## NATIONALS NEWS

**RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD**  
The Washington Nationals square off against the Atlanta Braves in the rubber match of this three-game weekend series on Sunday late afternoon...Following the game, the Nationals will travel to Cleveland to face the Guardians in a three-game series starting Monday.

- The Nationals are 4-3 in rubber games this season, including wins in three of their last four.
- With a win today, the Washington would claim its first series victory in Atlanta since May 27-30, 2024.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 7-5 during this stretch so far.

**ROSTER MOVE**  
The Nationals recalled left-handed pitcher **PJ Poulin** from Triple-A Rochester and placed right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin** on the 15-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain.

**WINNING WAYS**  
The Nationals beat the Braves, 2-0, behind a one-hit shutout thanks to **Jake Irvin** (Win, 5.0 IP, BB, 7 SO), **Brad Lord** (Hold, 3.0 IP, H, 3 SO) and **Richard Lovelady** (Save, 1.0 IP, SO)...It was the 10th one-hit shutout in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Washington's runs came via solo homers by **Dylan Crews** and **Jorbit Vivas**.

- The Nationals are 15-11 (.577) since April 25 and have won five of their eight series over this stretch, with one series split against the New York Mets (May 18-21).
- In the 15 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.67 ERA and a .203 opponents' average with 141 strikeouts.
- The Nationals have a 15-11 (.600) record on the road this season...Washington has taken at least a share of five of the last six series away from home.

**VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE**  
Since May 6, Washington's offense leads Major League Baseball in home runs (28), extra-base hits (77), doubles (44), slugging percentage (.490), OPS (.824) and runs scored (1st, 103).

- Of note, the 77 extra-base hits are 82 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 55), the 44 doubles are 13 more than both Arizona and San Francisco (31) and the 103 runs are 28 more than the Dodgers (103).

**BULL PENNING**  
Over the last five games (23.2 IP), Washington's bullpen has struck out 24 batters, issued five walks and has pitched to a 2.28 ERA (6 ER/23.2 IP) with a .198 opponents' average...Notable recent performances include:

- Clayton Beeter** has tossed two hitless outings (2.0 IP) with four strikeouts and one walk since returning from the Injured List on May 21.
- Andrew Alvarez** recorded his first career save on May 20 vs. New York (4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, HR, BB 5 SO).
- Brad Lord** has not issued a walk in his last five outings while striking out 13 batters and pitching to a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) over this stretch...On the season, he's recorded 4.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio (29 SO/6 BB).
- Richard Lovelady** is 1-1 with four saves, three holds and a 1.26 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts in his last 14 outings...He's posted a 1.76 ERA in 15 games with the Nationals.

**BACKSTOP BAT**  
**Keibert Ruiz** has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, going 14-for-34 (.424) with seven doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, one walk, one stolen base and eight runs scored...He is in the midst of a seven-game hitting streak.

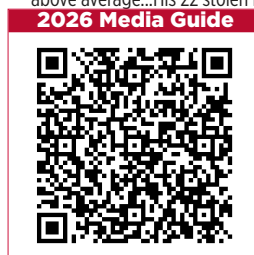
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for first among Major League catchers with 12 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in isolated power (.3rd, .242) and slugging percentage (5th, .505).
- The 12 doubles are tied for the most among all Major League Baseball switch hitters with **Elly De La Cruz** and his .505 slugging percentage is good for third (min. 100 PA).

**A IS FOR ABRAMS AND...ALL-STAR?**  
With All-Star voting set to open in a few weeks, **CJ Abrams** has placed himself among the best players in Major League Baseball, as well as one of the top shortstops in the National League...See chart to the right for Abrams' rankings among National League shortstops.

- He leads Major League Baseball with 45 RBI...He ranks among National League hitters in wOBA (5th, .401), OPS (6th, .929), wRC+ (6th, 159), slugging percentage (7th, .545), on-base percentage (8th, .384), extra-base hits (T8th, 24) and hits (T8th, 56).

**ACE OF BASES**  
The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams in baseball according to the advanced metrics:

- Per Baseball Savant, the Nationals are tied for the Major League lead with six baserunning runs (*A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.*)
- According to FanGraphs, Washington ranks second in Major League Baseball in their baserunning metric, baserunning runs above average, at 5.0...Baserunning runs above average is all encompassing baserunning statistic that turns stolen bases, caught stealings, and other base running plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average.
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with four baserunning runs and is second with 3.7 baserunning runs above average...His 22 stolen bases lead MLB ahead of **Jose Ramirez** (20).

# CAREER

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

## LAST START

Griffin struck out five with no walks in 5.0 innings of work against the Mets on May 19...He allowed five earned runs in the first two innings, but went on to surrender just two hits with four strikeouts over the final three to keep Washington in the game...The Nationals went on to beat the Mets, 9-6.

## vs. ATLANTA

Griffin faced the Braves on April 21 at Nationals Park...He allowed three earned runs on six hits with three strikeouts and one walk in 6.0 innings of work to earn the win.

## LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .185 batting average (12-for-65) with 19 strikeouts and just five walks...His four-seam fastball (.083 opp. AVG), sweep (.167) and sinker (.182) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year.

- In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

## BACK IN THE STATES, BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

Griffin earned his first Major League win as a starter in his first career start on March 30 at Philadelphia...He threw 5.0 innings allowing just two earned runs on five hits with five strikeouts and no walks.

- It was his first Major League appearance since Sept. 22, 2022 at Tampa Bay and first Major League start after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball

## WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

## LUCKY 7

Griffin has the ability to throw seven pitches, including: cutter (31.1%), four seamer (16.5%), sweeper (14.6%), changeup (11.3%), curveball (8.8%), split finger (6.3%) and sinker (11.4%).

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.
