BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore got a pair of solo home runs from **Gunnar Henderson** and **Leody Taveras** but fell in Cleveland last night, 4-2, for the team's fourth loss in five games...Following today's series finale against the Guardians, the road trip continues on Monday with the first of three games in Kansas City.

👉 **Dean Kremer** struck out seven over 6.0 innings...He's fanned seven or more batters in consecutive starts for the fourth time in his career (last: 3, 9/6-18/24).

👉 The Orioles tied a season high by striking out 16 times last night, joining March 28 vs. Minnesota.

ACTION JACKSON: Since the beginning of the previous homestand on April 10, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .371/.371/.857 (13-for-35) with two doubles, five homers, six runs scored, and 13 RBI in nine games...During that time, he's tied for the MLB lead in home runs with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, NYY's Aaron Judge, LAD's Max Muncy, and LAA's Mike Trout, is second in total bases (30) behind Alvarez (32), tied for second in RBI with LAA's Mike Trout behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (14), and tied for second in hits with Alvarez behind TEX's Josh Jung (14).

👉 Jackson leads the Orioles with 17 RBI, which is tied for third in the AL with TEX's Jake Burger, NYY's Ben Rice, and BOS' Trevor Story, trailing HOU's Yordan Alvarez (20) and LAA's Jorge Soler (18)...A primary second baseman has not led the Orioles in RBI since Jonathan Schoop in 2017 (105).

👉 Jackson's five home runs have all come as the second baseman, second in the majors behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (7).

👉 Among players with at least 60 plate appearances this season, his 3.14 pitches per plate appearance ranks fifth lowest in the majors...The Orioles are averaging 3.96 pitches per plate appearance as a team, ranked seventh in the AL and ninth in the majors this season.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 19 of the last 20 games since March 28 while slashing .304/.404/.443 (24-for-79) with 11 doubles, 10 runs scored, eight RBI, 13 walks, and one hit by pitch during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on Wednesday.

👉 His 11 doubles this season leads the majors ahead of SF's Willy Adames and ATL's Matt Olson (both 10)...He's the third Oriole to record 11 doubles in his first 21 games of a season, joining Hanser Alberto (11) and Jose Iglesias (12), both in 2020.

👉 Ward enters play today as the only player in the majors to have four hits in two separate games this season...In 704 career games entering the 2026 season, Ward's career high in hits was three, done 37 times.

LEAVE IT TO LEODY: **Leody Taveras** is batting .368/.489/.526 (14-for-38) with three doubles, one home run, seven runs scored, nine RBI, nine walks, and one stolen base this season...If he was qualified for the league leaders (3.1 PA/G), he'd lead the majors in on-base percentage and rank second in batting average.

👉 He's hit safely in seven straight games since April 12, tied for the third longest stretch of his career...The only longer hitting streaks in his career is a nine-gamer from July 9-21, 2022 and an eight-game stretch from September 4-13, 2021.

👉 Taveras has hit safely in 10 of 11 starts this season while slashing .394/.524/.576 (13-for-33).

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has yet to allow a hit in a career-high 10 straight appearances (10.0 IP) to open the season, the longest active stretch in the majors and the longest season-opening hitless streak by a Baltimore pitcher in team history...Garcia has recorded 30 outs without giving up a hit, the second-longest hitless streak to begin a season by an Oriole in the expansion era (since 1961) behind **Yennier Cano** in 2023 (30), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

👉 Garcia has also stranded all five inherited runners, only the second pitcher in MLB history to begin a season with 10+ scoreless appearances of no hits and no inherited runners scored along with TB's Scott Aldred, who did so in 11 straight from April 8-May 1, 1999.

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks fourth in the AL with a 3.36 ERA behind the Rangers (3.03), Tigers (3.25), and Mariners (3.27)...That number drops to 1.99 on the road, which leads the AL and is fourth in the majors behind the Braves (0.65), Reds (1.09), and Phillies (1.50).

👉 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on Friday night...It's the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

WALKING IT OUT: The Birds have drawn 4+ walks in 14 games this season, tied for second most in the majors with the Cubs, Pirates, and Twins, trailing the White Sox (15).

👉 Baltimore has drawn at least four free passes in nine of the last 11 games.

GUARDIANS OF THE GALAXY: The Orioles have not won a season series against Cleveland since 2016 (5-1)...During that time, the team is 21-37 (.362)...The O's are 39-79 (.331) all time at Progressive Field since the ballpark opened in 1994.

👉 Future Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** hit his 500th career home run at Camden Yards on September 6, 1996, after returning to the club in a mid-season trade with Cleveland on July 21.

👉 The Orioles clinched the inaugural AL East division title on September 13, 1969 vs. Cleveland at Memorial Stadium.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

April 19, 1975 - After Cleveland scores two runs in the 10th inning to take a 5-3 lead, Brooks Robinson pinch hits with two on and one out in the bottom half and hits a three-run homer off Dave LaRoche to give the Orioles a 6-5 win. Robinson is mobbed by teammates as he crosses the plate on what will be his 268th and final career home run.

April 19, 1990 - Dave Johnson becomes the first Baltimore-born Oriole to start a Home Opener, allowing one run in 7.0 innings to beat the Tigers, 4-2.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and 107th of his career...Was voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining **Randy Myers** (1997), **Mike Cuellar** (1974), and **Dave McNally** (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since **Rodrigo Lopez** (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss of the season on April 14 vs. Arizona after tossing a season-low 4.2 innings, allowing season high's in hits (9) and runs (4) while permitting one home run and one walk with six strikeouts...Threw 99 pitches, 61 strikes.

📌 Prior to his last outing, had worked 6.0+ innings and allowed two runs or less in each of his first three starts to open the year, becoming the first Oriole starter to accomplish the feat since **Dylan Bundy** from March 29-April 9, 2018 (3 G).

📌 Has issued two walks over his last three starts (16.2 IP) after walking four hitters over 7.0 innings in his Opening Day start vs. Minnesota.

BELIEVELAND: Rogers has made two career starts opposite the Guardians, going 0-1 with a 5.79 ERA (6 ER/9.1 IP)...Made his only career start at Progressive Field on August 1, 2024 and suffered the loss, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts over 4.1 innings.

📌 In five career starts against the AL Central, he is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP).

BEST OF THE BEST: Since making his 2025 season debut on May 24 (G2) at Boston, Rogers' 2.03 ERA (30 ER/133.1 IP) is third lowest in MLB (min. 125.0 IP), trailing DET's Tarik Skubal (1.95) and PIT's Paul Skenes (1.98).

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL: Rogers has been over a full run better during the day compared to night starts in his career, posting a 4.25 ERA (146 ER/309.1 IP) at night compared to a 3.19 mark (83 ER/234.1 IP) in the daytime...Last season, Rogers allowed three runs or less in his first 10 starts at night while pitching to a 1.37 ERA (9 ER/59.1 IP) before allowing six runs in 3.0 innings on September 26 at New York-AL...Three of his four starts this season have been during the day.

📌 Since joining the Orioles, he has allowed two runs or less in 10 straight daytime affairs since July 6, 2025, the second-longest streak among starting pitchers in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Kyle Bradish's** 12-game run from June 25, 2023-May 26, 2024.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Since making his MLB debut on August 25, 2020, Rogers has allowed 0.81 home runs per nine innings, the seventh-lowest mark in the majors (min. 500.0 IP), trailing SF's Logan Webb (0.61), NYY's Max Fried (0.67), DET's Framer Valdez (0.69), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.73), BOS' Ranger Suarez (0.79), and LAD's Blake Snell (0.80).

📌 Since making his season debut in 2025, Rogers has permitted seven home runs over 133.1 innings, three of which came in last year's season finale at New York-AL...Two of the three long balls came in a three batter stretch, with Aaron Judge and Giancarlo Stanton going deep in the third frame, with Cody Bellinger drawing a walk in between...Stanton also homered in the first frame.

WALKING THE TIGHT ROPE: Rogers has held the opposition to a .167 (5-for-30) clip with zero outs and a .192 (5-for-26) average with one out.

📌 With two outs, however, opponents have managed to go 14-for-35 (.400)...Five of the eight RBI Rogers has permitted have come with two outs.

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Last season, Rogers featured his four-seam fastball 40.8 percent of the time and limited the opposition to a .158 (22-for-139) clip on the offering...The .158 opponent average was the second lowest among all MLB starters (min. 100 AB ending in pitch), trailing SEA's Bryan Woo (.153, 42-for-274).

📌 Thus far in 2026 opponents are 11-for-41 (.268) off his four-seamer, including 4-for-9 with two doubles in his last outing vs. Arizona.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of **Dave McNally** (1.95 ERA, 1968) and **Jim Palmer** (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).
