**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles fell to the Cardinals, 6-3, in the opener of the three-game set in St. Louis...Drop to 10-6 in series openers and 4-3 in series openers on the road...The O's were held to just three hits, matching their season low for the sixth time (last: 5/13 vs. TOR)...**Gunnar Henderson** provided all the offense for the Birds with his MLB-leading 16<sup>th</sup> home run of the year, a three-run blast in the sixth that also marked Baltimore's first hit of the game...O's pitchers issued a season-high-tying seven free passes (also: 5/8 at WSH).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** leads MLB with 16 home runs and ranks among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...He has homered in four straight games, the fourth MLB player to do so this year and first Oriole since **DJ Stewart** from September 5-9, 2020; the last Oriole to homer in five straight games was **Jonathan Schoop** from July 22-27, 2018; the club record since 1954 is six, done first by **Reggie Jackson** from July 18-23, 1976 and matched by **Chris Davis** from September 26 to October 2, 2012.

Ø According to MLB's Sarah Langs (@SlangsOnSports), Henderson is the fifth player age 22-or-younger to hit at least 16 homers in his team's first 45 games of a season, joining Washington's Bryce Harper in 2015 (16), Seattle's Alex Rodriguez in 1998 (18), Washington Senators' Harmon Killebrew in 1959 (18), and Milwaukee Braves' Eddie Matthews in 1953 (16).

Ø He is the second player in Orioles history with at least 16 homers in the team's first 45 games, joining **Brady Anderson** (16 in 1996).

Ø Henderson is the first Oriole to hold the outright MLB lead in home runs on May 20 or later since **Mark Trumbo** finished the 2016 season with an MLB-best 47, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 69 home runs, tied with 2012 for the second-most homers through the first 45 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (70)...The most through Baltimore's first 46 games of a season is 76 in 1987.

Ø The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least six homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (16), **Adley Rutschman** (9), **Anthony Santander** and **Jordan Westburg** (7), and **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Cedric Mullins**, and **Ryan O'Hearn** (6); the Yankees rank second with five players with at least six long balls.

**LEADING ACTORS:** Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

Ø Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history with **Cedric Mullins** (2022), **Seth Smith** (2017), **Adam Jones** (2016), and **Don Buford** (1971); he trails **Brady Anderson** (7 in 1999 & 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

**THE ERAS TOUR:** The O's have an AL-best 2.49 ERA (46 ER/166.0 IP) in their last 18 games since April 29, trailing only the Dodgers (2.43) for the best mark in MLB...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 116 hits while holding opponents to a .196 batting average (116-for-592).

Ø For the year, the Birds rank fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB with a 3.31 ERA (151 ER/410.0 IP); the club has not posted a mark that low in a season since 1979 (3.26).

**LEFTY LOOSEY:** Facing left-handed pitching this season, Orioles batters have an MLB-best 24 home runs, .505 slugging, .845 OPS, and 245 total bases...Three Orioles rank in the top 11 in MLB in OPS against left-handed pitching: **Adley Rutschman** (3<sup>rd</sup>, 1.178), **Anthony Santander** (10<sup>th</sup>, 1.049), and **Gunnar Henderson** (11<sup>th</sup>, 1.040).

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** enters today ranked fifth in the AL batting average (.304) and tied for sixth in hits (55)...He is tied for second in the AL and fourth in MLB in multi-hit games (18).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Orioles began a seven-game road trip last night with the first of three games in St. Louis (0-1)...The O's will then play four games in Chicago against the White Sox from May 23-26.

Ø The Orioles are 12-6 (.667) on the road this season, the best road record in the AL and second-best in MLB behind the Phillies at 15-6 (.714).

**BIRDS OF A FEATHER:** The Orioles and Cardinals are meeting for their first and only series of the season this week...It is the first meeting between the squads since the O's dropped two out of three in Baltimore from September 11-13, 2023...The last time the Orioles traveled to St. Louis was from May 10-12, 2022, when they took two out of three at Busch Stadium...Entering this series, Baltimore and St. Louis had only squared off in the regular season 18 times in team history; the 18 regular-season games against the Cardinals were tied for Baltimore's fewest against a single active opponent with the Dodgers, who the Birds will travel to for three games later this season.

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles have gone 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept, eclipsing the 1903-05 New York Giants (105) for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Oriole manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 344 wins rank fifth all-time among Oriole managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Oriole Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his fourth start of the season tonight against St. Louis...Made his season debut on 5/2 vs. New York-AL...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (right UCL sprain)...Made three rehab starts, one with Double-A Bowie and two with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts and four walks...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 quality starts) for the O's in 2023 and finished fourth for the AL Cy Young; became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-.300 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Spent time on the Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 15 vs. Toronto...Allowed two runs on four hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...Had a career-high three plate appearances of at least nine pitches...Has not received more than three runs of run support since his start on September 8, 2023 at Boston (5)...Threw 85 pitches, 56 strikes.

**GAME OF CARDS:** Slated to make his second career start against the Cardinals...Earned his first career win in his only prior start against the Cards on May 10, 2022 in St. Louis after allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with 11 strikeouts in 7.0 innings; the 11 strikeouts remain a career high; faced the minimum through 5.0 innings; both runs scored on an inside-the-park home run in the sixth inning.

**AGAINST THE NL CENTRAL:** Making his sixth career start against the NL Central and his first since June 8, 2023 in Milwaukee; retired 14 of the last 16 batters he faced in that outing with 10 of those outs coming via strikeouts...Owns a 1-0 record with a 2.93 ERA (9 ER/27.2 IP) in his five previous starts against the division...Has not factored into the decision in his last four starts against NL Central opponents since picking up the win on May 10, 2022 in St. Louis.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Bradish has posted a 7-3 record with a 3.25 ERA (35 ER/97.0 IP) in 18 starts away from Oriole Park since the start of last season...Has not allowed more than three runs in 16 of those starts and has not allowed more than two runs in a road start since August 1, 2023 at Toronto.

**NIGHT OWL:** Slated to make his second night start of the season...Went 9-6 with a 3.44 ERA (41 ER/107.1 IP) across his 19 night starts in 2023.

**STATCAST STUD:** His HardHit% is ranked in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile (20.0); also ranks among MLB leaders in xSLG (98<sup>th</sup>, .253), xBA (97<sup>th</sup>, .172), Exit Velocity (94<sup>th</sup>, 85.3), xwOBA (94<sup>th</sup>, .251), and xERA (94<sup>th</sup>, 2.42), per Statcast.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Bradish is holding lefties to a .179/.258/.250 (5-for-28) slash line this season, while righties are slashing .292/.414/.417 (7-for-24) off him...Has allowed 10 extra-base hits to lefty hitters in his last 18 starts and one in his last six outings.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, earning six third-place, eight fourth-place, and five fifth-place votes; marked the highest finish by an Orioles hurler since Zack Britton finished fourth in 2016...Led the O's in nearly every pitching category last season, including ERA (2.83), strikeouts (168), opponent batting average (.215), on-base percentage (.275), OPS (.605), WHIP (1.04), and quality starts (18)...Ended the campaign ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), as well as opponent batting average (7<sup>th</sup>), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2<sup>nd</sup>), ERA (3<sup>rd</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), and winning percentage (T-8<sup>th</sup>, .632)...The 168 strikeouts were a career high and the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 batters in 2018...Logged five straight quality starts from August 6 to September 8, the longest such streak of his career...The last longer streak by an Oriole was Alex Cobb's six-gamer from July 26 to August 24, 2018...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. TEX; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in O's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, September 6, 1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, September 5, 1966 at LAD - WS G1).
