THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY	
On this date in 1961, Paul Richards managed his final game as Orioles manager...The Orioles hit five home runs and RHP Jack Fisher tossed a complete game, despite matching a club-record with 12 walks in an 11-4 win over the Angels at Wrigley Field in Los Angeles...1B Jim Gentile, OF Jackie Brandt, OF Earl Robinson, SS Ron Hansen, and 2B Jerry Adair each homered in the win...Luman Harris took over as interim manager the next day and guided the club to a 17-10 record for the remainder of the season.	

TRADE WINDS: This morning, the Orioles acquired two players to be named later from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for LHP Tommy Milone...Milone was signed by the Orioles as a minor league free agent on February 14, 2020...The 10-year Major League veteran made six starts this season, going 1-4 with a 3.99 ERA (13 ER/29.1 IP) while fanning 31.

THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: INF Hanser Alberto went 1-for-4 on Saturday night at Buffalo's Sahlen Field...Since the start of the 2019 season, Alberto leads the majors with 100 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .405 (100-for-247) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks third in the AL and ninth in the majors with a .328 (43-for-131) average against all pitchers...He leads the AL and ranks second in the majors with 12 doubles...His 14 multi-hit games rank second in the AL and are tied for third-most in the majors.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The Orioles lead the majors with 11 bunt hits this season...OF Cedric Mullins leads the majors with six bunt hits, while INF Hanser Alberto ranks second in the majors with three bunt hits and INF/OF Andrew Velazquez is tied for third in the majors with two bunt hits.

BUFFALO WILD THINGS: The Toronto Blue Jays home ballpark for the 2020 season is Sahlen Field in Buffalo...The Blue Jays have called the park "home" since August 11.

☯ According to ESPN Stats and Info, 2020 marks the first time that Buffalo has hosted Major League regular season games since the Buffalo Buffeds/Blues of the short-lived Federal League called the city home from 1914-15.

☯ It's been nearly 105 years since a team from Baltimore last played a Major League game in the city of Buffalo...On September 8, 1915, the Baltimore Terrapins were swept in a doubleheader (4-0, 5-4) by the Buffalo Blues at Federal League Park...The games of that day were the last Major League games played in Buffalo prior to 2020.

☯ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, this series in Buffalo marks the first regular season games played at a non-Major League ballpark in Orioles history (since 1954).

ROAD WARRIORS: At 8-5 (.615), the O's own the fourth-best road record in the AL and sixth-best in the majors...Tuesday's loss at Tampa Bay was the O's first loss on the road since Opening Day at Boston...O's hitters rank second the AL and rank third in the majors with a .279 team batting average on the road...The Orioles rank second in the AL and rank sixth in the majors with a .776 team OPS on the road...O's pitchers own a 4.08 ERA (52 ER/114.2 IP) in 13 games on the road this season to rank fourth in the AL and eighth in the majors.

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: OF Anthony Santander went 2-for-4 on Saturday night and has hit safely in 20 of his last 22 games...His recent hitting streak of 18 games marked a career high...Santander hit .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI from August 5 [2]-23...It was the longest stretch by an Oriole since Nick Markakis' 18-game mark from April 21-May 11, 2014.

☯ Santander's 10 home runs on the season lead the Orioles, are tied for seventh in the AL, and are tied for 10th in the majors...He ranks fifth in the AL and is tied for sixth in the majors with 28 RBI this season...22 of his 36 hits have been for extra-bases (11 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs) and leads the majors with 22 extra-base hits.

CATCH THIS: The O's catching corps of Pedro Severino, Chance Sisco, and Bryan Holaday ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks 12th in the AL with a .303 (27-for-89) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The O's have been one of the more successful teams in baseball when swinging at the first pitch...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.429) and OPS (1.178), rank second in extra-base hits (22), lead the AL and are tied for first in the majors in doubles (13), and lead the AL and rank sixth in the majors in hits (51) as a team on the first pitch.

☯ OF Anthony Santander leads the Orioles with nine hits on the first pitch...He is tied for seventh-most in the majors and is tied for second in the AL...Hanser Alberto and Renato Núñez are tied for 13th in the AL with six hits each on the first pitch of an at-bat.

☯ Santander is tied for second in the majors with five extra-base hits on the first pitch, while C Pedro Severino is tied for eighth in the majors with four extra-base hits on the first pitch.

INJURED LIST: Seven players are on the Injured List...RHP Shawn Armstrong (left SI joint inflammation), INF Chris Davis (left knee patellar tendinitis), RHP Hunter Harvey (right forearm strain), and OF Austin Hays (non-displaced rib fracture), are on the 10-day Injured List...LHP Wade LeBlanc (left elbow stress reaction), INF/OF Trey Mancini (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and INF Richie Martin (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

COACHING STAFF: The O's named Fredi González as Major League Coach, Darren Holmes as Bullpen Coach, and Anthony Sanders as First Base Coach...José Hernández shifted from Major League Coach to Assistant Hitting Coach...All other coaches remained in their same positions from the 2019 season: Doug Brocail as Pitching Coach, Tim Cossins as Major League Field Coordinator/Catching Instructor, José Flores as Third Base Coach, and Don Long as Hitting Coach.

THE SKIPPER: Brandon Hyde was named the 20th manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Most recently, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)...Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

LAST START: Lopez will make his first start of the season (fifth appearance)... Will be his fourth outing with Baltimore after starting the year in Kansas City...Was claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16 vs. WSH...His last appearance came on 8/25 at TB, where he tossed a scoreless inning of relief in the bottom of the eighth, allowing one hit and one walk.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: In three career appearances (one start) against Toronto, is 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP) and five strikeouts...Last faced the Blue Jays on 7/29/19 in Kansas City as a member of the Royals, retiring the only batter he faced in relief on three pitches...His lone start came in his first career appearance against Toronto on 8/15/18, where he took the loss after allowing six runs (all earned) on eight hits, one home run, and two walks with three strikeouts over 4.2 innings of work.

FACING THE AL EAST: In his career, Lopez has made 12 appearances (seven starts) against the AL East, and holds a 2-3 record with a 5.98 ERA (29 ER/43.2 IP) and 35 strikeouts...AL East opponents are batting .276 (47-for-170) with seven home runs against Lopez in his career.

FOR STARTERS: Lopez is 6-13 with a 6.42 ERA (93 ER/130.1 IP) in 27 career starts...Is 5-7 with a 5.77 ERA (47 ER/73.1 IP) in 15 career road starts...His last start came in his final game of last season on 9/29/19 vs. MIN, where he took a no-decision after allowing four runs on six hits with three strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work...Made a career-high 18 starts for the Royals last season and recorded a 6.57 ERA (63 ER/86.1 IP) with 71 strikeouts and a .287 opponent’s average (98-for-341)...Opened last season in the Royals starting rotation, but went 0-6 with a 7.07 ERA (39 ER/49.2 IP) over his first 10 starts...Went 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP) and .232 opponents’ average (22-for-95) during a five-start stretch from 8/19/19-9/17/19, including back-to-back wins on 9/6/19 at MIA and 9/12/19 at CWS...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in the 3-0 win at MIA, marking his first career scoreless start.

OH, THE RELIEF: Has pitched in 36 career games as a reliever, working to a 1-2 record with a 5.24 ERA (40 ER/68.2 IP)...As a reliever, opponents have hit .277 (74-for-267) against him...Earned his first career save 8/25/19 at CLE, recording a scoreless bottom of the 10th inning...Collected eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of relief on 5/29/19 vs. CWS, the most strikeouts by a Royals reliever since Bruce Chen (also 8) on 6/28/14 vs. LAA.

RIGHT OVER LEFT: Lopez has had far greater success against righties than against lefties in his career, holding right-handers to a .266 average (102-for-383), compared to left-handers who are batting .310 (125-for-403) against him... In 2019, Lopez held right-handed batters to a .241 average (59-for-245), including a .118 average (6-for-51) over 15 appearances from 6/21-8/19...Opposing left-handed batters hit .332 (81-for-244) against him in 2019...So far in 2020, lefties are batting .375 (6-for-16) against him, compared to righties who are batting .261 (6-for-23).

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the entire season with Kansas City...Made the Opening Day roster for the first time and set career highs in wins (4), appearances (39), starts (18), innings (123.2) and strikeouts (109)...Posted a 4-9 record with a 6.33 ERA (87 ER/123.2 IP) in his 39 appearances (18 starts) with the Royals.
