NATIONALS NEWS

HAPPY FOURTH OF JULY!
 In a letter to his wife **Abigail Adams** dated July 3, 1776, **John Adams** wrote that the Declaration of Independence "ought to be solemnized with Pomp and Parade with shews, Games, Sports, Guns, Bells, Bonfires and Illuminations from one End of this continent to the other from this Time forward forever more"...The Washington Nationals will honor that request by facing off against the Pittsburgh Pirates on Saturday morning in our nation's capital.

- Washington is 10-10 (.500) on July 4th since 2005 and since the 11:05 a.m. tradition began in 2012, the Nationals are 6-7 (.462) on the Fourth of July.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT
 The Washington Nationals opened their longest homestand of the season on Friday night with a 9-5 win over the Pittsburgh Pirates...**Luis García Jr.** and **Daylen Lile** each clubbed multi-homer games, while **José Tena** added a two-run blast of his own.

- Washington is 35-27 (.565) since April 25, the fifth-best mark in Major League Baseball over this stretch and are 11-3-1 in their last 15 series since May 12.

SPEAKING OF LUIS...
 Reigning National League Player of the Week **Luis García Jr.** ranks in the National League in RBI (2nd, 62), slugging percentage (3rd, .559) and OPS (9th, .874)

- He is 12-for-24 (.500) with three doubles, five homers, 13 RBI, two walks, just one strikeout and seven runs scored in his last six games.
- He has nine home runs in his last 13 games, the most in the National League (2nd in MLB) since June 19.
- Since May 24, **García Jr.** leads MLB with 40 RBI and a .789 slugging percentage and ranks second with 15 home runs and a 1.153 OPS.

PITCHING IN
 Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.37 ERA (16 ER/60.2 IP) over the last 12 games...They've combined for 69 strikeouts, just 10 walks and only seven home runs allowed.

- Foster Griffin** - who ranks ninth in the NL with a 2.87 season ERA - has allowed just two earned runs in 19.1 innings (0.93 ERA) with 20 strikeouts and three walks in two starts during this stretch.
- Cade Cavalli** has 20 strikeouts and just one walk to go along with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in his last two starts.
- Andrew Alvarez** is 1-1 with 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts with four walks during this stretch.
- Zack Littell** tossed 5.0 innings of two-run ball on June 28 vs. Baltimore to earn his seventh win of the season.
- Miles Mikolas** has not issued a walk over his last two starts (10.1 IP).

JAMES WOOD LUMBER COMPANY
James Wood is 9-for-21 (.429) with two doubles, one triple, two homers, six RBI, four walks and six runs scored over his last five games...He's reached safely in nine of his last 15 plate appearances (7 H, 2 BB).

- In addition to his league rankings found in the box to the right, Wood is the only player in the National League (1 of 2 in MLB) with at least 20 home runs and at least 10 stolen bases this season.

HOMER HAPPY
 The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 85 home runs since May 6, ahead of the Phillies (78) and the White Sox (76)...Washington leads in slugging (.465) and is second in OPS (.790) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 122 home runs this season, the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 89 games behind the 2017 Nationals (127 HR), 2019 Nationals (125 HR) and 2016 Nationals (123 HR).

NAS (H)IM
Nasim Nuñez is 20-for-54 (.370) with a double, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, eight walks, seven stolen bases and 11 runs scored over his last 18 games.

- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 32 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

ROLLIN' RUIZ
Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers (min. 125 PA) with a .333 batting average, a .924 OPS and is third with a .556 slugging percentage in 33 games since May 7.

- He's hitting .333 with 11 doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 22 runs since that date.

CREWSIN'
Dylan Crews is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with three doubles, a homer, three RBI, five walks, one hit by pitch, three stolen bases and nine runs scored over his last 12 games...He's hit safely in nine of the 12...He has a .386 on-base percentage and a .431 slugging percentage over this stretch.

- Crews has nine infield hits this season, tied for third-most on the club despite playing in just 39 games so far and tied for fifth-most in MLB since he was recalled on May 19.

SAVES ON SAVES
 The Washington Nationals have had 10 separate pitchers record at least one save this season, second-most in Major League Baseball behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and Cincinnati Reds (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Clayton Beeter** (6), **Gus Varland** (6), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **PJ Poulin** (3), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1), **Paxton Schultz** (1) and **Justin Lawrence** (1) have all recorded saves.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST APPEARANCE

Littell tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two earned runs on three hits while striking out three against the Baltimore Orioles on June 28 at Camden Yards...He earned the win in the 6-4 victory.

vs. PITTSBURGH

Littell is set to make his sixth career appearance against the Pirates...He's made one start against Pittsburgh and is 0-0 with a 7.27 ERA (7 ER/8.2 IP) and five total strikeouts in total.

STREAKIN'

Littell posted a six-game winning streak May 3 to June 6, tied for the second-longest winning streak in Major League Baseball at the time...He went 6-0 with a 2.27 ERA, a .197 opponents' average and just two home runs allowed in seven games during this streak..

- The six wins were tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez during the streak.
- He ranked among National League pitchers (min. 35.0 IP) in opponents' slugging (5th, .299), home runs per 9.0 innings (6th, 0.50), ERA (7th, 2.27) and opponents' average (9th, .197).

MAY FLOWERS

Littell went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- Was tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski**.

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
