NATIONALS NEWS

BELTWAY SERIES
The Washington Nationals beat the Baltimore Orioles, 13-3, on Saturday afternoon in front of a sellout crowd at Nationals Park to claim the first installment of the 2026 Beltway Series.

- With a win today, the Nationals would sweep the Orioles for the second consecutive series (dating back to May 16-18, 2025) for the first time in the series' history...A win also gives Washington a six-game winning streak over Baltimore, matching the longest by the Nationals over the Orioles (also: May 10, 2017 to June 19, 2018).
- The Nationals are 9-3 (.750) against the Orioles since the start of the 2024 season...Washington has outscored Baltimore 71-37 and has pitched to a 2.70 ERA during this 12-game stretch.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home.

WINNING WAYS
The Nationals have won four of five, seven of 10, eight of 12 and 12 of 19 games since April 25...They have won five of their last seven series and have won five of their last six home games.

- Washington's 12-7 (.632) record since April 15 is tied for the fifth-best mark in Major League Baseball.
- In the 12 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.51 ERA and a .207 opponents' average.
- Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.3 runs per game more than the league average team.

HOMER HAPPY
Washington's 19 home runs since May 6 are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Chicago White Sox and ahead of the Philadelphia Phillies (16) and Los Angeles Dodgers (15)...The Nationals have homered at least once in eight of the 10 games during this stretch.

- **Daylen Lile's** four homers are tied for third in Major League Baseball over this stretch.

SPEAKING OF DAYLEN...
Daylen Lile is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with .738 slugging percentage (4 2B, 4 HR), 11 RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and nine runs scored in his last 11 games...He's hit safely in nine of the 11 and has reached safely in 10 of the 11.

- Lile is 11-for-26 (.423) with two doubles and four homers (.962 SLG) in his last six games.
- Thanks to this stretch, Lile is now tied for third in the National League with 12 doubles.

OUT OF THIS WORLD
CJ Abrams is 23-for-66 (.348) with seven doubles, a triple, two homers, 16 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 13 runs in his last 17 games...He's reached safely in 14 of the 17 (.411 OBP) and is slugging .576 during the stretch.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (3rd, 37), on-base percentage (4th, .393), OPS (6th, .933), wRC+ (6th, 160), wOBA (6th, .404) and slugging percentage (10th, .540).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 252 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 96 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 27 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD
James Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.6 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.0).

- Wood is one of three players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 29 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch angle) are tied for the most in MLB with **Kyle Schwarber**, and his 56 batted balls over 100 MPH rank second in MLB behind **O'Neil Cruz** (57).

ACE OF BASES
The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams as a club, according to Baseball Savant...They lead Major League Baseball with five baserunning runs (*A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.*)

- **Nasim Nuñez** is tied for the Major League lead with four baserunning runs...His 19 stolen bases lead the National League are second in Major League Baseball behind Cleveland's **Jose Ramirez** (20).

FARM REPORT

STREA-KING
Harrisburg shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 33 games this season, the third-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest active streak.

SO GOOD THIS NOTE BARELY FITZ
Wilmington infielder **Devin Fitz-Gerald** has hit eight home runs in his last 10 games...The eight homers are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball in May...He is .372 (16-for-43) with a 1.023 slugging percentage (2 2B, 3B, 8 HR) over this stretch...Fitz-Gerald leads all of MiLB with five leadoff home runs this season...He leads Washington's system in home runs (11), slugging percentage (.674), OPS (1.110), extra-base hits (23) and RBI (11st, 31).

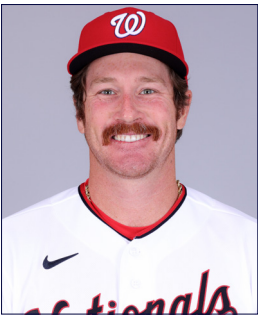

CAREER

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is third in Major League Baseball with 136 starts and is sixth with 767.2 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season...Is behind only Logan Webb (140) and Dylan Cease (139) for the most starts in MLB since 2022.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST START

Mikolas gave up one earned run through 3.1 innings of work, striking out two against the Cincinnati Reds...The Nationals went on to win 10-4 with Mikolas receiving a no decision.

vs. BALTIMORE

Mikolas is set to make his fourth career start against the Orioles.

- Mikolas owns a 4.41 ERA (8 ER/16.1 IP) with a 1-0 record against Baltimore.

LAST THREE STARTS

Mikolas owns a 4.26 ERA (6 ER/12.2 IP) in his last three starts...He has eight strikeouts and walked just three during that span.

- For comparison, in his first three starts this season, he pitched to a 12.41 ERA (17 ER/12.1 IP).

2025

Went 8-11 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 starts...Marked his fourth consecutive season with 31 or more starts.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
- Posted a 2.77 ERA in five starts from Aug. 28-Sept. 20 with a record of 1-1...Allowed two or less earned runs in all the five games and struck out 15 batters across 26.0 innings.
- Recorded a 3.42 ERA in 15 home starts and a 6.39 ERA in 16 road starts.

Was the Cardinals Opening Day starting pitcher for the second straight season.

- Marked his fifth season with 32-or-more starts...Ranked tied for fifth in the National League with 32 starts.
- Went 10-11 with a 5.35 ERA with 122 starts and just 25 walks in 32 starts.
- Eight of his 10 wins came on the road, tied for second most wins in road starts just behind Michael King (9)
- Reached 1,000 career innings on June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings with just one hit allowed.
- 2024 Pitch Mix:** Four Seamer (27.9%) Slider (24.3%) Sinker (23.0%) Curveball (11.7) Changeup (8.5%), Sweeper (4.1%), Slow Curve (0.5%)

2023

Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since Jhoulys Chacin (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee.

- Ranked among NL pitchers in starts (1st, 35) and innings pitched (3rd, 2011).
- Pitched 201.2 innings, giving him back-to-back seasons with 200 innings, marking his 3rd career season with 200-or-more innings.
- Was Cardinals Opening Day starting pitcher, the second of his career, and 1st since 2019.
- Made two relief appearances for the United States in the World Baseball Classic posting a 1.50 ERA in 6.0 innings pitched.
