PITTSBURGH PIRATES (29-42) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (42-28)

June 14, 2025 - Wrigley Field - Chicago, IL - 1:20 CDT - Game #72/Road #34

RHP Mike Burrows (1-1, 5.00 ERA) vs. LHP Matthew Boyd (5-3, 2.89 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have split the first two games of this seven-game trip to Chicago (Thursday-Sunday) and Detroit (June 17-19)...<u>Are 14-9 over their last 23 games (since May 20 vs. Cincinnati)</u>...Went 6-3 on their recent homestand against Houston (1-2), Philadelphia (3-0) and Miami (2-1) from June 3-11...Are 17-16 since Don Kelly took over as manager on May 8...Have played in 17 one-run games since Kelly managed his first game on May 9 (they have a 9-8 record in those games).

EVTDA EVTDA: Ditteburgh has gone 4.2 in overa inning games so far this season, including Eriday's 10 inning victory. The Director

EXTRA, EXTRA: Pittsburgh has gone 4-3 in extra-inning games so far this season, including Friday's 10-inning victory...The Pirates have won back-to-back extra-inning games (also May 23 vs. Milwaukee) for the second time in 2025 (also April 6 vs. New York-AL and April 9 vs. St. Louis)...<u>Pittsburgh last won three consecutive extra-inning games from March 28-April 27, 2024 (four straight).</u>

PHAMTASTIC MILESTONE: Tommy Pham reached 10 years of Major League service today...<u>He is the second Pittsburgh player to do that this season, along with Andrew Heaney, who reached it on April 17 and proceeded to toss 7.1 scoreless innings in a 1-0 win vs. Washington that day...Andrew McCutchen (16 years, 31 days) is the only other Pirate with at least 10 years of service time.</u>

PAUL-STAR: Paul Skenes allowed four hits and two walks over his 5.0 scoreless innings on Friday in Chicago...He's allowed one or zero runs in seven consecutive starts (since May 12 at New York-NL), the longest-such streak by any Pirates pitcher since at least 1901 (he broke a tie with John Candelaria in 1982 and Jack Chesbro in 1902 with his start on Friday)...He's recorded at least five strikeouts in each of those starts, making him the first Major League pitcher to record seven straight starts of at least 5.0 innings, one or zero runs allowed and at least five strikeouts since New York (NL)'s Jacob deGrom also did so from April 23-June 11, 2021.

BULLPEN BOOST: Pittsburgh relievers combined to toss 5.0 innings in Friday's 10-inning win at Wrigley Field...<u>It was the Pirates' seventh win this season when their bullpen combined to throw at least 5.0 innings</u>

while allowing one or zero runs...Only Los Angeles-NL (13) has more-such wins this season... Pittsburgh's 1.31 ERA (34.1ip/5er) from its relievers over its last 10 games (since June 4 vs. Houston) is the third-lowest mark in MLB, behind only Chicago-NL (1.10) and Baltimore (1.17).

BUCS ON THE BASES: The Pirates stole three bases in Friday's win at Wrigley Field, including one from Oneil Cruz, whose 25 steals are tied with Tampa Bay's José Caballero for the most in all of Major League Baseball (Chicago-NL's Pete Crow-Armstrong, 22, ranks third)...Pittsburgh's 68 stolen bases this season are fourth-most in Major League Baseball, behind only Tampa Bay (97), Milwaukee (87) and Chicago-NL (85)...The Pirates have three players with at least nine stolen bases (also Ke'Bryan Hayes and Isiah Kiner-Falefa with nine apiece), tied for third-most in MLB.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar converted his 10th straight save opportunity to begin the season with a 1-2-3 10th inning on Friday...In 24 games since being recalled from Triple-A

Indianapolis on April 19, he has nine saves, a 2.38 ERA (22.2ip/6er) and 32 strikeouts...His 32 strikeouts since being recalled are tied with Houston's Josh Hader, Miami's Ronny Henriquez, Toronto's Brendon Little, Cleveland's Cade Smith and Milwaukee's Abner Uribe for third-most among all Major League relievers, behind Colorado's Jake Bird (39) and Minnesota's Griffin Jax (38).

ISIAH'S IMPACT: Isiah Kiner-Falefa's game-winning sacrifice fly in the 10th inning of Friday's 2-1 win in Chicago marked his fifth career game-winning RBI in extra innings and the first since June 9, 2024 at Oakland (with Toronto).

VERY FRIENDLY CONFINES: Pittsburgh has won each of its last three series at Wrigley Field (September 19-21, 2023; May 16-19, 2024; September 2-4, 2024)...Per OptaStats, the Pirates have won four consecutive series at Wrigley Field twice in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...They also did that in four straight from April 2011-July 2012, as well as from September 2013-September 2014.

Burnett tossed 9.0 scoreless innings as the Pirates captured their third shutout in four games. Starling Marte was 3-for-5 with a double, while Neil Walker singled and scored the game-winning run.

2025 RECORD: 1-1, 5.00 ERA

AGE: 25 (turns 26 on November 8) **SIGNED:** Thru 2025 **HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected in the 11th round of the 2018 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Burrows allowed two runs on four hits and three walks (six strikeouts) over 4.1 innings in his last start on Monday vs. Miami (no-decision in the 10-3 win).

START ME UP: Burrows earned his first win as a starter in the Major Leagues, pitching a career-high 5.1 innings while striking out six batters en route to a 3-0 win on June 4 vs. Houston...It was tied for the second-longest outing of his professional career (also July 7, 2021 for High-A Greensboro vs. Asheville), trailing only an outing of 7.0 scoreless innings for Double-A Altoona on May 26, 2022 at Harrisburg...Burrows became one of just 10 Pittsburgh rookies (11 instances) since at least 1901 to pitch 5.1-plus scoreless innings with six-plus strikeouts while issuing zero walks in an outing.

IN THE SHOW: Burrows will make his fifth start of the season with Pittsburgh today... He lost an 8-5 decision in his season debut on May 22 vs. Milwaukee, while also allowing five runs (four earned) on May 27 at Arizona (no-decision in the 9-6 victory).

DEBUT DAY: Burrows made his MLB debut in relief of Paul Skenes last season on September 28 at Yankee Stadium...In that game, he earned the win, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits, three walks, two strikeouts and one home run in 3.1 innings...He was recalled from Triple-A Indianapolis this April 24, but did not pitch before being optioned back to Triple-A after the team's April 25 victory in Los Angeles.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Burrows went 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA (32.1ip/9er) and 41 strikeouts over eight appearances (seven starts) at Triple-A Indianapolis...In his start on May 11 vs. Columbus, he struck out a career-high 11 batters in 4.2 scoreless innings...At the time of his promotion to Pittsburgh on May 21, he ranked second in the International League with a 1.02 ERA, 28 strikeouts and a 0.85 WHIP, as well as third with a .175 batting average against, in the month of May (four games/three starts).

TALK OF THE TOWN: Burrows is currently rated as the Pirates' No. 13 prospect, according to Baseball America (No. 15, according to MLB Pipeline)...Burrows has been a top-30 prospect for Pittsburgh, per Baseball America, in every preseason since 2020.

WHERE I'M FROM: Burrows is a native of Waterford, Connecticut, roughly two hours from Yankee Stadium, where he made his Major League debut last September 28.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE: Burrows represented Pittsburgh at the 2022 All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium...He pitched a scoreless fifth inning in the National League's 6-4, seven-inning win, allowing a hit and a walk (one strikeout)...He was the first Connecticut native to be selected to the game since George Springer (2013).

THE BURROWS FILE: Burrows was drafted by Pittsburgh in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford High School (Waterford, Connecticut)...He has a 3.58 ERA (291.1ip/116er) over 78 career games (73 starts) in the minor leagues... He's pitched for the Gulf Coast League/Florida Complex League Pirates (rookie), West Virginia (short-season), Low-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis over his seven professional seasons in the Pirates' organization.
