**TWINNING:** The O's defeated the Twins last night, 3-1 in 10 innings, to open the three-game set at Target Field...The Birds improved to 5-5 in extra-inning contests this year...Have won three games in a row for the first time since June 24-26.

- **Cole Irvin** tossed his first quality start in an O's uniform, working 6.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits with four strikeouts; the run scored after he left the game...Has pitched to a 1-1 record with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) and 17 strikeouts to four walks in his last five starts, in which the O's have gone 4-1.
- **Ramón Urias** drove in the winning run with an RBI double in the 10<sup>th</sup> that scored **Colton Cowser**, the automatic runner at second base to begin the extra frame.
- **Félix Bautista** earned his fourth win of the season after working a career-high-tying 2.0 innings (4x, last: 5/20/23 at TOR) with a walk and three strikeouts.

**FINISHING UP THE FIRST HALF:** With two games remaining before the All-Star Break, the O's sit at 52-35 (.598), which currently ranks as the eighth-best pre-All-Star Break winning percentage in club history (since 1954)...The only seasons in which the O's had a better winning percentage before the break were 1969 (.677, 65-31), 1966 (.667, 58-29), 1979 (.656, 59-31), 1997 (.647, 55-30), 1971 (.632, 55-32), 1964 (.632, 48-28), and 1970 (.621, 54-33).

**YOUNG GUNN:** On Thursday at New York-AL, **Gunnar Henderson** recorded his first career leadoff home run and set career bests with four hits and five RBI...He also matched career highs reaching safely four times and scoring three runs...He's the fifth O's rookie (sixth occurrence) with a leadoff home run, joining **Cedric Mullins** (2x), **Joey Rickard**, **Ryan Flaherty**, and **Matt Angle**...Became the fourth Orioles rookie with four hits and at least two homers in a game, joining **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Chris Richard**, and **Curt Blefary**...Also became the first MLB player with four hits and two home runs in the first four innings of a game since **Matt Carpenter** did so for St. Louis on July 20, 2018 at Chicago-NL...Became the youngest O's batter (22-007) to log a multi-homer performance since **Manny Machado** (20-082) on September 26, 2012 vs. Toronto, and the youngest to do so on the road since Orioles Legend and Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** (21-219) on October 1, 1977 at Boston.

- Henderson is slashing .305/.354/.590 (32-for-105) with four doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 14 runs scored, 21 RBI, seven walks, and three stolen bases in 27 games since the start of June...During that time, he ranks among AL leaders in slugging (4<sup>th</sup>), homers (T-4<sup>th</sup>), and OPS (6<sup>th</sup>, .944).
- He was voted the AL Rookie of the Month for June, his first monthly award and sixth O's rookie to earn the honor; named AL Player of the Week for the week of June 5-11, his first career weekly award.

**STAR-STUDDER:** Major League Baseball yesterday announced that **Austin Hays** has been named a starting outfielder for the AL at the 2023 All-Star Game in Seattle due to injuries to **Aaron Judge** and **Mike Trout**...He will be the first Oriole to start a Midsummer Classic since outfielder **Cedric Mullins** in 2021...Hays will be joined by relievers **Yennier Cano** and **Félix Bautista** and catcher **Adley Rutschman**...Marks the first selection for each player and the first time the Orioles have had multiple All-Stars since sending five players in 2016.

- Rutschman will also compete in the T-Mobile Home Run Derby on Monday, July 10...He will be the first O's participant since **Trey Mancini** was the runner-up in 2021...Two Orioles have won a Home Run Derby: **Miguel Tejada** in 2004 and Orioles Legend and Hall of Famer **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1991.
- **Jackson Holliday** and **Heston Kjerstad** were selected to participate in the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at T-Mobile Park in Seattle...Marks the first appearance for both at the event, which will take place tonight at 7 p.m. ET...Holliday moved up to No. 1 overall on the *MLB Pipeline* updated Top 100 prospect rankings...Kjerstad is No. 38...**Gunnar Henderson** represented the Orioles at last year's event at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles.

**AL RELIEVER OF THE MONTH:** Major League Baseball on Monday announced that **Félix Bautista** was voted the AL Reliever of the Month for June...Marks Bautista's second career Reliever of the Month Award and his second of the 2023 campaign after winning in April...He is the first O's reliever to win the award on multiple occasions as **Jim Johnson** was the only other pitcher in team history to take home the honor (May 2012).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore is in the middle of a seven-game road trip to complete the pre-All-Star Break schedule...The O's went 2-2 in the Bronx and won the first game of the three-game set in the Twin Cities against Minnesota last night...The Orioles open after the break with a six-game homestand against Miami and Los Angeles-NL from July 14-19.

- Baltimore's 26-17 (.605) road record is the best in the AL and third-best in MLB.
- The Birds went 38-43 (.469) on the road last year, 14<sup>th</sup>-best in MLB, after going a combined 114-237 (.325) away from Camden Yards from 2017-21.

**AGAINST THE TWINS:** The Orioles and Twins are meeting for the second and final time in the regular season this weekend...Baltimore dropped the first two games to Minnesota at Oriole Park last weekend but rallied for two runs in the eighth inning on Sunday in a 2-1 comeback win...The O's lost 16 straight games to the Twins from March 31, 2018 to May 31, 2021, the longest losing skid by the Orioles against Minnesota since the team moved to the Twin Cities in 1961 and the third-longest against a single opponent in club history (since 1954).

**PITCH PERFECT:** O's starting pitchers have a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) with 31 hits (5 HR), 11 total runs, 13 walks, and 35 strikeouts in seven games this month...Only five teams have a better starter ERA in July: Minnesota (0.88), San Diego (1.74), New York-NL (1.85), Seattle (1.96), and Atlanta (2.06)...Overall, Baltimore's 2.61 ERA (18 ER/62.0 IP) in July is the third-best in the AL and fifth-best in MLB.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1958:** Memorial Stadium hosts its first and only All-Star Game...The Orioles have two players on the AL squad: starting catcher **Gus Triandos** goes 1-for-2 and reliever **Billy "Digger" O'Dell** retires the last nine NL batters on 27 pitches for a save and earns the unofficial "MVP" Award as the AL wins the Midsummer Classic, 4-3...Baltimore native **Eddie Rommel**, a 13-year pitcher and 21-year umpire in the majors, calls balls and strikes.

**GENUINE DRAFT:** The 2023 MLB First-Year Player Draft is scheduled for July 9-11 during All-Star Week in Seattle...The Draft will feature 20 rounds across the three days, including the first two rounds, compensatory rounds, and competitive balance rounds on the opening night of the Draft...The Draft will begin exclusively on *MLB Network*, *ESPN* and *MLB.com* on Sunday, July 9 at 7 p.m. ET...The Draft will resume at 2 p.m. on Monday, July 10, with the first pick in Round 3, and will continue through Round 10 on *MLB.com*...Day 3 of the Draft on Tuesday, July 11, will begin at 2 p.m. featuring picks in rounds 11-20 on *MLB.com*.

- The Orioles have three picks on Day 1 of the Draft: No. 17, No. 53, and No. 63.
- Marks the first time since 2018 that the Orioles do not have one of the top five picks; that year, Baltimore selected right-handed pitcher **Grayson Rodriguez** with the No. 11 overall pick out of Central Heights High School in Nacogdoches, Texas.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 18<sup>th</sup> appearance (17<sup>th</sup> start) of the season, ninth appearance (eighth start) on the road, and fifth career appearance (third start) against the Twins this afternoon...With a strikeout today, Wells would become the third O's pitcher since 2008 with 100+ strikeouts before the All-Star Break, joining Dylan Bundy (113 K in 2018) and Jason Hammel (101 K in 2012)...Went 7-7 with a 4.25 ERA (49 ER/103.2 IP) in 23 starts for the O's in 2022...Made his first career start on April 10, 2022 at Tampa Bay...Ended the 2022 season on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder inflammation...Also spent time on the Injured List with lower left side discomfort in 2022...Originally selected by Minnesota in the 15<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State, San Bernardino before being taken by the Orioles in the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last outing on July 3 at New York-AL...Allowed two runs on five hits (2 HR) with two walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Marked his seventh quality start of the season...Threw 86 pitches, 56 strikes.

**CAREER AGAINST THE TWINS:** Making his fifth career appearance (third start) against the Twins today...Has pitched to a 2-0 record with a 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) through his first four career outings against his former organization...Earned the win in his last start against the AL Central foe on July 3, 2022 at Target Field...Surrendered one run on three hits with one walk and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Threw 90 pitches, 57 strikes.

**CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Making his 22<sup>nd</sup> career appearance (13<sup>th</sup> start) against the AL Central this afternoon...Owns a 6-4 record with a 3.42 ERA (29 ER/76.1 IP), one save, and six quality starts through his first 21 assignments against the division...Earned the win in his last start against the AL Central on June 9 vs. Kansas City...Allowed two runs on five hits with one walk and four punchouts in 6.2 innings...Left with three runners on, one of which later scored...Marked his fourth quality start of the season...Threw 92 pitches, 58 strikes.

**WATCH ME WHIP:** Wells enters play today leading MLB in WHIP (0.90), opponent on-base percentage (.236), and batting average (.188)...Has allowed 90 baserunners (67 H, 22 BB, 1 HBP) across 17 appearances (98.2 IP) this season, the fewest in MLB (min. 90.0 IP); his 67 hits surrendered this season are tied for the fewest among pitchers who have thrown at least 90.0 innings...He posted a 0.72 WHIP in April, tied for the seventh-lowest mark by an O's pitcher in a calendar month in club history (since 1954) and lowest since Scott McGregor recorded a franchise-record 0.61 WHIP in May 1978...Wells issued just three walks and allowed 18 hits in 29.0 innings through his first five appearances (four starts) in April.

**MR. CONSISTENT:** Wells has tossed 5.0-or-more innings in each of his 17 appearances (16 starts) this season, tied for the fourth-most such outings in MLB...Is the first O's pitcher to complete at least 5.0 frames in each of his first 17 games of the season since Miguel González also accomplished the feat in 17 straight assignments to begin the 2013 season...The last Oriole to do so in his first 18 starts of a season was Mike Mussina in his first 24 starts of 1994...Wells entered 2023 with 12 such performances, all in 2022.

**LOVING LEFTIES:** Opposing left-handed batters are slashing .185/.224/.324 (74-for-401) against Wells through his first 84 career games (39 starts)...He has recorded more career strikeouts against lefties (119) than hits allowed...Among pitchers with at least 400 left-handed batters faced in that span, Wells ranks first in opponent on-base percentage, third in opponent OPS (.548), and fifth in opponent batting average.

**RACKING UP STRIKEOUTS:** Wells has recorded 99 strikeouts this season, the most by an O's pitcher through his first 17 games of the season since Dylan Bundy tallied 110 punchouts in his first 17 outings in 2018...His 99 strikeouts are a career high, surpassing his season total from last season (76)...Wells struck out at least seven batters in five straight starts from May 13 to June 4, tied with Erik Bedard (2007) for the second-longest streak by an Oriole pitcher since the franchise moved to Baltimore in 1954, trailing only an eight-game streak by Connie Johnson in 1957.

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:** Made his third straight Opening Day roster...Notched career highs in wins (7), starts (23), innings (103.2), and strikeouts (76)...Won five consecutive starts from June 11 to July 3, becoming the first Oriole to win five straight starts since Chris Tillman, who also won five straight from April 27 to May 18, 2016...Wells owned a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) in those games, holding opposing batters to a .168 (17-for-101) batting average with 21 punchouts and eight walks...Finished the season with just 28 walks in 103.2 innings...Spent two different stints on the Injured List...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (lower left side discomfort) on July 28 and again on September 23, retroactive to September 30 (right shoulder inflammation)...Recorded at least one strikeout in each of his 23 starts.
