AROUND THE HORN

KOREAN HERITAGE NIGHT: Tonight's Korean Heritage Night features a branded hat, recognitions, performances and demonstrations.

LOU GEHRIG DAY: Tomorrow, the D-backs will raise awareness and support for those affected by ALS during Lou Gehrig Day presented by Dignity Health. Doug Clough, who has lived with ALS for 12 years, and Phoenix native Ernie Ruiz, a 24-year U.S. Air Force veteran and ALS advocate who was diagnosed in 2023, will throw out the ceremonial first pitches. Longtime D-backs Advantage Member Henry "Chip" Stoecker, following his recent ALS diagnosis, will serve as reader for Lou Gehrig's iconic "Luckiest Man Alive" speech. Bill Olivier, who has surpassed the typical ALS prognosis, will serve as honorary captain.

JAPANESE HERITAGE NIGHT: Japanese Heritage Night this Wednesday will feature an exclusive jersey, a parade, recognitions and performances.

MEXICAN HERITAGE NIGHT: On Thursday, fans can also enjoy a night of culture, music and dance with Mexican Heritage Night presented by Coors Light. Fans who purchase the Special Event Ticket Pack will receive both a game ticket and a Mexican-inspired D-backs jersey.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 8-1 in their last 9 home games.

- The D-backs resume their stretch of 17 of 20 games vs. NL West opponents after going 11-2 in a 13-game span from May 15-27 (6-0 vs. Giants and 5-2 vs. Rockies).
- Since May 9, the D-backs' 14 wins (14-7) are tied for third most in the Majors (also: Braves and Dodgers), behind the Brewers (15) and White Sox (15).
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 16 straight home starts, hitting .377 (20-for-53)/1.118 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 7 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 3-2 @ Mariners in 10 innings yesterday.

- Merrill Kelly** went decisionless after allowing 2 runs over 5.1 innings (8 H, 2 BB, 2 K).
- Ketel Marte** recorded a RBI sac fly to tie the game at 2-2 in the eighth inning.
- Kevin Ginkel, Brandyn Garcia, Juan Morillo** and **Jonathan Loaisiga** combined for 1 run over 4.0 frames with 2 walks and 7 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated INF **Pavin Smith** from the 60-day IL (left elbow inflammation), optioned INF/OF **Tim Tawa** to Triple-A Reno following yesterday's game and transferred INF **Carlos Santana** to the 60-day IL (strained right adductor).

UPCOMING MILESTONES: **Eduardo Rodriguez** is 1 win shy of 100 for his career.

- The D-backs are 2 wins shy (2,198) of 2,200 regular-season franchise wins as a franchise.
- Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- Torey Lovullo** is 5 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants, L 0-3 @ Mariners).

1-RUN AFFAIRS: The D-backs have had 3 of their last 4 games decided by 1 run (1-2).

- The D-backs' 21 1-run games are tied for most in the Majors (also: Mariners' (21)).
- The D-backs' 11 1-run wins are tied for second in MLB (also: Cardinals), behind the Phillies and White Sox (12).

HOT AT HOME: **Ketel Martel** owns a 9-game home hitting streak, batting .486 (17-for-35)/1.468 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 14 RBI and 4 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has a 6-game home hitting streak, batting .440 (11-for-25)/1.262 OPS with 1 double, 4 triples, 4 RBI and 1 walk, including 3 multi-hit efforts.

NL WEST PLAY: Since April 26, the D-backs' 12 wins and .857 win percentage vs. NL West opponents are tops in the division.

- The D-backs' .301 AVG also leads the division since April 26 (Dodgers .266, Rockies .250, Giants .250 and Padres .213).
- Corbin Carroll**, in his last 12 games vs. NL West opponents, is hitting .367 (18-for-49)/1.130 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks, including 9 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 13 straight games vs. NL West opponents, hitting .310 (13-for-42)/.953 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI, 8 walks and 3 hit-by-pitch.
- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 9 of his last 10 games vs. NL West, hitting .351 (13-for-37)/.959 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks, including 7 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base 12 of his last 13 games and 19 total times (11 H, 7 BB,HBP)/.333 OBP with 2 doubles and 8 RBI.

BULLPEN FOCUS: **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in his last 13 games (10.1 IP) and boasts an opponent .118 AVG (4-for-34)/.280 OPS, 0.58 WHIP, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.

- Jonathan Loaisiga** has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 games (7.1 IP) and is 1-1 with a 0.68 WHIP, 1 walk and 1 strikeout.
- Ryan Thompson**, in his last 11 games, is 1-1 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER in 10.0 IP), 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 17 quality starts in their last 25 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 16 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 159.1), IP/G (1st, 6.1), ERA (2nd, 2.88), BB/9.0 IP (3rd, 1.98), Wins (T-4th, 15), OBP (4th, .273) and WHIP (5th, 1.05).

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs went 3-4 last season at Chase Field and split the last 4-game series.
