LOS ANGELES DODGERS (35-25) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-36)

June 9, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #60/HOME #31

RHP TONY GONSOLIN (2-2, 2.31 ERA) vs. LHP TYLER ANDERSON (3-5, 4.67 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won three of their last five games and have gone 5-5 in their last 10 after losing six in a row...Have gone 11-25 in their last 36 games after winning three straight games to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Were 19-40 after 59 games in 2020 (19-41 after 60).

STIFF COMPETITION: Beginning with this series against the defending World Champion Dodgers (35-25), the Pirates are scheduled to face the Central Division-leading Brewers (34-26) in Milwaukee over the weekend and the Nationals (24-33) in Washington next week...The Bucs will then oppose the Indians (32-26) and the first-place White Sox (37-23) in back-to-back series starting on June 18.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: The Pirates have posted a 7-5 record in one-run games this season, which includes a 3-2 record at PNC Park...In the 21 seasons of play at PNC Park, the Bucs have produced a 284-200 (.587) record...The Pirates have posted a winning record, or .500 record, in one-run games 16 times in the first 20 years of play here.

GOING THE EXTRA MILE: The Pirates have collected at least one extra-base hit in a season-high 15 straight games.

HAPPY 90th!: Former Bucco player, coach and manager **Bill Virdon** is celebrating his 90th birthday today...The N.L. Rookie-of-the-Year in 1955 while playing with the Cardinals, Virdon spent a majority of his 11-year playing career with the Pirates...He hit .334 in 1956 and finished second in the N.L. batting race behind Hank Aaron, was a member of the Pirates 1960 World Champion team and won a Gold Glove for his outfield play in 1962...Virdon has agreed to have his life documented in the upcoming book, "Bill Virdon: I Guess I Did That" (working title) to be published by McFarland Books in early 2022...He will be recognized by the Springfield Cardinals at their 6:35pm game tonight, as part of his 90th birthday celebration.

AN ALL-STAR SEASON: **Adam Frazier** enters today's action leading all MLB players in hits (77) and doubles (21)...He ranks third in the National League in batting (.330) and eighth in OBP (.391)...Frazier's .352 batting average since April 28 is the second-highest among all Major League players behind Nick Castellanos (.381)...In addition, he leads all N.L. second basemen in games played (57) and is second with 217 total chances behind Ozzie Albies (221).

LA STORY: This series marks Los Angeles' first visit to PNC Park since winning all three games here from May 24-26, 2019...The Pirates have lost 11 straight games to the Dodgers overall since winning for the last time on 6/5/18 at PNC Park.

STREAKY: **Adam Frazier** brings an 11-game hitting streak into tonight's action (15-for-44, .341)...He also hit safely in 10 straight games from 5/14-25 and in a career high-tying 12 consecutive games from 4/28 to 5/11...Frazier is the only player in the Majors this year with three separate hitting streaks of 10 game or more.

CASHING IN AT PNC: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** is hitting .356 (26-for-73) with four doubles, three triples, four homers and 10 RBI in his 20 career games played at PNC Park...He has hit safely in each of his last 10 games at PNC Park, dating back to September 19, going 16-for-41 (.390) with two doubles, a triple, three home runs and 1.126 OPS.

COMING THROUGH IN THE CLUTCH: **Adam Frazier** has eight hits in his last 16 at bats with runners in scoring position and is hitting .425 (17-for-40) in that department this season...He leads all National League players with the .425 average and ranks second among all players in the Majors behind Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.429).

THE COMFORTS OF HOME: **Adam Frazier** has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games at PNC Park (21-for-57, .368) and is hitting .333 (40-for-120) overall at home this season...**Clay Holmes** has posted a 0.54 ERA (16.2ip/1er) in 14 games at PNC Park this season and **Chasen Shreve** is unscored upon in his first nine games (6.0ip) here.

SLINGIN' SAMMY: Lefty **Sam Howard** has held left-handed batters to two hits in 35 at bats this season and they have gone hitless in 26 straight at bats since San Diego's Jake Cronenworth singled on 4/13...Howard has stranded all 15 of his inherited runners and held opposing batters hitless in 20 at bats with runners in scoring position.

NOTHING SHORT OF THE BEST: **Kevin Newman** is the only Major League shortstop without an error this season (min: 40 games played)...He has gone 49 consecutive games without making an error at shortstop (he made one in his final game there in 2020)...Newman holds the club record for most consecutive errorless games at shortstop in a single season, having gone 54 straight games without a miscue in 2019 from May 24 to July 23.

HOLMES HONED IN: **Clay Holmes** has made 13 straight scoreless appearances (12.1ip) and has been charged with just one earned run in his last 20 games (22.2ip)...Holmes' 0.40 ERA since 4/13 is the lowest in MLB (min: 20 games)...Holmes has also posted a 0.55 ERA (16.1ip/1er) in his 14 games at PNC Park this season.

Brian Giles, Jose Guillen, Ed Sprague and Brown all homered in the game. Francisco Cordova picked up the win, pitching 6.0 innings and giving up two runs and eight hits while striking out three.
