**THE WORD ON THE BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals begin their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days, first against their arch rivals, the Chicago Cubs, for three games beginning tonight. The remaining opponents on the homestand include the Texas Rangers (June 1-3) and Cincinnati Reds (June 5-7).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in third place in the National League Central 4.5 games out of first place and a half-game behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals enter on a four-game losing streak, tied for their longest of the season, and since a five-game stretch from Sept. 8-13, 2025 to Seattle and Milwaukee.

**VELÁZQUEZ & CROOKS PROMOTED TO ST. LOUIS:** The Cardinals made a series of transactions today promoting OF **Nelson Velázquez** and C **Jimmy Crooks** from Memphis (AAA). INF **César Prieto** and C **Yohel Pozo** were optioned to Memphis (AAA). Velazquez batted .232 with 7 HR, 22 RBI in 40 games, with a .308-5-15 May. Crooks' 13 HR rank 2nd on the Redbirds roster and 4th in the International League.

**UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS:** Tonight starts a string of seven straight night games for the Cardinals. St. Louis is 19-10 (.655) in night games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB behind Atlanta (.707, 29-12) and Tampa Bay (.667, 20-10). The Chicago Cubs, owners of the most home day games in MLB each season, are 18-11 (.621) for the 6th-best record in night games this season.

**FREE TV:** Tonight's game is the first of three straight that will be broadcast on free, over-the-air television (KMOV 4-CBS, KTVI 2-FOX, KSDK 5-NBC), marking the first instance that three Cardinals regular season telecasts will be accessible on over-the-air local channels since August 10-12, 2007 when the team's three-game weekend series versus the Los Angeles Dodgers was televised on KSDK (Friday, Sunday) and KTVI (Saturday).

**CLUB FLIP:** With an off day and a doubleheader over the last road trip, the Cardinals have flipped their rotation starting **Andre Pallante** tonight and moving **Kyle Leahy** back-to-back with **Matthew Liberatore**.

**NOOT NEWS:** Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** has played seven games during his injury rehabilitation assignment batting .316 (6-19) with 2 HR, 4 RBI and a 1.065 OPS. He's currently on assignment in Springfield (AA), with previous stops in Palm Beach (A) and Memphis (AAA).

**Phil Maton** pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

**Jon Jay** played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

**Lars Nootbaar** and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured **Jameson Taillon** on the pitching staff.

**Daniel Descalso** played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

**Brant Brown** was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Cubs Staff Assistant **AJ Lewis** played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

**Nolan Gorman** won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Mark Weisman** was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

## N.L. RANKINGS: Wins (5, T-10th)

## TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Making his 11th start of the 2026 season tonight; it's his 72nd career start (180th career appearance).
- Has pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first 10 starts, longest streak by a Cardinal since **Sonny Gray** ran off 12 straight last season from July-September. His 10 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season is longest since Gray ran off 10 to begin 2024. The last Cardinal to put together 11+ starts of 5.0+ IP to begin a season was **Carlos Martinez** who in 2017 worked 5.0+ IP in 31 straight to begin the year, one shy of doing so in each of his 32 games started (4.1 IP in his final start that year vs. CHI).
- **This start continues a pattern of having alternated Home & Road starts to begin the season; won his last four road starts and dropped his last four home starts.**
- Is trying to snap a 4-game losing streak at Busch Stadium dating back to his lone Home win on 3/31 vs. NYM; Has received zero runs in support in his last two Home starts and just 5 total run for a 1.61 RSA at Busch Stadium in 2026.
- Averaging 8.00 RSA on the road and 1.61 at home. Has yet to receive more than 2 runs in a home start or less than 3 runs in a road start.
- His 180th career appearance tonight ties him with **Chris Carpenter** for 69th all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 180 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 70 or more starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (71), wins (29), innings pitched (515.0) and strikeouts (364).**
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** (60-day IL) for most among active Cardinals.

## LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, May 23 at Cincinnati - Game 1): W, 8-1; 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 93 pitches.

- Improved to 2-2 as a starter at Great American Ball Park, where he owns a 2.35 ERA.
- The win was the Cardinals lone win on just completed road trip ( 1-1 at CIN & 0-3 at MIL).
- Remained undefeated in road games as he stands at 4-0 with a 2.67 ERA on the road.

## 2026 NOTES:

**ROAD HOUSE:** Posted the lone Cardinals win on recent CIN/MIL road trip, winning the opening game of DH on 5/23 at CIN to improve to 4-0 on the road.

**3 TURNS:** Pitched into the 7th inning vs. KC (5/17) with a season-high 6.2 innings and 27 batters faced in a 2-0 loss.

**THE STATE OF WINNING:** With a win in Sacramento (5/12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

**SLIDE ON IN:** Is holding opposing batters to a .154 BA (10-65) with his slider, and 23 of his 43 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

**COUNT ON ME:** Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all 10 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in five of those games.

**IF AT FIRST:** Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .913 OPS, 10 runs and 3 HRs in 1st inning and batters are hitting .381 (8-21) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

**BITTER BREW:** Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

**AHOY MATEY:** Pitched a then season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

**TRI-DENT:** Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

**SPACE TRAVELER:** Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

**MARCH MADNESS:** Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

## CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-16 in his 35 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-19 in those games.
- **Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (62.7%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.**
- As a starting pitcher (377.1 IP), Pallante's 59.3 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 370.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

## PALLANTE VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- Makes his 13th career appearance (6th start) against the Cubs; He's 0-4 with a 4.40 ERA (28.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts vs. the Cubs.
- Among teams he's faced 10+ career times, the Cubs (0-4) and Brewers (0-3) are lone teams he's yet to record a win against.
- In five career starts vs. CHI, is 0-4 with a 5.85 ERA (20.0 IP) and 10 strikeouts, while receiving four total runs of support (STL is 1-4).
- Made a relief appearance vs. Cubs at London Stadium (June 25, 2023). Pitched a scoreless 8th inning allowing one hit and recorded a Hold, setting up Jordan Hicks for the save in the 9th inning.
- Has made 25 career starts against the NL Central Division since 2022, is 8-12 with a 3.65 ERA (133.0 IP) and 96 strikeouts. He's allowed 1 run or fewer in 11 of those 25 starts.
