**ROSTER MOVE**—The Rays have reinstated SS **Wander Franco** (right quadriceps strain) from the 10-day IL and optioned INF **Jonathan Aranda** to Triple-A Durham...Franco hit .375/.444/.625 (6-for-16) with 2 2B, 1 3B and 2 RBI in five rehab games with the Rookie-level FCL Rays and Durham.

RAY MATTER—Last night's win snapped a streak of four straight series losses, the club's longest drought since Aug 4-20, 2017 (5)...the Rays have won three of their last 4 games after a 2-8 stretch and have won back-to-back games for the first time since June 7-9 vs. STL (3)...the Rays are 4-7 in their last 11 games, 8-11 in their last 19 games and 21-22 in their last 43 games after an 18-10 start to the season...the Rays are in 4th place in the AL East for a sixth straight day, the first time they have been alone in 4th place (or below) at least 50 games into the season since they were 34-40 through June 20, 2018 (4th)...if the postseason started today, four of the AL's six teams would be from the AL East...the Rays hold the AL's third and final Wild Card spot and have a 1-game lead over the Guardians.

- + Last night the Rays won on a walk-off, 2-run single by Isaac Paredes...the Rays have won in walk-off fashion in back-to-back games for the eighth time in club history, first since Sep 20-21, 2019 vs. BOS...for the record, their only time with three straight walk-off wins was May 22-24, 2014...the Rays have five walk-off wins this season, T-3rd in the majors behind the Yankees (9) and Padres (6).
- + The Rays are 3-26 this season when trailing after 8 innings, with the other such wins coming on May 6 at SEA and May 3 at OAK.
- + Today the Rays continue a stretch of 13 games in 13 days from June 24–July 6, with a June 27 off day and July 2 doubleheader at TOR.
- + Since May 26, the Rays are 13-15 and they have seen their divisional deficit grow from 4.5 GB to 12.5 GB...the Rays are averaging 3.54 runs per game since then, 27th in the majors...their .223 avg. ranks 27th over that stretch, .286 OBP ranks 25th and .343 SLG is 29th.
- The Rays are 9-14 in series openers and 7-6 in openers at home.
- + The Rays are 3-6-2 in their last 11 series after a 7-2-0 stretch.
- ullet Rays games are averaging 3:01 this season, 2nd-fastest in MLB.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays have played four straight 1-run games and 11 consecutive games decided by 2 runs (or fewer)...this 11-game streak is the longest in club history, passing April 15-24, 2007 (9), and the longest in the majors since the Orioles (12) from May 8-21, 2017...the Rays have played a majors-most 29 1-run games this season, going 15-14 including 5-8 since June 4 and 7-11 since May 8 after an 8-3 start...the Rays have played 41 games decided by 2 runs (or fewer), most in the majors...the Rays are 21-20 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer), including 11-14 since May 16.

+ The Rays are 7-3 in extras after going 7-12 last season...the 10 extra-inning games rank 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (11).

SEEKING SWEEP—Today the Rays are attempting to sweep the Pirates for the first time in franchise history...with a win today, they would complete a fifth sweep this season and fourth sweep in a series of 3 games (or more)...would join sweeps from April 8-10 vs. BAL (3-0), May 2-4 at OAK (3-0), May 24-25 vs. MIA (2-0) and June 7-9 vs. STL (3-0)...last season the Rays recorded a club-record 14 sweeps, passing their previous high of 12 (2018, 2013)...they had 12 sweeps of 3 games (or more), most in the AL.

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays have a 3.19 ERA this season, 4th in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.94), Yankees (2.94) and Astros (3.03)...they have a 2.59 ERA (104.1-IP, 30-ER) in the last 12 games and have yielded 3 ER (or fewer) eight times over that span...the Rays have a 2.72 ERA in the last 40 games, 1st in the majors since May 11 ahead of the Astros (3.16).

- + Rays pitching has combined for 26 SO and 2 BB so far this series.
- + The Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) 42 times, 3rd in MLB behind the Astros (44) and Yankees (44)...they are 31-11 when yielding 3 runs (or fewer), compared to 8-21 when allowing 4+ runs.
- + Rays starters have a 3.33 ERA this season, 4th in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.63), Yankees (2.97) and the Astros (3.26)...the starters have a 2.77 ERA in 40 games since May 11, best in the majors since then over the Yankees (3.10)...the Rays have used 12 starters, tied for 2nd in MLB behind the Tigers (13)...the starters have combined for 327.1 IP. fewest in the AL and 29th in the majors (PIT. 325 IP).
- + The Rays bullpen ranks 5th in MLB and 4th in the AL with a 3.05 ERA...Rays relievers have a 2.29 ERA in 18 games since June 5...the Rays have seven pitchers with a save, tied for most in the majors... last season they had 14 pitchers with a save, setting a ML record.

**FEAST OR FAMINE**—The Rays are averaging 4.06 runs per game this season, 23rd in the majors and 11th in the AL...this is a 1.23 decrease from their 5.29 runs per game last season, the 3rd-largest in the majors behind the Athletics (-1.44) and Tigers (-1.36)...the Rays have seen the 4th-largest decrease in home runs per game, dropping from 1.37 in 2021 to 0.94 this season...the Rays rank 12th in the AL in avg. (.234), 5th in RISP avg. (.255), 12th in on-base pct. (.297), 12th in slugging (.375) and 10th in homers (67).

- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or more) in four straight games, their 2nd-longest streak of the season behind May 17-25 (7)...they have hit 7 HR in their last 4 games, compared to 3 HR in the previous 9 games...the Rays have reached double-digit hits three times in their last 7 games, compared to three times in the previous 22 games.
- + The Rays are 30-8 when scoring 4 runs (or more) and 23-5 when scoring 5 runs (or more), compared to 9-24 when scoring 3 runs (or fewer)...the Rays are 30-9 when scoring first and 9-23 when their opponent scores first...the Rays are 31-8 when they outhit their opponent and 7-22 when recording fewer hits than their opponent.
- + The Rays have 12 SB in the last 30 games, compared to 34 SB in the first 41 games this season...they rank 3rd in the AL with 46 SB behind the Rangers (61) and Guardians (47) and 1st in the majors with 20 CS...the Rays are 69.7 pct. on steal attempts, 22nd in the majors.
- + This season the Rays are batting .299 (105-for-351) with RISP in the 39 wins, compared to .186 (41-for-221) with RISP in the 32 losses.
- + The Rays have made 33 outs on the bases this season, according to Baseball Reference, most in the majors (Cubs, 29)...the website does not include pickoffs, caught stealing or force plays in this statistic.

UNDER THE LEATHER—The Rays have allowed 46 unearned runs this season, 2nd in the majors behind the White Sox (49) and their most before the All-Star break since 2005 (46)...this is 79.3 pct. of their total (58) from last season, when they didn't allow their 46th until the 108th game (Aug 3)...the Rays have allowed 11 unearned runs in their last 14 games since June 10...they have made 15 errors and yielded 10 unearned runs in their 39 wins, compared to 29 errors and 36 unearned runs in their 32 losses.

- + The Rays are 26-14 in errorless games; 13-18 when making one.
- + The Rays have 44 errors this season, 9th in the majors...they have 24 errors since May 20, 3rd in the majors and most in the AL.
- + Rays catchers have caught 6.8 pct. (3 of 44) of attempted base stealers this season, 29th in the majors, including 0-for-15 in June.

RAYS vs. PIRATES—The Rays are 8-9 all-time against the Pirates...this is the first series between the clubs since June 27-29, 2017 at PIT...it marks the third series all-time at Tropicana Field, following June 23-25, 2014 and June 13-15, 2003...the Rays were scheduled to host them on Opening Day in 2020 until the COVID-19 shutdown resulted in a revised schedule.

- + Pirates Manager Derek Shelton is one of three current managers who are former members of Kevin Cash's coaching staff, along with Charlie Montoyo (Blue Jays) and Rocco Baldelli (Twins)...he spent parts of seven years on the Rays staff as the hitting coach.
- + The Rays are 9-1 in interleague games this season and have won nine straight, tied for the 2nd-longest interleague winning streak in franchise history behind June 9-26, 2004 (13)...since the start of last season, their 24-6 record in interleague games leads the majors over the Red Sox (20-7)...the Rays are 16-1 in interleague home games over that same span, while pitching to a 2.35 ERA at home.

VICTORY PAREDES—Yesterday vs. PIT, Isaac Paredes singled in the 6th, hit a solo homer in the 8th and walk-off, 2-run single in the 9th, the first walk-off hit of his career...in his last 3 games, he is batting .583 (7-for-12) with 5 HR, 8 RBI and 1 HBP in 13 PA...he has homered in all 3 games, tying Manuel Margot from May 6-8 for the longest streak by a Ray this season...he is the second player in club history with 5 HR over a 3-game span, joining Brandon Lowe (5) from Sep 29–Oct 2, 2021...he is the second player in the majors this season with 5 HR in a 3-game span, joining MIN Byron Buxton from June 8-10—which led to AL Player of the Week honors.

- + Paredes leads the team with 10 HR despite making his season debut on May 1 and being optioned from May 8-15...all 10 HR have come in his last 25 games since May 18, compared to 2 HR in the first 65 games of his career...since May 18, his 10 HR are tied for 3rd in the AL behind NYY Aaron Judge (13) and LAA Mike Trout (12).
- + His walk-off hit was the seventh in club history on a 0-2 pitch, first since **Austin Meadows** (2-run single) on July 21, 2021 vs. BAL.

**LAST START**—On Mon vs. NYY, left with a 1-0 deficit but got no decision after the Rays tied it in the 8th...faced the Yankees in back-to-back starts, both winless, on the heels of a career-best 6-game winning streak...his only run allowed was a solo homer by **Anthony Rizzo** in the 1st inning... after the Rizzo homer, retired his next 11 BF including striking out the side in the 4th...yielded back-to-back singles and a walk with 1 out in the 5th but escaped the jam with a 5-4-3 GDP...pitched around a 1-out single in the 6th...his line: ND, 6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 8 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches, 60 str.

- + 77.3 pct. (17 of 22) of his runs allowed this season are via homer.
- + The Rizzo homer was his second allowed to a lefty this season, following **Jesse Winker** on May 5 at SEA...struck Rizzo out in the 4th inning, the first time in his career he threw a changeup to a lefty.
- + Induced a career-high 10 swings-and-misses against his changeup.

vs. PIRATES—Has never faced the Pirates...is 4-0 with a 2.43 ERA (33.1-IP, 9-ER) in six career interleague starts, including 2-0 with a 0.45 ERA (20-IP, 1-ER) in 3 IL starts this season...has a 9.00 SO/BB ratio (27-SO, 3-BB) this season and limited them to a .149 avg. (10-for-67) and 2 XBH (1-2B, 1-HR).

**ON A ROLL**—Ranks among major league leaders in ERA (1.81, 1st), opp avg. (.185, 1st), opp OPS (.537, 1st), WHIP (0.85, 1st), strikeout rate (35.3 pct., 1st), strikeouts (113, 2nd), SO/BB ratio (7.06, 2nd) and swing-and-miss rate (35.9 pct., 2nd)...is on pace for 258 SO, which would set a single-season franchise record ahead of **Chris Archer** (252) in 2015...has allowed 10 runs (6 ER) in his last 8 starts spanning 52 IP, a stretch that has lowered his ERA from a season-high 3.06 to 1.81...has made eight consecutive starts of 6+ IP, 7+ SO and 2 ER (or fewer), the longest streak in club history...has gone 6 IP (or more) and allowed 2 ER (or fewer) in eight straight starts, the longest single-season streak in franchise history and tying **Paul Wilson** from Aug 28, 2001–April 10, 2002 for the longest in club history overall.

- + Has made six consecutive starts at Tropicana Field of 6 IP (or more) and 2 runs (or fewer), tied for the 2nd-longest streak in franchise history and trailing Blake Snell (7) from April 16-July 1, 2018.
- + His 1.95 ERA at home is the 3rd-lowest single-season mark in club history behind Snell (1.27) in 2018 and **David Price** (1.81) in 2012.
- + Is one of four pitchers in franchise history to make at least 5 starts in a single season with 7 SO (or more) and 0 BB, joining Price (7) in 2014, Charlie Morton (5) in 2019 and James Shields (5) in 2012...his 5 starts of that type are the most in the majors this season.
- + His 1.81 ERA through 14 starts this season is the lowest in franchise history for a traditional starting pitcher in the season-opening rotation, passing **Chris Archer** (2.00) through 14 starts in 2015.

**ON THE OFFSPEED**—Has 86 SO via offspeed and breaking pitches, most in the majors ahead of CHW **Dylan Cease** (74)...has a whiff rate of 41.2

pct. (150 of 364) between those pitches, compared to a 28.8 pct. whiff rate (72 of 250) on his fastball...whiff rate is calculated as the ratio of swinging strikes per swing...the 39 SO with his curveball are tied for 3rd in the majors behind HOU Framber Valdez (44) and ATL Kyle Wright (42)...83.2 pct. (94 of 113) of his strikeouts have come via swing-and-miss and the 94 swinging strikeouts rank 2nd in the majors behind MIL Corbin Burnes (99)...opponents are batting .156 (32-for-205) against his offspeed and breaking pitches, compared to a .247 avg. (24-for-97) against his fastball.

- + Has used his changeup for 22.6 pct. of his pitches this season, compared to 8.0 pct. during his rookie season...the 45.1 pct. whiff rate on the changeup is the 7th-highest in the majors (min. 25 PA).
- + Has recorded nearly as many strikeouts (39) with his curveball as he has allowed balls in play (46) against the pitch so far...twelve of the 46 batted balls have resulted in hits, with 10 singles and 2 HR.
- + His changeup is rated at 10.6 Runs Above Avg., according to Fan-Graphs, the 3rd-best offspeed pitch in the majors...his curveball is rated 6.5 Runs Above Avg., 2nd behind ATL **Kyle Wright** (7.2).

LIMITING THE DAMAGE—Opponents are batting .185/.229/.308 (56-for-302) against him this season, and he ranks among AL leaders in opp avg. (1st), opp OBP (1st), opp SLG (4th) and opp OPS (.537, 1st)...has produced a 49.7 pct. ground ball rate, 6th-highest in the AL...while his strikeout rate has increased from 27.3 pct. during his rookie season to 35.3 pct. this season, his walk rate has decreased from 7.2 pct. to 5.0 pct. ...has left 88.5 pct. of runners that reach base stranded, 1st in the majors...has limited opponents to a .109 avg. (5-for-46) with RISP, 5th-lowest in the AL (min. 30 AB) and 6th-lowest in the majors...opponents are 2-for-their-last-35 against him with RISP, and only one of the hits over that span produced a run.

+ Has allowed contact on just 66.4 pct. of the swings against him this season, according to FanGraphs, the lowest contact rate in the AL.

**FLAME THROWING**—His avg. fastball velocity this season is 96.9 mph, tied for 12th in the majors (min. 500 pitches) and 2nd among lefties behind MIA **Jesús Luzardo** (97.2)...has reached 100 mph three times this season after doing so 16 times last season, which ranked 4th in the majors among starters...in his last 8 starts since May 11, has 21 SO with the fastball and has recorded a swing-and-miss on 32.9 pct. (52 of 158) of swings against it, compared to 21.7 pct. (20 of 92) in his first 6 starts this season.

+ In his last 8 starts, has limited opponents to a .169 avg. (11-for-65) with 3 HR in at-bats ending with the fastball, compared to a .406 avg. (13-for-32) with 2 2B and 3 HR against it in his first 6 starts.

**LAST START**—On Tues vs. NYY, took no decision in his first start at Tropicana Field since Sep 26, 2021 vs. MIA...after yielding a leadoff single in the 1st inning, retired his next 9 BF, including five consecutive strikeouts between the 2nd and 3rd innings...allowed a homer to **Aaron Judge** to lead off the 4th, snapping his scoreless streak at 9 IP...yielded three straight 1-out baserunners in the 5th and was replaced with the bases loaded after a strikeout...his line: 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 78 pitches, 47 str.

- + Has allowed 1 run in his last 2 starts spanning 10.2 IP after yielding a career-high 5 runs in 2.1 IP in his first start on June 11 at MIN.
- + 88.9 pct. (8 of 9) of the runs he has allowed in his career have come via homer, including 83.3 pct. (5 of 6) of runs allowed this season.

vs. BREWERS—Has never faced the Brewers.

- Yesterday vs. PIT, recorded a career-high-tying 4 hits, incl. 2 2B, for the third time this season...marked his first XBH and RBI since June 12 at MIN.
