THE PIRATES:...had a 5 -0 lead after four innings before losing 9-5 in 10 innings Wednesday night...Have played in 12 games decided by one or two runs in their last 18 contests... Have also played in 18 one-run games overall, which are the second-most in MLB (the Cubs lead the way with 19)...Are tied with the Phillies and Cubs for the most wins (10) in one-run games in all of MLB...Have gone 19-4 when scoring at least four runs in a game...Have gone 5-2 in extra innings; the second-most wins in MLB behind the Guardians (six).

LAST TIME OUT: Paul Skenes struck out each of the first seven batters he faced
while not allowing a hit in 6.0 shutout innings for his first big league win Friday afternoon at Wrigley Field...Skenes became the first pitcher in MLB history to have a start where he struck out the first seven batters or more and finished with zero hits allowed...He also became the third rookie all-time to record seven strikeouts to start a game, joining Jacob deGrom on September 15, 2014 (eight strikeouts in his 21st career game) and Jim Deshaies on September 23, 1986 (eight strikeouts in his 28th career game).

 on the road from April 1-4, split a four-game series at Philadelphia from April 11-14 and were swept in three games at Citi Field against the Mets from April 15-17.DIALING LONG DISTANCE: The Pirates have hit 19 home runs since May 11, which are the second-most in all of MLB behind the Yankees (21)...Connor Joe and Andrew McCutchen lead the team with three apiece during that time.

THE 700 CLUB: Bryan Reynolds recorded the 700th hit of his big league career with his single in the first inning last night before adding the second grand slam of his career in the fourth inning...Since the beginning of the 2019 season, Reynolds' 701 hits are the second-most in MLB among switch hitters behind Jose Ramirez (725).

YOU'VE BEEN GRAND SLAMMING: Bryan Reynolds hit the second grand slam of his career on Wednesday, which was also the third by the Pirates this season...Pittsburgh's three grand slams are tied with the Dodgers for the most in all of MLB...The Pirates are hitting 304 with the bases loaded this season, which is the seventh-highest average in all of MLB (the Royals lead the way with a 433 average with the sacks packed).

AGAINST LEFTIES: The Pirates will be opposed by a starting lefthander for the 19th time this season this afternoon (the Pirates are 10-8 in games started by lefties this year)...The Pirates are tied for the second-most home runs (18) in all of MLB against southpaws along with the
