THE PIRATES: are playing their 10th of 11 road games in a 14-game stretch (the stretch began on July 30 at Cincinnati) with tonight's game against Miami at loanDepot park (the only three home games during that stretch came from August 7-9 vs. New York-NL)...Finished a stretch of 17 consecutive days with a game on Sunday vs. the Mets (the stretch began on July 24 vs. Chicago-NL)...Will begin a six-game homestand vs. Boston (Friday-Sunday) and Detroit (August 17-19) after this trip (will mark their first home interleague games since June 23-25 vs. Seattle)...Have hit 145 homers (they hit 117 homers in 2025)...Have the most hits (1068) in all of Major League Baseball...Have scored 602 runs, tied with Los Angeles (NL) for the third-most in Major League Baseball, behind only Washington (649) and Chicago-NL (622), after scoring 583 runs in 2025...Have struck out the third-most batters (1122) in Major League Baseball, behind Philadelphia (1187) & Milwaukee (1169).

BEACH BOUND: Pittsburgh is in the second game of a brief, three-game road trip to Miami (Tuesday-Thursday)...It marks the Pirates' first three-game series at loanDepot park since taking two of three games here from September 17-19, 2021...They split a four-game series from July 11-14, 2022, lost three of four games from June 22-25, 2023, swept a four-game series from March 28-31, 2024 and lost three of four games from March 27-30, 2025 in Miami...It is the Pirates' second and final three-game road trip of the season (they also won two of three games from April 10-12 at Chicago-NL) and their first against a non-National League Central opponent since they won two of three games to end the season from September 27-29, 2024 at Yankee Stadium.

IRON CITY BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds has played in each of Pittsburgh's 121 games this season and 130 straight team games (he missed his last game last season on September 17 vs. Chicago-NL)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fifth-longest streak by a Pirate since 1989, trailing Jason Bay (307, 2004-06), Bobby Bonilla (189, 1989-90), Kevin Young (142, 1998) and Andrew McCutchen (132, 2011)...He is also on pace to become the seventh Pirate (10th instance) in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to play in all of the team's games in a season, joining Dick Groat (161 in 1962), Bill Mazeroski (162 in 1964, 162 in 1966 and 163 in 1967), Matty Alou (162 in 1969), Omar Moreno (162 in 1980 and 103 in 1981), Johnny Ray (162 in 1982) and Bay (162 in 2005).

THE MORE YOU YO: Yohan Ramírez had a career-high-tying five strikeouts while allowing one just walk over 3.0 scoreless innings of relief on Tuesday at Miami, his second straight outing with at least 3.0 scoreless innings, one/zero hits allowed and four strikeouts (also August 7 vs. New York-NL)...He joined Wilber Dotel (May 25-29) as the only Pirates relievers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to do that in back-to-back outings...Ramírez has a 0.29 ERA (30.2ip/1er) in his last 21 relief appearances (since June 6 at Atlanta), making him one of two Pirates relievers (since earned runs became official in the National League in 1912) with a 0.29 or lower ERA over a 21-game span (minimum 30.2 innings), joining Bill Landrum (nine different spans) in the 1989 season.

CAUGHT YA: Henry Davis caught Heriberto Hernández trying to steal second base in the sixth inning on Tuesday at Miami, marking his third caught stealing in his last four games...He also threw out Jackson Chourio on August 6 at Milwaukee and Luis Robert Jr. on Saturday vs. New York (NL)...Davis' 12 caught stealings are the eighth-most among National League catchers (Miami's Joe Mack is tied for fourth with 15)...The only Pirates catchers in the last 11 years (since 2016) with 13 or more caught stealings in a season were Francisco Cervelli (21) in 2018, Cervelli (15) in 2016, himself (14) last year, Elias Díaz (14) in 2019 and Joey Bart (13) in 2024.

SIMON SAYS: Ronny Simon, who played in 19 Major League games with Miami before being claimed off waivers by Pittsburgh on June 2, 2025, went 1-for-2 with a walk on Tuesday at loanDepot park (it was his first game here as a visiting player)...He is 6-for-20 (.300) with a double, two RBI, two walks, a steal and three runs in his first six games with the Pirates this year (he has hit safely in four straight contests, dating back to August 7 vs. New York-NL).

EASY BEIN' GREEN: Axiel Plaz (twice) and Tony Blanco Jr. homered for High-A Greensboro on Tuesday vs. Winston-Salem...Plaz' second homer was the Grasshoppers' 198th of the year, a new single-season record in the South Atlantic League...Their 199 homers are the most by any High-A/Class-A, Advanced team since Rancho Cucamonga (California League) hit 202 in 2018.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

August 12, 1987: Bob Walk tossed a four-hit shutout in Pittsburgh's 11-0 win against St. Louis at Three Rivers Stadium. The shutout snapped the Cardinals' 145-game streak of not being shut out, which was five games short of the then-modern National League record, set by the Pirates from 1924-25. Walk also had an RBI single and scored a run during Pittsburgh's eight-run outburst in the fourth inning.
