**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs 2017 Robert O. Fisher Award-winner **Gene Dias'** **Astros** and the first game of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes an off day on Mon and a 3-game series vs the **Nationals** from Tue through Thu.

- Following Thu's game vs **Wsh**, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **Cle** (5/15-5/17) and **Phi** (5/18-5/20).
- Cin is coming off a 0-7 road trip at **Pit** (0-3) and **Chc** (0-4).

**A ROAD TRIP TO FORGET:** The Reds entered their 5/1-5/7 road trip a season-high 9 games over .500 (20-11) and in first place in the National League Central (+1.0)...ended that 0-7 road trip in last place (20-18), trailing the division-leading **Cubs** by a season-high 6.0 games.

- It marked just the fourth time in club history that Cin lost all 7 games of a 7-game road trip (April 2022, June 2004, September 1989).
- It was the first time since 2017 that Cin pitchers allowed 50 or more runs in a 7-game set.
- From Mon-Wed at **Wrigley Field**, the Reds suffered 3 straight walkoff losses for just the fourth time in franchise history (also: 2010, 1989, 1967).
- C Jose Trevino** made pitching appearances in back-to-back games on 5/1 & 5/2 at **Pit**...the 5/1 appearance marked his 500th career game.
- In the second inning of the 17-7 loss at **Pit** on 5/2, Reds pitchers tied a Major League record by walking 7 consecutive batters...allowed 5 runs in the inning without giving up a hit.
- In Tue's 3-2, 10th-inning loss at **Chc**, **RHP Emilio Pagan** threw 1 pitch in the 9th inning before leaving the game and subsequently going on the injured list with a left hamstring strain.
- In yesterday's 8-3 loss at **Chc**, starter **RHP Rhet Lowder** was removed from the game in the 4th inning with right shoulder discomfort.

**KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON:** The Reds remain 2 games above .500 (20-18) despite their current 7-game losing streak.

- 2 of the last 3 World Series winners (**LAD** 2025 & **Tex** 2023) endured losing streaks of 7 or more games during their championship seasons...the '25 **Dodgers** lost 7 straight in July while the '23 **Rangers** dropped 8 in-a-row in August.
- The 2006 World Champion **Cardinals** languished through 3 separate losing skids of 7 or more games (7g 9/20-9/26; 8g 7/27-8/4; 8g 6/20-6/27).
- Since 2000, there have been 57 losing streaks of 7 or more games suffered by teams who would go on to appear in the Postseason that very same year.

**TRIUMPHANT RETURN:** In his first Major League appearance in 759 days (since 4/7/24 vs **NYM**), **RHP Tejay Antone** worked a perfect 8th inning with 2 strikeouts in the Reds' 7-6, 10-inning loss on Wed at **Chc**.

- Antone**, who was selected from **AAA-Louisville** earlier in the day, has undergone "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow 3 times during the course of his career (April 2017, August 2021, April 2024).
- Antone** was in line to earn his third career win on Wed after the Reds plated 4 runs in the top of the 9th inning.

**POWER SURGE:** The Reds have hit 30 homers over their last 15 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), most in the majors during that time.

- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter tonight's game ranked third with 52 HR (**NYG** 61, **Atl** 55).
- This is the ninth time in club history that they've hit as many as 52 HR through the season's first 38 games...prior to this year, they last did it in 3 straight seasons from 2019-2021 (56hr in '19, 57hr in '20, 54hr in '21).
- Of the Reds' 156 runs scored this season, 78 have come on homers (50%), the highest rate in the majors.

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds are meeting the **Astros** for the only time in 2026.

- Hou** took 2 of 3 vs Cin last year at **Daikin Park** (5/9-5/11).
- Cin has won 10 of the last 12g vs **Hou**, 55 of the last 79 games, and 20 of the last 26 series.
- The Reds swept the **Astros** in 3 of their last 4 series, in 4 of their last 6 series, and in 5 of their last 9 series.
- In the 3-0 win on 5/9/25, the **Astros** snapped their 9-game losing streak vs Cin dating back to 6/17/19.
- The Reds' 9-game winning streak vs the **Astros** from 6/17/19-9/5/24 was their longest against **Hou** since winning 9 in-a-row 4/29-9/26, 2009...in 1995, Cin beat Hou in 11 straight games from 5/22-9/4.

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have avoided being swept in 37 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds avoided being swept at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided being swept in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Reds have grounded into just 18 double plays this season, tied with the **Brewers** and **Mariners** for fewest in the majors...hit into 106 double plays last year, 12th-most among all Major League clubs.

**EL CABALLO DE HIERRO:** **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 256 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest streak of consecutive games played by a Red since 1970.

### ACTIVATED:

- Today was activated from the 15-day injured list and tonight will make his season debut.
- Will make his first career appearance vs Hou...the Astros are 1 of 3 Major League teams he's never faced (Astros, Tigers, Reds).

### REHAB ASSIGNMENT

- Was in his second stint on a rehab assignment when activated from the injured list...was sidelined with blister issues on his left index finger.
- Made his first rehab appearance on 4/2 for A-Daytona vs Jupiter, faced 8 batters before he was removed from the game due to the recurrence of a blister on his left index finger...was returned from rehab the following day.
  - Began his second rehab stint on 4/26 for A-Daytona vs South Bend and pitched 5.0 shutout innings...his assignment was transferred to AAA-Louisville on 5/2...allowed 2 runs on 5 hits in 4.1 innings in that night's 8-4 loss at Omaha (2bb, 6k, 79TP).

**2026 SPRING TRAINING:** Went 1-2 with a 7.24 ERA in 5 starts for the Reds during the 2026 Cactus League season (13.2ip, 18h, 12r/11er, 4bb, 18k, 4hr).

- In his final Cactus League start on 3/22 at Cle, was removed from the game after facing 2 batters due to a blister on his left index finger...was placed on the IL the next day.
- Gametime temperature was 95 degrees.

- This season, leads all primary Major League shortstops in home runs (10), extra-base hits (17), runs scored (27), and total bases (77).
- His 5 HR off left-handed pitching in 2026 are tied with NYY's Aaron Judge, Hou's Yordan Alvarez, NYY's Ben Rice, and Sea's Julio Rodríguez for most in MLB.
- Is 3 SB shy of 150 for his career...looking to surpass Eric Davis (25y, 82d) as the youngest Red (currently 24y, 117d old) since 1900 to reach 150 career steals.
- Is 6 extra-base hits shy of tying Bob Bescher (1908-13) for fourth-most by a switch hitter in Reds history.

- Among all National Leaguers with 50+ at-bats this season, ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.581).
