Facing Velocity

Ronald Acuña Jr.'s game-tying, three-run home run yesterday occurred on a pitch that was thrown 100.5 mph. Matt Olson also homered on a 100-mph offering on August 9 at New York-AL.

The Braves constitute one of two MLB clubs with multiple home runs on pitches 100 mph-or-harder this season (LAD, 2).

Per Sarah Langs, the 100.5-mph pitch was the third-fastest ever homered on by a Brave in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008). Eddie Rosario (101.2 mph) and Matt Olson (101.0 mph) are the only players with homers on faster pitches.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Philadelphia Phillies today conclude a four-game wraparound series with the 10th of 13 scheduled meetings...Atlanta is undefeated in series play against Philadelphia this season.

 The Braves swept the Phillies in three games here at Citizens Bank Park from April 17-19, took two-of-three at Truist Park from April 24-26, and have guaranteed at least a split of this series.

 With yesterday's victory, Atlanta secured the season series for the sixth time in the last seven seasons... Since 2020, the Braves have played to a 53-43 (.552) record against Philadelphia.

 These two teams played six games in a 10-day span from April 17-26, but hadn't seen each other since...The Braves and Phillies on Friday began a stretch wherein they will play seven games in a 10-day span to complete their season slate.

 This is Atlanta's second wraparound series of the season after dueling the New York Mets in the same fashion at Truist Park from July 3-6...The two teams split that series.

 The Braves went just 5-8 in 13 games against the Phillies last year, dropping the season set against Philadelphia for the first time since the 2019 season.

 LH Jesús Luzardo is slated to oppose the Braves for the 11th time in his major-league career...Across 10 previous starts, the Peruvian has gone 3-4 with a 3.38 ERA (20 ER/53.1 IP)...Since joining Philadelphia for the 2025 season, he hasn't beaten Atlanta (0-1) despite a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) across three starts...The 6-foot-0, 218-pounder faced the Braves seven times as a Miami Marlin from 2021-24 (3-3, 4.29 ERA).

 RH Grant Holmes has made three starts and six total appearances against Philadelphia, going 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER/18.1 IP)...In his career, the Conway, SC, native owns a 2.70 ERA (23 ER/76.2 IP) against NL East opponents and a 4.08 ERA (108 ER/238.1 IP) against nondivisional foes... Holmes covered 3.0 perfect innings in his last start on September 2 at Washington, but a rain delay (1 hour, 26 minutes) forced him to depart the game.

STARTING PITCHING: RH Tyler Mahle went 6.0 innings and allowed zero earned runs (two unearned) in a no-decision last night...Since the All-Star break, the Braves' 3.19 ERA (91 ER/256.2 IP) from their rotation leads the NL and ranks third in all of baseball.

 Only the Yankees (2.84) and Angels (3.00) have been better in that span...The Braves' 256.2 innings from its rotation since the break rank fifth.

 In 48 total games since the break, Atlanta's rotation has 14 starts without an earned run and has allowed no more than one earned run in 24 of its turns (50%)...Braves starters have allowed more than three total runs just nine times in that span.

 The Braves' 14 starts without an earned run since the All-Star break are the most by any staff in baseball.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Yesterday hit his 16th home run of the season, and has now homered in back-to-back games and in three of his last four contests...He has seven RBI stemming from home runs in his last four games.

 Yesterday's homer was his fourth off Aaron Nola; only Austin Riley (6), Juan Soto (5), Marcell Ozuna (5) and Pete Alonso (5) have more.

 The home run marked his fourth career game-tying shot in the eighth inning-or-later, and his first since May 3, 2024, when he hit one at Dodger Stadium... He also hit a pair in 2019: June 9 at Miami and August 4 versus Cincinnati.

 Acuña Jr. has homered in consecutive games for the second time this season...He went deep in four straight games from May 28-31.

 Since the beginning of play on August 28, Acuña Jr.'s .500 batting average (17-for-34) is the highest in Major League Baseball (min. 30 AB)...The stretch marks the first time he's batted .500-or-higher in a nine-game span (min. 30 AB) since June 10-20, 2025.

WIN: Atlanta rallied from a three-run deficit to beat Philadelphia yesterday, 5-4...It marked the team's second win this season when trailing by such a margin, joining its comeback from May 1 at Colorado...The team was down, 6-2, after seven frames that day before winning, 8-6...The Braves scored all eight runs in unanswered fashion that day.

 The Braves have logged two wins in back-to-back seasons when trailing by three runs after seven innings...Atlanta had two total such wins from 2021-24.

 The Braves are 36-30 in comeback scenarios this year...The team is 36-56 (.391) when trailing at any point in a game, the fifth-best record in MLB behind the Los Angeles Dodgers (.423), Milwaukee Brewers (.409), Chicago Cubs (.396) and Tampa Bay Rays (.396).

 Austin Riley drove in the decisive run in the top of yesterday's ninth inning, lining a triple to the centerfield wall...It signified his second go-ahead RBI in the ninth inning or later this season, joining his go-ahead double on July 26 at Baltimore.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: Atlanta enters today's game against Philadelphia with the best intradivision record in Major League Baseball (30-15, .667)...The Chicago White Sox rank second at 27-15 (.643).

 The Braves' .667 intradivisional winning percentage would finish as the team's fifth-best in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...The club finished with higher marks in 1993 (.705), 1999 (.686), 2023 (.673) and 2004 (.671).

 Including today's matchup, Atlanta has seven games remaining against NL East foes: five against Philadelphia and three against Miami...The Braves are 7-2 (.750) versus the Phillies and 8-2 (.800) versus the Marlins this season.

Makes his 27th start of the season and the 55th of his career this afternoon in the finale of a four-game series at Philadelphia...Atlanta is 19-7 in his 26 turns this year.

Makes his fourth career start (seventh appearance) against Philadelphia and his third meeting with the club this season...Is 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER/18.1 IP) in six career appearances against the Phillies.

Split a pair of April starts against Philadelphia, working 4.2 innings in a no-decision April 19 at Citizens Bank Park before earning the win April 24 at Truist Park, allowing three runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings...Is 1-0 with a 4.22 ERA (5 ER/10.2 IP) against them in 2026.

Owens a 2.70 ERA (23 ER/76.2 IP) in his career against National League East opponents, compared to a 4.08 mark (108 ER/238.1 IP) against the rest of the majors.

Tossed 3.0 hitless, scoreless innings in a no-decision September 2 at Washington, retiring all nine batters he faced before the game went into a 1:26 rain delay... Threw 26 pitches, 16 for strikes.

Is 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) and a 0.93 WHIP over his last three starts, holding opponents to a .184 average (9-for-49)...All nine hits he allowed in the span were singles.

Owens a 2.62 ERA (13 ER/44.2 IP) in nine day starts this season and a 4.14 mark (40 ER/87.0 IP) in 18 night outings...Opponents are batting .220 (36-for-164) against him in day games.

Went 3-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) over five starts in August, allowing one home run and holding opponents to a .235 average (23-for-98).

In 27 appearances (26 starts), is 9-5 with a 3.62 ERA (53 ER/131.2 IP) and 104 strikeouts, with eight quality starts...Is holding opponents to a .236 average (117-for-496).

Opponents are missing 39.3 percent of their swings against the pitch, the fifth-highest rate among the eight pitchers who have thrown at least 700 sliders this season.

They have also chased 40.5 percent of his sliders out of the strike zone, likewise the fifth-highest mark in that group...Opposing hitters are batting .207 (42-for-203) against the slider.

Thirty-one of his 104 strikeouts have come in the first inning, more than in any other frame...Opponents are batting .202 (19-for-94) against him in the opening inning.

Opponents are batting .200 (42-for-210) with a 2.47 ERA (16 ER/58.1 IP) against him the first time through the order this season.

The second time through, opposing hitters are batting .284 (55-for-194) with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER/48.0 IP).

Sixteen of the 19 home runs he has allowed this season have come the second time through the order or later.

Set the Braves modern-franchise record this season with 20 consecutive home starts allowing three-or-fewer runs, dating to May 12, 2025 – surpassing Hall of Famer Warren Spahn (18, 1961-62), with Kris Medlen's 16 (2010-13) next.

Tossed 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in consecutive starts for the first time in his career, August 4 vs. Miami and August 9 at New York (AL)...It was the first such run by a Braves pitcher since Hurston Waldrep (August 15-20, 2025).

Recorded his 250th career strikeout June 3 against Toronto, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings.
- 🔥

Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026 on May 23 against Washington, fanning the side in order in the first inning – the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.

Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.
