PADDACK GOT THAT DOG IN HIM: The Twins shut out the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 7-0, recording their first shutout of the season, first night game win and third win at Target Field of 2024...Chris Paddack (1-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with six hits allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts — one short of his career high...it marked Paddack's first big league win as a starter since May 2, 2022 at Baltimore... the offense tied their season high with 11 hits, three coming from Edouard Julien, who hit a double and his team-leading fifth home run...Max Kepler returned from the IL and went 2-for-4 with a double and three RBI.
