris Stratton has made a career-high 59 appearances and ranks fourth among National League relief pitchers with 70.1 innings pitched this season...<u>His 100.1 innings pitched over the last two seasons are the most among all Major League relievers</u>...Stratton has made eight straight scoreless appearances at PNC Park (8.0ip/11so).

**COMING THRU IN A PINCH:** Wilmer Difo collected his Major League-leading 14th pinch hit of the season Friday night, the most by a Pirates player in a season since **Delwyn Young** had 16 in 2010...As a team, the Pirates rank seventh in MLB with 49 pinch hits, seventh in pinch-hit RBI (30) and are tied for fifth with eight pinch-hit home runs.

**FROM THE TOP SPOT: Ke'Bryan Hayes** has led off each of the last seven games and has gone 10-for-29 (.345) with a double, four RBI and five runs scored while hitting safely in six of the seven contests...He has gone 4-for-7 in the first inning.

THE LIFE OF BRYAN: Bryan Reynold ranks sixth among the National League leaders in hits (150) and fifth in OBP (.383)... He has recorded the fourth-most total bases (255) by any outfielder in all of Major League Baseball this season, trailing only Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (282), Cincinnati's Nick Castellanos (265) and Philadelphia's Bryce Harper (258)...His 58 extrabase hits are the third-most among all National League outfielders behind Harper (64) and Castellanos (63).

**NO PASSING OF THE BUC:** The Pirates are the only team in the Majors without a passed ball this season...Pittsburgh's consecutive games streak of 185 games without a passed ball is the longest such streak in MLB since at least 1900, eclipsing the previous mark of 174 games by the Montreal Expos (June 10, 1978 - June 26, 1979)...The Pirates' streak began on August 18, 2020 (confirmed by the Elias Sports Bureau).

## ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 14, 1982: For the first time since 1933, the Pirates hit two grand slams in a game. The Pirates beat the Cubs 15-5 at Three Rivers Stadium with Richie Hebner and Bill Madlock each hitting a grand slam; Madlock finished the day with six RBI. Randy Niemann earned the win in relief of starter Lee Tunnell and Larry McWilliams pitched the final 5.0 innings to earn his first Major League save.
