## YESTERDAY'S NEWS:

The Orioles defeated the Reds yesterday, 6-2, in the first game of the three-game series at Great American Ball Park.  
 ○ The Orioles overcame a 2-0 deficit to earn their 23<sup>rd</sup> comeback win of the season, one shy of their 2021 total; their 23 comeback wins are tied for second in the AL and tied for seventh in MLB this season.  
 ○ In his first start since being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List, **Kyle Bradish** did not factor in the decision, allowing two runs on five hits (one home run) with seven strikeouts and a wild pitch over 5.0 innings; marked his second start with at least seven strikeouts and zero walks, joining May 10 at St. Louis (11 K).  
 ○ Orioles pitchers combined for 11 strikeouts; the O's are 15-7 when they record double-digit strikeouts this season.

**BALTI .500:** The Orioles won their 51<sup>st</sup> game of the season yesterday and are 51-49...They are two games above .500 this late in a season for the first time since finishing the day 71-69 on September 7, 2017...They are over .500 at the 100-game mark for the first time since 2016 (58-42)...The 2021 O's did not win their 51<sup>st</sup> game until game 157 on September 28, the 2019 Birds did not win their 51<sup>st</sup> game until game 156 on September 22, and the 2018 Orioles only won 47 games.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** Baltimore has won 16 of their last 21 games, 21 of the last 31, 24 of the last 36, 27 of the last 41, 31 of the last 51, and 37 of the last 62...Entering today's games, the O's .659 winning percentage (27-14) since June 11 is the second-best in the AL and the fourth-best in MLB over that time (see chart at right)...The team had a 10-game winning streak from July 3-13, tied for the fifth-longest in a single season in O's history (since 1954) and the longest since the team won 13 in a row from September 7-22, 1999.

**SUMMER SURGE:** The O's have gone 16-7 in July, their second consecutive winning month after they went 14-12 in June...Their .696 winning percentage this month ranks second in the AL and third in MLB...Prior to last month, the O's did not have a winning month since August 2017 (17-12) and the last time Baltimore had a winning record in back-to-back months was May (14-13) and June (19-9) 2016...The Orioles have outscored their opponents 107-81 (+26) this month; on the season, Baltimore's run differential is now zero (421-421).

**THEY'RE NASTY:** The Baltimore bullpen owns a 2.99 ERA (136 ER/410.0 IP) through their first 100 games of the year, the third-lowest bullpen ERA in MLB (see chart at right)...Last year, O's relievers finished the season with a 5.68 ERA (421 ER/666.2 IP), the worst in MLB...In the month of July, the Orioles' pen leads MLB with a 2.36 ERA (24 ER/91.1 IP) in 23 games...O's relievers rank second with 110 strikeouts this month, while their 26 walks allowed are the fewest in the majors, giving them an MLB-leading 4.23 K/BB ratio in July...The Baltimore bullpen has worked 11 scoreless outings this month (39.1 IP), in which the Orioles have gone 11-0.

○ **Félix Bautista** owns a scoreless streak of 8.2 innings over his last eight outings since July 8; he has not allowed a hit (0-for-25) during this span while tallying 14 strikeouts (14.54 K/9) to just one walk for a 0.12 WHIP...His eight-game hitless streak is tied for the sixth-longest streak by a pitcher in O's history (since 1954); the last Oriole with such a streak was Tanner Scott, who had an eight-game streak sin 2020.

**TONY'S TATERS:** **Anthony Santander** clubbed his team-leading 18<sup>th</sup> home run of the season yesterday, tallying a season-high-tying three hits (3x, last: May 19 vs. New York-AL)...He extended his hitting streak to a season-high nine games, the fourth-longest active streak in the AL and sixth-longest in MLB...During his current streak, he is slashing .371/.450/.714 (13-for-35) with three doubles, three home runs, seven runs scored, eight RBI, a 1.164 OPS, and three-multi-hit efforts.

**STARTING TO AD UP:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely multiple times in eight consecutive games, the longest streak by a rookie since St. Louis' Edmundo Sosa had an eight-game streak in 2021, and the longest by an O's rookie since Boog Powell did so in eight straight games in 1962...Rutschman has drawn a walk in seven straight games, tied with Houston's Yordan Álvarez for the longest active stretch in MLB; it is the longest streak by an O's batter since **Trey Mancini** drew a walk in eight consecutive games from September 3-14, 2021...Rutschman is slashing .327/.477/.571 (16-for-49) with six doubles, two homers, 13 runs scored, seven RBI, 13 walks, and two HBP in 17 games since July 6...His .477 on-base percentage leads MLB during that time and his 1.048 OPS over that period is fifth-best in the AL (min. 60 PA).

**DEFENSIVE TACTICS:** The Orioles rank tied for fifth in MLB with 40 defensive runs saved (DRS), per *Sports Info Solutions*...Baltimore finished 24<sup>th</sup> with -30 DRS in 2021, tied for 16<sup>th</sup> with 1 DRS in 2020, 28<sup>th</sup> with -53 DRS in 2019, and 28<sup>th</sup> with -42 DRS in 2018.

- **Jorge Mateo** is tied for the second among shortstops and tied for 10<sup>th</sup> in MLB with 10 DRS.
- **Ramón Urias** ranks tied for fifth among third basemen with eight DRS.
- **Cedric Mullins** ranks fourth among MLB center fielders with seven DRS.
- **Adley Rutschman** is tied for seventh among MLB catchers with five DRS; he ranks fifth in MLB with a 50.0 percent strike rate and in the top seven percent of the league with two catcher framing runs, per *Statcast*.
- **Ryan Mountcastle** leads the AL and is second among MLB first basemen with four outs above average (OAA), per *Statcast*; **Trey Mancini** is tied for second in the AL and tied for third among MLB first basemen with three OAA, per *Statcast*.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** **Terrin Vavra** made his MLB debut last night as a pinch runner in the ninth inning...Became the sixth player this season to make his MLB debut as a pinch runner and the first O's player to do so since L.J. Hoes on September 25, 2012 vs. Toronto...He is the 10<sup>th</sup> O's player to make his MLB debut this year and the fourth position player...The club record for the most MLB debuts in a season is 16 in 2021...Vavra, 25, is ranked as the No. 12 prospect in the O's system by *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*.

**O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO:** The Orioles are currently on a six-game road trip with three games in Cincinnati against the Reds (1-0) and three games in Texas against the Rangers (0-0)...Marks Baltimore's first road trip of the second half...The O's went 3-2 (.600) on their last road trip from July 12-17 against the Chicago Cubs (2-0) and Tampa Bay Rays (1-2); marked their best winning percentage on a road trip this season.

**UNFAMILIAR FACES:** The Orioles have only faced the Reds 13 times in team history, going 9-4 in those games; Baltimore's 13 games against the Reds are their fewest against any active franchise...The two teams first met in 2005.

**SIGNED, SEALED, AND DELIVERED:** This week, the Orioles signed the first overall selection of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, infielder **Jackson Holliday**, from Stillwater High School (OK)...The 2022 First-Year Player Draft marked the third time in Orioles history that the club had the first overall selection in the MLB Draft, joining 2019, when the club selected catcher **Adley Rutschman** out of Oregon State University, and 1989, when they selected right-handed pitcher **Ben McDonald** out of Louisiana State University...Holliday is the son of 15-year MLB veteran and seven-time All-Star **Matt Holliday**...The O's have signed 16 of their 22 selections from the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, including each of their top four picks and 11 of their top 12.

**30 YEARS OF OPACY:** The Orioles will celebrate the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Oriole Park at Camden Yards from August 5-7 as they take on the Pittsburgh Pirates. **QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 10<sup>th</sup> start of the year, fifth on the road, and first against Cincinnati...Has not surrendered a run in a night game this season...Had his career-high 22.2 scoreless inning streak snapped in the fifth inning on July 4 vs. Texas...Acquired by the Orioles along with **INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Diaz**, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV...Became the first Israeli citizen to be selected in the First-Year Player Draft... Pitched for Israel's National Team in the 2017 World Baseball Classic and was named Israel's Most Valuable Pitcher in 2014 and 2015 after helping the team qualify for the European Baseball Championship.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his first loss since June 5 vs. Cleveland on July 24 vs. New York-AL...Pitched 5.1 innings and allowed four runs on five hits (one home run) with one walk, one hit batter, and six strikeouts...Has allowed at least three earned runs in three of his last four starts...Surrendered a home run in back-to-back outings for the first time this season...Has hit a batter in three straight starts...Threw 83 pitches, 55 strikes.

**LEAN, DEAN, FIGHTING MACHINE:** Had his career-high scoreless streak snapped at 22.2 innings pitched on July 4 vs. Texas; according to *The Elias Sports Bureau* and STATS, he does not get credit for the two outs he recorded in the fifth inning... Marks the longest scoreless streak by an Orioles starter since Mike Mussina pitched 27.0 scoreless innings from September 21, 1995 to April 2, 1996...The last Orioles pitcher with a scoreless streak of at least 22.2 innings was Steve Johnson, who tossed 25.1 scoreless frames across eight games (three starts) from August 25 to September 29, 2012.

**AGAINST THE NL CENTRAL:** Scheduled to make his first career start against a National League Central opponent and his first career interleague start.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Has gone 2-0 with a 1.66 ERA (4 ER/21.2 IP), and a .277 (23-for-83) opponent average in four starts on the road this season...His road ERA ranks fourth in the Major Leagues (min. 4 GS)...Has not suffered a losing decision away from Oriole Park since June 24, 2021 at Toronto.

**LATE IN THE GAME:** Eight of Kremer's 16 runs allowed this year have come in the fifth inning-or-later...Opposing hitters are batting .341 (14-for-41) with six strikeouts in the fifth to seventh innings compared to .250 (34-for-136) with 32 strikeouts in the first through fourth innings combined.

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:** Posted a 7.55 ERA (45 ER/53.2 IP) over a career-high 13 starts, including two quality starts...Named to the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career; made three different stints on the big league roster...Finished the season with 47 strikeouts, the fourth-most among Oriole rookies... Recorded the 50<sup>th</sup> strikeout of his career when he punched out Luke Voit in the third inning on May 14 vs. New York-AL...Became the eighth Oriole to record 50-plus strikeouts in his first 11 career games, and the first since Wei-Yin Chen in 2012...Allowed at least one home run in 11 of his 13 starts and multiple homers in five; 28 of his 46 total runs allowed (60.9%) came via home run.
