**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Astros (2-1), Blue Jays (3-0) and Twins (three to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...have won a season-high-tying five straight games (also: April 23-27), the longest active streak in the majors...are 10-5 in their last 15 games, 12-8 in their last 20 and 17-12 in their last 29...have gone 8-4 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days (May 13-June 1) and 5-1 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19-June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...have already played a majors-most 34 home games...are at .500 for the fifth time, first since entering play on April 29 (14-14)...were last above the mark entering play on April 5 (4-3)...have sole possession of second place in the AL East for the first time since entering play on April 3...have spent two days in first, five in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays completed their second series sweep of the campaign with yesterday's 13-0 win over the Blue Jays, joining April 25-27 at SD...it tied the second-largest shutout win in club history, trailing only a 14-0 win on July 29, 2021 vs. NYY...it was their fourth shutout victory this season and first at home since April 1 vs. PIT (7-0). Tampa Bay has won two straight, four of five and seven of its last 10 series, including a season-high four consecutive series wins at Steinbrenner Field.
- ★ The Rays have not trailed since falling behind, 2-0, in the top of the 1st on Wed. vs. HOU, going 35 innings since their last deficit...their set with the Blue Jays marked their first in which they never trailed since March 30-April 1, 2023 vs. DET (min. 3G).
- ★ They are 7-2 in their last nine home games, including five straight wins, on the heels of a 1-11 stretch from April 15-May 8.
- ★ The Rays are 8-14 on Memorial Day, going 4-5 at home...their last game on the holiday came on May 29, 2023 at CHC (L, 1-0), and their last win was May 31, 2021 at NYY (3-1)...this marks the Rays first time hosting a Memorial Day game since May 27, 2019 vs. TOR (W, 8-3)...it marks their second Memorial Day game against the Twins, joining a 7-3 win on May 31, 2004 at the Metrodome.

### STREAK SZN

- ★ The club has won a season-high-tying five straight games, outscoring opponents, 30-8 (+22)...its last longer streak was seven games from June 3 (G2)-9, 2023.
- ★ Rays pitchers have not allowed a run in 11 consecutive innings...their longest streak this season is 19 straight scoreless frames from April 24-26.
- ★ Tampa Bay has gone a season-high six straight games without committing an error, its longest streak since June 19-26, 2024 (8G).
- ★ **Brandon Lowe** has tallied an extra-base hit in five straight games, tied for the second-longest active streak in MLB behind **ATH Lawrence Butler** (6G) and tied for the second longest of his career (7G: Aug. 9-15, 2020)...the last Ray with a longer streak was **Mike Zunino** (6G) from Aug. 10-17, 2021.
- ★ Lowe also has an eight-game hitting streak (10-for-27/.370), his longest since a 10-game run from Aug. 9-19, 2020.
- ★ **Chandler Simpson** is riding a 10-game hitting streak, tied for the fifth-longest active streak in MLB and the longest by a Rays rookie since **Randy Arozarena** (12G) from June 3-21, 2021...Simpson is three games shy of the longest streak by a rookie in club history (13G), a mark shared by **Rocco Baldelli** (2003) and **Delmon Young** (2007).
- ★ **Curtis Mead** has homered in a career-high three straight games, the longest active streak in MLB, tying **Junior Caminero** (April 12-14) for the longest run by a Ray in 2025...**Brandon Lowe** has the most recent longer streak (4G from April 8-11, 2023)...
- ★ Mead entered the streak with 2 HR in his first 90 career games.
- ★ Mead also has a career-high seven-game hitting streak (8-for-19/.421) and has recorded an extra-base hit in a career-best four straight games.
- ★ Caminero has a career-high-tying three-game XBH streak (3x, last: April 12-14, 2025).
- ★ The Rays have won each of **Zack Littell**'s last five starts after losing his first five...it marks the club's longest streak in a pitcher's starts since winning six straight **Zach Eflin** outings from May 7-June 16, 2024.
- ★ Rays starters have earned the win in four straight outings, their longest streak since April 5-9, 2023 (4GS)...their last longer streak was from July 12-25, 2014 (8GS)...the rotation had four wins in their previous 20 starts (April 29-May 20).

**OFFENSIVE OFFENSE**—The Rays erupted for 13 runs yesterday, their second most this season behind a 16-1 win on April 14 vs. BOS...in their 27-minute, seven-run 5th inning, each of their first nine batters reached without making an out, tied for the longest streak to open a frame in team history, according to Stats Perform (also: June 25, 2008 at FLA - 5th inn)...it marked their most consecutive batters reaching safely at any point in a frame since July 29, 2021 at NYY (11 straight - 6th inn)...a season-high 11 different Rays reached base, tied for the most in a nine-inning game in club history (15x, last: Sept. 2, 2022 vs. NYY).

- ★ The Rays have scored seven runs or more 11 times, tied for fourth most in the AL behind the Tigers (16G), Yankees (16G) and Red Sox (13G).
- ★ The Rays have belted 9 HR in their last four games after hitting 1 HR in their previous five...they have 17 HR in their last 12 games since May 13, tied with the Red Sox for second most in the AL over that span behind the Angels (22HR).
- ★ **Brandon Lowe** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .386/.438/.795 (17-for-44) with 3 2B, 5 HR and 11 RBI, over that span (since May 13), he is second in the AL in average, slugging pct. and OPS while ranking third in total bases (35).
- ★ **Junior Caminero** went 5-for-11 (.455) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI last series...he logged his fifth career multi-XBH game yesterday (last: April 29 vs. KC - 2B, HR).
- ★ **Chandler Simpson** has 32 hits, 14 stolen bases and no errors—no other major league player since 1901 has matched that stat line through 31 career games (Stats Perform).

### PITCHING IN

- ★ Rays pitchers have allowed two runs in their last 28 innings, four in their last 35 and six in their last 42...the staff permitted only two runs in the sweep over the Blue Jays, tied with April 1-3, 2019 vs. COL for the fewest in a series of three-games or more in franchise history...it marks their first time yielding two runs or fewer over any three-game span since Sept. 19-21, 2024 (2R)...tonight, they look to allow one or zero runs in four straight games for the third time in franchise history...would join March 30-April 3, 2019 (5G) and Sept. 24-27, 2000 (4G).
- ★ Rays pitching has produced a 1.60 ERA (45.0IP, 8ER) during the club's five-game winning streak, including a 1.52 ERA (29.2IP, 5ER) from starters...the rotation has yielded two runs or fewer in five straight outings for the first time since a season-opening six-start streak from March 28-April 2.
- ★ The Rays have spun a 2.15 ERA (71.0IP, 17ER) over their last eight games overall, with the bullpen pitching to a 1.54 ERA (23.1IP, 4ER) in that span.

**TWINNING**—The Rays and Twins open a six-game season series tonight...the clubs will meet in Minneapolis from July 4-6...the Rays went 4-3 against them last season, claiming back-to-back season series wins (2023-24) for the first time since 2016-18 to improve to 11-3-3 in season series since 2007...six of the seven meetings were one-run games, and all three road games were decided in the final at-bat...eight of the last nine matchups overall have been decided by one run dating back to Sept. 12, 2023, Tampa Bay's most one-run affairs vs. any opponent in that span...the Rays are 10-4 in the last 14 meetings dating back to June 12, 2022 and 6-2 in their last eight home games against the Twins...they went 3-0-1 in series play vs. Minnesota from 2023-24 after losing six of eight sets from 2018-22.

- ★ The Rays have lost eight straight games against AL Central opponents dating back to Sept. 14, 2024 at CLE, their longest streak since June 20-Aug. 16, 2016 (9G).
- ★ **Josh Lowe** is a career .304 (17-for-56) hitter in 15 games against the Twins...**Yandy Diaz** is batting .375 (15-for-40) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI and a 1.105 OPS in his last nine games against Minnesota dating back to Sept. 11, 2023.
- ★ Twins manager **Rocco Baldelli** was Tampa Bay's first-round selection (No. 6 overall) in 2000 and spent six of his seven MLB seasons with the club...he joined the Rays front office in 2011 and was a member of **Kevin Cash**'s coaching staff from 2015-18.

**MINOR MATTERS**—Class-A Charleston **OF Theo Gillen** was named Carolina League Player of the Week for May 19-25 after going 8-for-19 (.421) with 1 2B, 2 HR (one inside-the-park HR), 4 RBI and 2 SB...Tampa Bay's first-round selection (No. 18 overall) in 2024, the 19-year-old Gillen opened the season on the injured list (left calf strain), but ranks second in the Carolina League with a .994 OPS since his April 27 debut...Rays farmhands have claimed a league honor in eight consecutive weeks, the longest active streak in baseball...the organization's 12 total weekly awards are the most among all farm systems.

**TONIGHT’S START**—Zack Littell will make his 11th start of the campaign and his first against Minnesota...marks his 58th career start (213G) and his fourth against the Twins (6G)...has allowed three runs or fewer in seven straight starts, recording a 3.19 ERA (42.1IP, 15ER)...is looking to extend his winning streak to four games, which would be the longest of his career as a starter...is in his second season as a full-time starter after joining the Rays rotation in July 2023...claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Littell worked 5.0 innings on May 20 vs. HOU, but was left with a no-decision...he allowed two runs on seven hits (1HR) and one hit batter with six strikeouts...he permitted back-to-back doubles to open the 2nd inning from Victor Caratini and Jake Meyers...the right-hander also allowed a home run to Isaac Paredes in the 3rd frame...he finished strong, sitting down seven of the final nine batters he faced...the Rays have won each of his last five starts (April 27–pres.).

- ✦ Littell has surrendered three runs or fewer in 12 of his last 14 starts dating back to Sept. 8, 2024...owns a 3.40 ERA (82.0IP, 31ER) in that span and has held opponents to a .231 (71-for-307) average.
- ✦ He has limited the opposition to a 11-for-47 (.234) clip against his split-finger over his last six starts...in his first three, he recorded a .333 (6-for-18) opp. average on the pitch.

**COLD LIKE MINNESOTA**—Littell will be making his fifth career appearance (third start) opposite the Twins...he is 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (18.0ER, 9ER) and 16 strikeouts in the previous four...he last faced Minnesota on Sept. 2, 2024 at Tropicana Field and went 4.0 innings with four runs allowed on seven hits, four walks and one home run with two strikeouts in a losing decision...his teams are 1-4 in games he pitches against the Twins, and 1-2 in his starts.

- ✦ He has made 41 career appearances (13GS) vs. AL Central clubs...pitched to a 3.70 ERA (107.0IP, 44ER)...this is his first game against an AL Central opponent this season and first since Sept. 25, 2024 at DET (L, 4.2IP, 7H, 3R, 7SO, 1HR).

**ZACK IS BACK**—In his last five starts, all Rays wins, Littell is 3-0 with a 3.26 ERA (30.1IP, 11ER)...he has received three runs or more of support in four of the five outings (4.45 RSA)...in his first five starts entering that stretch, all Rays losses, he was 0-5 with a 5.28 ERA (29.0IP, 17ER) and received a total of four runs of support (1.24 RSA).

- ✦ Since he permitted 12 ER over a two-start span from April 4-10, five of Littell’s last seven starts have been quality...his six quality starts are tied with Taj Bradley for second in the Rays rotation behind Ryan Pepiot (7).

**DIG DEEP**—Opponents are batting .182 (12-for-66) against Littell with two outs compared to .289 (46-for-159) with one or zero outs...it marks the fifth-lowest two-out average among qualified AL pitchers, trailing HOU Framber Valdez (.127), NYY Carlos Rodón (.143) and BAL Tomoyuki Sugano (.179) and DET Tarik Skubal (.179)...opponents are 9-for-35 (.257) against him with runners in scoring position, but have gone 2-for-14 (.143) with RISP and two outs.

**A LITTELL HELP, PLEASE?**—Littell’s 2.88 runs support average is fifth lowest in the AL...since joining the Rays rotation, he is 10-1 with a 3.24 ERA (100.0IP, 36ER) over 19 starts in which he received three runs of support or more—the Rays are 16-3 in those games...in 34 starts with two runs or fewer, he has gone 4-19 with a 3.95 ERA (187.0IP, 82ER), and the Rays are 9-25 in those contests.

- ✦ Since the start of 2024, his 3.13 run support average is second lowest in the majors behind SEA Logan Gilbert (3.13) (min. 150.0IP).
- ✦ Littell has received at least three runs of support in four of his last five starts, after seeing four total runs in his first five starts, including four starts with one or zero runs of support...since the start of 2024, he has seen three or fewer runs of support in 34 of 39 starts, including 28 with two runs or fewer and 15 with one or zero.

**RUNNING OUT OF GAS**—He has allowed 18 of his 28 runs (65.4%) in the 3rd (11) and 5th (7) frames...in innings 1-2, Littell has pitched to a 3.15 ERA (20.0IP, 7ER) with a 1.00 WHIP and .230 (17-for-74) opp. average with 3 HR...from the 3rd inning on, he has recorded a 4.81 ERA (39.1IP, 21ER), 1.22 WHIP and .272 (41-for-151) opp. average with 11 HR.

**DON’T WALK THIS WAY**—Since his Rays debut on May 16, 2023, Littell’s 4.0 pct. walk rate ranks third in the majors (min. 1,000BF) behind SEA George Kirby (2.9%) and BAL Zach Eflin (3.5%)...he has issued one or zero walks in 43 of his 53 starts with the Rays and two walks or fewer in 50 of them.

**2024 RECAP**—Littell went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA (156.1IP, 63ER) over 29 starts in his seventh major league season and second with the Rays, leading the club in starts and innings...posted his lowest ERA since 2021 (2.92) and ranked fifth in the AL (min. 150.0IP) in walk rate (4.7%)...went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (49.1IP, 10ER) over his final nine starts—entered that stretch at 3-7 with a 4.46 ERA (107.0IP, 53ER) through his first 20...recorded a 3.16 ERA (57.0IP, 20ER) in 10 starts against AL East opponents...had one stint on the 15-day IL (right shoulder fatigue) from Aug. 15–Sept. 1, missing 15 games...marked his first full season as a starter after joining the club’s rotation in July 2023.
