Matt Olson (2nd, 9), Drake Baldwin (8th, 7) and Michael Harris II (T9th, 6) each rank top-10 in Major League Baseball in lefty-lefty home runs.

Atlanta is one of two teams with multiple players in the top 10 (Athletics), and the only club with three.

Overall, the Braves' 22 lefty-lefty homers as a team are two more than any other major-league club. Atlanta's 126 lefty-lefty hits pace the National League.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and San Diego Padres today continue their four-game midweek series to round out their season slate against one another...The Padres swept the Braves in three games at Petco Park from June 22-24.

 Atlanta won yesterday, 3-2, and secured its 29th comeback victory of the season...Michael Harris II and Ozzie Albies each hit home runs for the Braves.

 Since the beginning of the 2025 season, the Braves are just 2-9 (.182) against the Padres...Both of their wins in that span have occurred here at Truist Park.

 Atlanta entered this series with just a single win over San Diego since the start of 2025...The Padres are tied with the Mets, Phillies and Giants for the most wins against the Braves since last season began.

 RH Walker Buehler has made six regular-season starts against Atlanta, pitching to a 2-2 record and a 3.75 ERA (15 ER/36.0 IP)...His last start against Atlanta took place on May 31, 2025 here at Truist Park as a member of the Boston Red Sox...Across 5.2 innings, the 6-foot-2, 185-pounder allowed five earned runs on 10 hits and two home runs... Buehler, a native of Lexington, KY, has faced the Braves in the postseason more than any other pitcher...Across five October starts, he's 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA (12 ER/23.2 IP).

 RH Reynaldo López is set to make his 10th start and 23rd appearance of the season with a 4-2 record and a 3.50 ERA (24 ER/61.2 IP)...Since rejoining Atlanta's rotation on June 26, the native of San Pedro de Macoris, DR, has allowed one run-or-fewer in three of his four turns...In three previous starts (four appearances) against San Diego, he has pitched to the tune of an 0-1 record and a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP).

WIN: After falling behind, 1-0, in the fourth inning, the Braves scored three consecutive runs yesterday to ultimately win, 3-2...It signified Atlanta's 29th comeback victory of the season...Only one MLB club has garnered more: Arizona (30).

 The team's .420 winning percentage when trailing at any point is third-best in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL and Milwaukee.

 Atlanta won despite scoring three-or-fewer runs for the 10th time this season...The team's .286 winning percentage under such circumstances ranks second in the NL and fourth in MLB behind Chicago-AL (.302), Milwaukee (.300) and Seattle (.294).

 The Braves won their fifth game this season when getting out-hit by three or more, tied for the most wins in MLB...Their .227 winning percentage when doing so leads the majors.

 The team won the game despite going hitless with runners in scoring position, its fifth time doing so this season...Only Milwaukee has won more such games in the NL.

MEDEROS MANIA: Víctor Mederos earned his first career save last night after tossing 2.1 scoreless innings to finish the game...Mederos and Hall of Famer Walter Johnson (1913) are the only players in modern MLB history to amass the following statistics through their first five games of the season: 9.0 innings pitched, one-or-fewer runs allowed, one save*, two RBI.

 *Saves were first introduced during the 1969 season, but have since been credited retroactively in applicable situations.

 In his first five appearances with the Braves, Mederos has pitched to a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) with seven strikeouts...Atlanta is 4-1 when he appears in a game.

 Mederos became the first Brave since 2006 to pitch at least 9.0 innings and allow one-or-fewer runs in his first five games with the franchise...Chuck James was the last to do so spanning the 2005-06 seasons.

 Among pitchers with at least 9.0 innings pitched this season, Mederos' 0.96 ERA is fifth-best in Major League Baseball behind Matt Brash (SEA, 0.54), Robert Suarez (0.56), Angel Chivilli (NYY, 0.87) and Mason Miller (SD, 0.89).

HOMERS: The Braves have belted multiple home runs in each of their last four games, tied for their longest such streak of the season...They also did so from May 1-4 in games against Colorado and Seattle.

 The club hasn't hit multiple homers in more than four straight games since September 17-24, 2024, when it did so in seven straight games.

 The Braves have hit 28 home runs in a 14-game span, dating to July 3...Before this stretch, they hadn't posted such a span since July 31-August 14, 2024, when they hit 30 in 14 games...They've also hit 11 home runs in a four-game span for the third time this season...They also did so from May 1-4 and July 3-6.

 Atlanta's 29 home runs in July have long surpassed its total from the entire month of June (19)...The team's 29 longballs this month are second-most in the majors behind Washington (33)...The Braves' 19 homers last month ranked last in the major leagues.

OZZIE ALBIES: Last night logged half of Atlanta's hits and its only multi-hit game with a 2-for-4 performance...His sixth-inning, solo home run off Wandy Peralta proved to be the difference in a 3-2 win...Peralta entered the contest with a 36.0-inning homerless streak.

 Albies has belted eight home runs off of left-handed pitchers, tied for the eighth most in the National League...His strikeout rate of 6.6% against lefties is the lowest among MLB qualifiers...He's one of five qualifiers to be below 10% in that regard.

 Both of his hits yesterday came on pitches outside of the strike zone...His 33 out-of-zone knocks this season are the third most in baseball behind Ernie Clement (TOR, 39) and Alec Burleson (STL, 35)...Albies registered his fourth game this year with multiple hits on balls.

Makes his 10th start of the season and the 133rd of his career, in the second game of a four-game series against San Diego at Truist Park...Atlanta is 6-3 in his nine turns.
- 🔥

Makes his fourth career start against the Padres and his first appearance against the club since March 28, 2025...Is 0-1 with a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP) in four career appearances (three starts) vs. San Diego.
- 🔥

That March 28, 2025 outing against San Diego was his only appearance of the 2025 season...He underwent season-ending right shoulder surgery and did not pitch again that year.
- 🔥

Atlanta has lost all three games he has started against them.
- 🔥

Has turned in a quality start in two of his three career starts against San Diego, going 6.1 innings and allowing two runs on May 20, 2024, and 6.0 innings and allowing three runs on July 13, 2024.
- 🔥

Carries a 4-2 record and a 3.50 ERA (24 ER/61.2 IP) through 22 appearances (nine starts)...Has posted a 54-to-25 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.26 WHIP this season.
- 🔥

Returned to the rotation June 26 at San Francisco after 13 consecutive relief appearances from April 29 through June 21...Worked to a 3.27 ERA (8 ER/22.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts across those 13 outings.
- 🔥

Is 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18.0 IP) in four starts since rejoining the rotation... Allowed one earned run in each of the first three of those turns, a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), before surrendering four July 11 at St. Louis.

Opponents are batting .333 (13-for-39) against him in the first inning, where he has been charged with eight of his 24 earned runs...From the second inning on, they are hitting .207 (40-for-193) with a 2.73 ERA (16 ER/52.2 IP).
- 🔥

Owens a 2.54 ERA (57 ER/202.1 IP) since the start of the 2024 season, the sixth-lowest mark among 148 major league pitchers with at least 35 starts over that span... Chris Sale ranks second at 2.36, giving Atlanta two of the top six.
- 🔥

Has held opponents to a .060 average (4-for-67) on pitches out of the strike zone and .176 (22-for-125) in two-strike counts.
- 🔥

Batters are hitting .125 (4-for-32) against his curveball with five strikeouts...They have hit .231 (15-for-65) against his slider and .252 (33-for-131) against his four-seam fastball.
- 🔥

Has recorded a 3.00 ERA (12 ER/36.0 IP) in 12 appearances at Truist Park this season and has not lost at home, going 3-0.
- 🔥

Owens a 1.94 ERA (22 ER/102.0 IP) in 18 home starts since joining Atlanta in 2024.

Took the loss July 11 at St. Louis, allowing four runs on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings in a 4-1 defeat at Busch Stadium...Threw 57 of 85 pitches for strikes and posted a 9-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio.

Three of the four runs scored in the first inning on Lars Nootbaar's two-out, three-run home run...Retired 12 of the final 14 batters he faced.

Received a no-decision July 6 against New York (NL), allowing one run on three hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts in a 7-6 loss in 10 innings.
- 🔥

Earned the win July 1 against St. Louis, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts in a 5-1 victory...Tossed 4.0 hitless innings after the first, and the win was his first in a starting assignment since April 2 at Arizona.

Moved to the bullpen in late April after five starts to open the season and made 13 relief appearances before returning to the rotation.

Has pitched for five organizations - Washington, Chicago (AL), Cleveland, Los Angeles (AL) and Atlanta - beginning his career in the rotation before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021...Signed by the Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

🔥

In his first season with Atlanta in 2024, earned his first career All-Star selection, going 8-5 with a 1.99 ERA (30 ER/135.2 IP) over 26 games (25 starts)...His 1.99 ERA was the lowest in the majors among pitchers with at least 25 starts.

🔥

His 2.00 ERA as a starter was the lowest by a pitcher in his first stint with the franchise in the Live Ball era (min. 25 starts) and the fourth-lowest in baseball since 1920 for a pitcher with 25-or-more starts to open a stint with a new team after debuting elsewhere, trailing only Hall-of-Famer Gaylord Perry (Cleveland, 1972), Roger Clemens (Toronto, 1997) and Kevin Brown (Florida, 1996).

🔥

His 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP) through 13 starts was the lowest by a Brave over that span since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine (1.57) in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are the only Atlanta-era (since 1966) starters with lower ERAs through 13 starts.

🔥

Made just one start in 2025, April 1 at San Diego, before undergoing arthroscopic right shoulder surgery on April 8 that ended his season.

🔥

Made his major league debut July 19, 2016 with Washington, then was traded to the White Sox that December in the four-player Adam Eaton deal (alongside Lucas Giolito and Dane Dunning)...Split 2023 among Chicago (AL), Los Angeles (AL) and Cleveland - dealt to the Angels on July 26 and claimed off waivers by the Guardians on August 31 - before signing with Atlanta that November.
