Seattle and Houston meet today for the 6th of 19 matchups this season...Seattle will host Houston at T-Mobile Park for a total 9 games (2-1), with 10 games set to be played in Houston (0-2).

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners conclude a 3-game series against the Houston Astros (0-2) today, the final stop on a 9-game, 3-city road trip that began with series against the Tampa Bay Rays (1-2) and Miami Marlins (1-2)...following the last out of today's game against the Astros, the Mariners will return home to T-Mobile Park for a 7-game homestand against Tampa Bay (4 G) and Philadelphia (3 G)...today's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzos** and **Dave Sims**.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners lost last night by a score of 4-0, but are 10-8 over their last 18 games since April 14...Seattle is 11-4 when scoring at least 4 runs and 1-8 when scoring 3 or fewer runs this season.

- **Fun in the Sun** - The Mariners are 6-3 (.667) in day games this season, tied for the 5th-best winning percentage in the Majors.
- **No Place Like Home** - Today's game marks the final game of Seattle's current 9-game road trip... following today's game, the Mariners will return home to Seattle, where they hold a 7-2 (.778) record, 2nd-best home winning percentage in the Majors, trailing only Los Angeles-NL (9-2, .818).
- **Homestand Highlights** - The Mariners open a 7-game homestand tomorrow with a 4-game series vs. Tampa Bay (May 5-8), followed by a 3-game series vs. Philadelphia (May 9-11)...homestand highlights include J.P. Crawford Bobblehead Night, College Night, Bark at the Park Night and more.
- **On the Farm** - Mariners outfielder **Kyle Lewis** appeared in his first game action of 2022 yesterday in a rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma...Lewis homered in his first at bat, and finished the night going 3-for-5 with 3 RBI.
- **vs. Houston** - The Mariners are 6-8 against Houston over their last 14 matchups spanning 5 series...the home team has won the last 5 series between Seattle and Houston...Seattle has not won a series at Minute Maid Park since they took 2-of-3 from Sept. 17-19, 2018.
- **Long Stretch** - The Mariners are on their 9th of 16 consecutive days with a scheduled game, their longest streak of days with a scheduled game this season.
- **Series Record** - The Mariners own a 3-4-1 series record (0-4-1 on the road) this season.

**TIME TO SCORE**...the Mariners have been shutout in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 24-25, 2019 (also vs. Houston)...Seattle has never been shutout in 3 consecutive games in club history...prior to getting shutout for the first time this season on April 11 at Minnesota, the Mariners had gone 100 consecutive games without being shutout (June 12, 2021 - April 10, 2022)...the 100-game stretch was 3rd-longest in club history, trailing only 139 games (5/15/1996 - 4/18/1997) and 131 games (5/6/1995 - 9/26/1995).

**BAD LUCK**...during the current road trip (4/26-c), the Mariners have tallied 45 outs on hard-hit balls (exit velocity 95+ mph)...the 45 outs on hard-hit balls, rank 7th-most in the Majors during that span...during the road trip, the Mariners are batting .405 on hard-hit balls, compared to the expected batting average of .578 on those batted balls...Seattle's -.173 difference between batting average and expected batting average on hard-hit balls during the road trip is the 2nd-most-unlucky gap in the Majors, trailing only Philadelphia (-.180).

**THE LEGEND OF TORO**...Abraham Toro went 1-for-2 with a hit-by-pitch in yesterday's game...his is now batting .286 (14x49) with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 home runs 15 RBI and 5 walks in 16 career games against the Astros (his former team)...since joining the Mariners on July 27, 2021, Toro has reached base safely in 12 of 15 games (with PA) against the Astros, including 6 games in which he reached safely multiple times...among current Mariners batters, Toro's .286 career average against the Astros ranks 2nd on the team, trailing only **Ty France** (.377).

**FOR STARTERS**...Mariners starters have pitched at least 5 innings, while allowing 3 runs or less in each of their last 4 starts, posting a 3.32 ERA (8 ER, 21.2 IP) with 13 walks and 17 strikeouts during that span...overall this season, Mariners starters hold a 3.47 ERA (48 ER, 124.1 IP), ranking 4th-best in the American League behind only Minnesota (2.63), New York (2.80) and Boston (3.34).

**MULTI-HIT MANIA**...J.P. Crawford is tied for the Major League lead with 10 multi-hit games this season (also: Jeff McNeil-NYM, Eric Hosmer-SD & Wander Franco-TB), followed by **Ty France** who ranks tied for 5th in the Majors with 9 multi-hit games (also: 7 others)...Crawford and France have each recorded multiple hits in the same game 3 times this season: April 9 at MIN, April 22 at KC and April 23 at KC...in those 3 games, the Mariners are 3-0, while averaging 7.3 runs per game.

**JULIO THE SPEEDSTER**...Julio Rodríguez leads the Majors with 9 stolen bases this season, ranking ahead of Jorge Mateo-BAL (7) and Harrison Bader-STL (6)...according to Statcast sprint speed, Julio is tied as the 4th-fastest baserunner in the Majors at an average of 29.9 feet per second, trailing only Bobby Witt Jr. (30.2), Jose Siri (30.1) and Trea Turner (30.1).

**WALK THE LINE**...the Mariners offense has drawn 96 walks this season, leading the Majors and ranking ahead of Arizona (92) and San Diego (92)...Jesse Winker leads the AL with 18 walks, trailing only Juan Soto-WSH (21) for the Major League lead...Eugenio Suárez (12 BB) and J.P. Crawford (12 BB) are tied for 11th-most walks in the AL.

**IN THE BOX**...through the first 24 games of the season, the Mariners offense carries a 115 weighted runs created plus (*FanGraphs*), ranking 5th in the Majors, trailing only the New York Yankees (122), New York Mets (119), Tampa Bay Rays (118) and Los Angeles Angels (118 wRC+)...Seattle's 115 wRC+ signifies that the club has been roughly 15 percent better than average as an offense this season.

**AS YOU KNOW**...Ty France leads the American League with 33 hits this season, ranking ahead of Xander Bogaerts-BOS (31), J.P. Crawford-SEA (30) and Rafael Devers-BOS (30), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...with today marking Game #25 for the Mariners, France's 33 hits already rank tied for 10th-most hits all-time through the clubs first 25 games of a season...with 1 hit today, France would become the first player to tally 34 hits over the first 25 games since Nelson Cruz (34 hits) in 2015...with 2+ hits today, France would become the first player to tally 35+ hits over the first 25 games since Ichiro Suzuki (36 hits) in 2005.

**ABOUT BRASH...**

- 23-year-old right-hander is making his 5th career start in tonight's game (all this season) and 2nd against Houston...marks the first time Brash has faced an opponent twice.
- Selected by the Padres in the 4th round of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Played 3 seasons (2017-2019) at Niagara University going 12-7 with a 2.97 ERA (63 ER, 190.2 IP) for the Purple Eagles.
- Acquired by the Mariners from the Padres on 9/17/20 as PTB-NL completing 8/31/20 trade for RHP Taylor Williams.
- Graduated from Bayridge Secondary School (Kingston, ON, CA)...Helped Bayridge to first two baseball championships in school history...Voted Bayridge's top male athlete all four years of high school.

**LAST TIME OUT...**tagged with the loss on 4/29 at Miami, going just 2.0 innings allowing 6 runs on 7 hits (1 HR) and 2 walks with 3 strikeouts.

**SAVE THAT BASEBALL...**earned his first career win in his T-Mobile Park debut on 4/17 against the Astros...tossed 5.1 innings, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits (1 HR) and 6 walks while striking out 5...had 4 double plays turned behind him (3 GIDP and one strike-them-out, throw-them-out double play) in the first 4 innings.

**BRASHTY DEBUT...**became the 6th pitcher in Mariners history to record 6-or-more strikeouts in his MLB debut, and first since Ken Cloude on Aug. 9, 1997, also against the White Sox.

**HOT START...**became the first Mariners pitcher to toss back-to-back starts of 2-runs-or-less while striking out 5-or-more to begin his MLB career.

**PROSPECTING...**is ranked as the 46th best prospect in baseball and the 4th best prospect in the Mariners system by *Baseball America*...Brash ranks as the Mariners 6th best prospect and the 98th best prospect in baseball, according to *MLB Pipeline*...he became the 2nd Mariners player to make their MLB debut in 2022 (**Julio Rodriguez** on Opening Day).

**THE BARBER...**it had been 22,235 days since a player from Niagara University appeared in the Majors before Brash made his MLB debut on 4/12 at Chicago-AL...the last was on 8/31/1958 when Sal Maglie allowed 5 runs (2 ER) in 3.0 innings for the St. Louis Cardinals in an 8-5 loss to the Chicago Cubs.

**CANADIAN CLIQUE...**became the 9th Canadian-born player to appear in the Majors this season and the 2nd for the Mariners this season (also: **Abraham Toro**) and the 15th in franchise history when he made his MLB debut on 4/12 at Chicago-AL.

**2021 MiLB TOTALS...**went 6-4 with a 2.31 ERA (25 ER, 97.1 IP) with 48 walks and 142 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) between High-A Everett and Double-A Arkansas.

**COMPLETELY DOMINANT...**tossed 7.0 inning CGShO allowing just 1 hit and 2 walks while tying his season high with 11 strikeouts on 8/19 21... named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

**K MACHINE...**in 3 starts from 8/19-9/2/21 struck out 11,10 and 11 batters, allowing just 1 run and 4 hits with 6 walks over the 3-start span...struck out 10 or more batters 5 times, with a season-high of 11 strikeouts, which he did 3 times... he struck out at least 6 batters in 15 of his 18 appearances combined between Everett and Arkansas in 2021, including in each of his last 9 starts (7/7-9/16) to finish the season...his 13.13 strikeouts per 9.0 innings was the 2nd-most among Mariners farmhands in 2021, trailing only Brandon Williamson.

**COMBINED HISTORY...**threw the first 6.0 innings of Arkansas combined no-hitter on 9/2 tallying 11 strikeouts and retiring the first 16 batters he faced before allowing a walk...Nate Fisher (2.0 IP), Dayeison Arias (1.0 IP) closed out the last 3.0 innings of the Travelers first no-hitter since 5/17/16...Brash was named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

**CAREER...**selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft...has appeared in parts of 2 minor league seasons one with the Padres organization and one with the Mariners.

**SELECTED...** had his contract selected by Seattle on Sept. 28, 2021, but did not appear in a game.

**PURPLE EAGLES IN THE PROS...**became the 18th player from Niagara University to appear in the Major Leagues, and first since Sal Maglie in 1958...Brash became the 2nd-highest draft pick out of Niagara University behind Doug Farrell (2nd round in 1971 and 3rd round in 1972.)

**TUESDAY'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP ROBBIE RAY (2-2, 4.15)**

30-year-old left-hander is making his 6th start of the season, and 1st against the Astros in 2022...L#2 in last start on 4/30 at Miami (5.0,4,3,3,4,8)...W#2: earned second win of the season in first T-Mobile Park start as a Mariner on 4/19 vs. Texas (6.0,4,2,2,1,4)...W#1 on Opening Day at Minnesota (7.0,3,1,1,4,5,HR),...was named the American League Cy Young Award winner for the 1st time in his career after going 13-7 with an American League-leading 2.84 ERA (61 ER, 193.1 IP) while striking out an MLB-high 248 batters...was one of 5 starting pitchers to be named to the All-MLB team followin the 2021 season...won AL Pitcher of the Month award for the month of August after sporting a 1.76 ERA (8ER, 41.0 IP) with 52 strikeouts in 6 starts... His 2.4 walks per 9 innings pitched marked the largest decrease (7.8 BB/9 in 2020) among qualified starting pitchers from season to season in Major League history...via Elias Sports Bureau...signed to a 5-year MLB contract on 11/30/21...**CAREER:** Is a veteran of 9 Major League seasons Detroit (2014), Arizona (2015-20),Toronto (2020-21) and Seattle (2022)...made his Major League debut with Detroit on May 6, 2014 vs. Houston...came into the 2022 season as Major League Baseball's all-time leader in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.21), minimum 1,000 innings pitched...his 1,241 strikeouts over his first 1,000 career innings pitched are the most all-time over a player's first 1,000 career innings in MLB history...drafted by Washington in the 12th round of the 2010 MLB First Year Player Draft out of Brentwood High School (TN). vs. **HOU**; 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA (18 ER, 30.0 IP) in 6 starts against the
