YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Red Sox in the middle game of the three-game set, 8-3, snapping their season-high five-game winning streak...Marked their first loss against the Red Sox this season after winning each of their first four games.

GAS 'EM UP: Grayson Rodriguez set a career-high with 10 strikeouts last night, becoming the fourth Oriole this season (sixth occurrence) with 10+ strikeouts in a start, joining Corbin Burnes (2x), Dean Kremer (2x), and Kyle Bradish (1x)...The six double-digit strikeout starts are Baltimore's most in a season since they also had six in 2017: Dylan Bundy (3x), Ubaldo Jiménez (2x), and Wade Miley (1G)...The last time the Orioles had more than six double-digit strikeout starts in a season was when they had eight in 2007: Erik Bedard (7x) and Jeremy Guthrie (1G)...The most in a single season since the franchise moved to Baltimore in 1954 is nine in 1998: Mike Mussina (7x) and Scott Erickson (2x).

NEED FOR SPEED: Cedric Mullins ranks eighth in Orioles history with 104 career stolen bases; next on the list is **Don Baylor** (118)...**Jorge Mateo** is tied with **Melvin Mora** for 13th in team history with 82 stolen bases as an Oriole; next on the list is **Don** Buford (85).

- The Orioles are one of five teams with multiple players with double-digit stolen bases this year, along with the Nationals, Phillies, and Royals (3), and the Reds (2).
- Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orioles are the only team in MLB with multiple players with 60+ stolen bases; Mateo has 77 and Mullins has 64.

START ME UP: On the season, O's starters have a 3.10 ERA (101 ER/293.0 IP), the third-best rotation ERA in the AL and fourth-best in MLB, behind the Phillies (2.73), Yankees (2.73), and Royals (3.08).

THE ERAS TOUR: The 0's have a 2.90 ERA (76 ER/236.0 IP) in their last 26 games since April 29, the third-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.48) and Phillies (2.85)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 169 hits while holding opponents to an MLB-low .199 batting average (169-for-849).

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson's 17 home runs are tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge for second in MLB, trailing Houston's Kyle Tucker (18)...Henderson ranks among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020; is one of six MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch (5 G), Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G), New York-AL's Aaron Judge (4 G), and Texas' Corey Seager (4 G).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 77 home runs, tied with 2016 for the third-most homers through the first 53 games of a season in 0's history behind 1987 (84) and 1996 (83); the most homers through Baltimore's first 54 games of a season is 85 by the 1996 team.

The Orioles have four players with at least eight homers, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (17), **Adley Rutschman** (10), **Anthony Santander** (9), and **Jordan Westburg** (8).

EADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season... **Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB and tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand tonight with the finale of the three-game set against the Red Sox (1-1)...The Orioles have a scheduled off day tomorrow, Thursday, May 30, before hosting the Rays for three games over the weekend...The O's are 18-11 (.621) at home, the fifth-best home winning percentage in the AL and ninth-best in MLB.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: The O's and Red Sox wrap up a three-game set in Baltimore tonight, the second of four series between the AL East rivals in 2024...The O's swept a three-game set in Boston from April 9-11, the first matchup between the teams this a three-game set in Boston from April 9-11, the first matchup between the teams this year...The Birds won each of their first four games against the Red Sox to start the season for the first time since 1967...The O's will host the Sox at Oriole Park again for a four-game set from August 15-18...The Birds and BoSox complete their regular-season series with three games at Fenway Park from September 9-11...The Orioles went 7-6 against the Red Sox last year and have gone 20-17 against them since the start of 2022.

AL BEAST: Entering the current series, the Orioles had gone 17 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, while going 12-0-5 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the Elias Sports Bureau...The Orioles need a win tonight to extend their streak to 18 consecutive sets against AL East foes without a series loss...The Orioles are 38-19 overall against division opponents since the streak began on April 24, 2023...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 349 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1,480).

ON THIS DATE: On this date in 1996, Cal Ripken, Jr. hits his 334th career home run to pass Eddie Murray on the Orioles' all-time list, one day after tying the record...The Orioles fall to Seattle, 9-8, at the Kingdome.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 12th start of the season tonight against the Red Sox...Has not allowed more than three runs in 13 consecutive outings...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 24 at Chicago-AL after allowing three runs on seven hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings; all three runs scored in the fifth inning...Has tossed six consecutive quality starts, one shy of tying his career high of seven from July 1 to August 5, 2023 (w/MIL)...Threw 92 pitches, 64 strikes.

SPILL THE TEA: Slated to make his third career start against the Red Sox tonight...Has pitched to a 1-0 record with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) in his two prior outings...Picked up the win in his last start against the BoSox earlier this season on April 9 at Fenway Park; surrendered one run on two hits (1 HR) and two walks with six strikeouts across 7.0 innings; retired his final 12 batters in a row and 19 of his last 21.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his ninth career start against the AL East and his fourth this season...Owns a lifetime 3-1 record with a 1.48 ERA (9 ER/54.2 IP) against the division; the 1.48 ERA is his lowest mark against any division... Did not factor into the decision in his last start against an AL East opponent on May 13 vs. Toronto; allowed one run on six hits and two walks with two strikeouts

EXTRA REST: When pitching on at least five days of rest this season, Burnes is 4-1 with a 2.22 ERA (12 ER/48.2 IP) in eight starts, while he is 0-1 with a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP) in three starts on normal rest...Opponents are hitting .202 (36-for-178) on extra rest compared to .258 (17-for-66) on four days rest.

EARLY STRUGGLES: After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo homer; the four first-inning home runs allowed are tied for the third-most in MLB.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 64 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 628.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank fourth in MLB (Aaron NoIa – 650.1, Zack Wheeler – 632.0, and Logan Webb – 629.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
