YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Red Sox in the middle game of the three game set, $8-3$, snapping their season-high five-game winning streak...Marked their first loss against the Red Sox this season after winning each of their first four games.

GAS 'EM UP: Grayson Rodriguez set a career-high with 10 strikeouts last night, becoming the fourth Oriole this season (sixth occurrence) with 10+ strikeouts in a start, joining Corbin Burnes (2x), Dean Kremer (2x), and Kyle Bradish (1x)...The six double-digit strikeout starts are Baltimore's most in a season since they also had six in 2017: Dylan Bundy (3x), Ubaldo Jiménez (2x), and Wade Miley (1G)...The last time the Orioles had more than six double-digit strikeout starts in a season was when they had eight in 2007: Erik Bedard (7x) and Jeremy Guthrie (1G)...The most in a single season since the franchise moved to Baltimore in 1954 is nine in 1998: Mike Mussina (7x) and Scott Erickson (2x).

NEED FOR SPEED: Cedric Mullins ranks eighth in Orioles history with 104 career stolen bases; next on the list is Don Baylor (118)...Jorge Mateo is tied with Melvin Mora for $13^{\text {th }}$ in team history with 82 stolen bases as an Oriole; next on the list is Don Buford (85).
$\theta_{\text {; }}$ The Orioles are one of five teams with multiple players with double-digit stolen bases this year, along with the Nationals, Phillies, and Royals (3), and the Reds (2).
$\theta$. Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orioles are the only team in MLB with multiple players with 60+ stolen bases; Mateo has 77 and Mullins has 64.

START ME UP: On the season, O's starters have a 3.10 ERA (101 ER/293.0 IP), the third-best rotation ERA in the AL and fourth-best in MLB, behind the Phillies (2.73), Yankees (2.73), and Royals (3.08).

He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 349 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver $(1,480)$.

ON THIS DATE: On this date in 1996, Cal Ripken, Jr. hits his $334^{\text {th }}$ career home run to pass Eddie Murray on the Orioles' all-time list, one day after tying the record...The Orioles fall to Seattle, 9-8, at the Kingdome.
