APRIL 20
2005 - Craig Biggio collects his 1,000th career RBI in a 6-1 win over the Brewers at Minute Maid Park. Biggio ends up going 2x4 in the game with HR and 2 RBI. **RHP Roy Oswalt** goes the distance to pick up the win, allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 8 strikeouts and no walks.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros begin a 3-game series vs. the Guardians tonight at Progressive Field in Cleveland, OH...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (1-0) will make his second start of the season as he takes on CLE RHP Slade Cecconi (0-2).

VS. THE LAND: Tonight is the first of six scheduled meetings vs. the Guardians in 2026...after this 3-game set at Progressive Field, the two clubs will play a 3-game series at Daikin Park, June 19-21...the Astros were 2-4 vs. CLE last season, going 2-1 here at Progressive and 0-3 at Daikin Park.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Tonight will be the 2nd start of the season for **RHP Spencer Arrighetti**...he earned the win in his first start on April 15 vs. COL, allowing just one run and three hits in 6.0 innings of work with 10+ strikeouts...it marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts and his 1st since punching out 11 on Aug. 28, 2024 at PHI...**VS. CLE:** Tonight will be Arrighetti's 3rd app. and 2nd career start vs. CLE...he has had some success vs. the Guardians in limited action (0-0, 2.25 ERA, 2 G, 1 GS, 8 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 6 BB, 10 SO)...his last app. vs. CLE was in relief on Sept. 27, 2024 (hurled 2.1 scoreless frames).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Astros lost to the Cardinals at home yesterday afternoon in 10 innings, 7-5...the Astros had rallied back from a 4-1 deficit, tallying 3 runs in the bottom of the 8th inning to force the game into extra innings...**Isaac Paredes** had a key, 2-run single with 2 outs in that 8th inning to tie it...**RHP Mike Burrows** started the game, retiring the first 14 batters that he faced before running into trouble in the 5th inning (4.2 IP, 3 H, 4 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)...**Yordan Alvarez** (solo HR), **Jose Altuve** (3x5) and **Taylor Trammell** (2x4, 3B) contributed on offense.

ON THE STAND: The Astros went 2-4 on their just-concluded homestand, going 2-1 vs. COL and 0-3 vs. STL, respectively...HOU is 7-6 at home overall in 2026.

QUICK ROADSTOP: The Astros will play just these three games in CLE on the current road trip before returning home for a weekend series vs. NYY...**Need A Win:** The Astros need a win tonight to snap an 8-game road losing streak.

A PERFECT 10: In yesterday's game, **Yordan Alvarez** continued his torrid start to the 2026 season with his ML-leading 10th HR...he has now homered in 3 consecutive games for the 4th time in his career (last: July 1-3, 2024)...additionally, his 10 HR match the club record through a player's first 23 games of a season with **Lance Berkman** (2002)...Alvarez has also matched his career high by recording an RBI in his 6th consecutive game, doing so for the 3rd time (last: Aug. 6-12, 2024).

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Alvarez currently leads the AL in WAR (1.6), RBI (21), XBH (17) and TB (64), and is 2nd in SLG (.790), OBP (.471) and OPS (1.261).

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have placed **IF Nick Allen** on the 10-day IL (retro 4/19) due to mid-back spasms...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros selected **IF Braden Shewmake** (#28) to the Major League roster...to make room for Shewmake on 40-man roster, the Astros transferred **RHP Cristian Javier** to the 60-day IL...lastly, **RHP J.P. France** has been outrighted to Triple A Sugar Land.

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 23 different batting orders in their 23 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

MR. 2000: **2B Jose Altuve** needs to appear in 2 more games to reach 2,000 in his career, which will make him the 3rd Astros player to reach this milestone...Hall of Famers Craig Biggio (2,850) and Jeff Bagwell (2,150) also surpassed 2,000 career games (all for HOU)...only four active players have reached 2,000 career games: **Andrew McCutchen** (2,276), **Carlos Santana** (2,212), **Freddie Freeman** (2,199) and **Paul Goldschmidt** (2,082).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 750th career extra-base hit on Thursday (4/16 VS. COL) with his 461st career double...he also has 32 triples and 258 home runs, all coming as an Astro...only **Craig Biggio** (1,014) and **Jeff Bagwell** (969) have more extra-base hits than Altuve in franchise history.

BEHIND THE DISH: **C Christian Vázquez** is hitting .375 (12x32) with a .444 OBP and a 1.132 OPS...he has also tallied 10 RBI in just 10 games (8 starts) and has four catcher caught stealings on the season.

HARD TO HIT: Opponents are just 7x48 (.146) vs. **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, who is just the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history... among AL relievers, Teng ranks T-2nd in innings (13.2) and T-8th in strikeouts (14)...yesterday was his 4th scoreless appearance of at least 2.0 innings this season, tied for the most among AL relievers.

NEW ARRIVAL: **OF Dustin Harris** was claimed off waivers from the White Sox on Saturday and joined the club yesterday...Harris entered yesterday's game as pinch-hitter and ended up getting two AB's (0x2 with two lineouts)...Harris was 3x12 (.250) in six games for the White Sox with 4 walks and 2 SB (.438 OBP).

SEASON DEBUT: Was fantastic in his MLB season debut last Wednesday vs. the Rockies, striking out 10 batters through 6.0 innings of work, allowing 1 run on 3 hits with 4 walks to pick up the winning decision in the Astros' 3-1 victory...were the most strikeouts in a game by an Astros pitcher this season and marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts (last: 11 strikeouts on Aug. 11, 2024 at PHI)...was also the 4th start by an Astros pitcher of at least 6.0 innings this season.

SPAGHETTI DAY: Was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land on April 15 and is set to take his 2nd turn through the Astros rotation...broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land and posted a 1.26 ERA (2ER/14.1IP), 0.77 WHIP and .111 opponent batting average, with 20 strikeouts, through 3 starts with the Space Cowboys...on the date of his recall from Triple A (April 15), he ranked 1st in the PCL in strikeouts and 2nd in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Threw his curveball at a 38.0-percent rate in his season debut and held opposing hitters to a .154 average (2x13) on the pitch...also threw his sweeper at a 17.0-percent rate, with hitters going 0x2 on the pitch.

VS. CLE: Has recorded a 2.25 ERA (2ER/8IP), a .154 opponent average and 11.25 SO/9IP (10SO/8IP) in 2 career appearances vs. CLE, including a 5.2-inning relief appearance in his last outing vs. the Guardians on Sept. 27, 2024 at Progressive Field...has held **OF Steven Kwan** and **IF José Ramírez** to a combined 0x4 in his career matchups.

STRIKEOUT PACE: His 212 career strikeouts are 3rd-most through a player's first 37 career appearances in Astros history, trailing only **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (242) and **RHP Tom Griffin** (221)...his 171 strikeouts in 2024 were the 3rd-most in a single season by an Astros rookie, behind only **RHP Tom Griffin** (200, 1969) and **RHP Hunter Brown** (178, 2023)...since making his debut in '24, his 10.2 SO/9IP ranks 6th among AL pitchers (min. 180 IP).

2025 SEASON: Battled through a pair of IL stints in his 2nd season in the Majors, missing 105 team games due to a broken right thumb from April 7-Aug. 6, and then the final 26 games of the regular season due to right elbow inflammation...held opponents to a .229 average through his 7 starts, also recording a 5.35 ERA (21ER/35.1IP), 1.415 WHIP and 7.9 SO/9IP...was fantastic at Daikin Park, recording a 2.08 ERA (4ER/17.1IP) and .056 opponent average (3x54) in his 3 home starts.

SAVANT SAYS: As a rookie in '24, he averaged 7.2 feet of extension, which ranked in the 96th percentile among MLB pitchers...averaged 7.4 feet of extension during his 1st start of 2026.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to nearby Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School, located approximately 30 miles from Daikin Park...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette and was routinely ranked as one of the club's top pitching prospects in ascent through the minors...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

VS. CLE: has posted a 0.77 ERA (1ER/11.2IP) and .175 opponent average with 18 strikeouts in 11 career appearances vs. CLE...is the 7th-lowest ERA among active relievers with at least 11.0 career innings vs. CLE.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With Fri. night's outing, he reached 337.0 career innings, matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...next on the all-time list is **RHP Xavier Hernandez** at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in K's (460) and 7th in apps. (326).

2025 SEASON: Was a workhorse out of the Astros 'pen in 2025, going 3-4-7 with a 2.28 ERA (18ER/71IP), a .196 opponent average (51x260), 1.15 WHIP and 13.31 SO/9IP in a team-leading 70 appearances...led AL relievers with 105 strikeouts.
