PERDOMO’S HEART & HUSTLE AWARD PRESENTATION TOMORROW:

D-backs’ 2025 Heart & Hustle Award winner, Geraldo Perdomo, in partnership with the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLB-PAA), will be recognized on field pregame tomorrow., Aug. 9...the annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

- At the conclusion of the season, all alumni and fans will vote to select the final winner from the 30 team winners, which will be announced in mid-November on MLB Network...no D-back has ever won the overall award.

LAST GAME:

- Anthony DeSclafani, in his third D-back start, tossed 4.1 scoreless innings with 3 hits, 0 walks and 4 strikeouts (71 pitches)...was his first scoreless start since May 2, 2023 with the Giants @ Astros (0 ER in 8.0 IP).
- Corbin Carroll hit his 23rd homer (solo in first inning), his furthest of the season (443 ft.) and is 2 shy of tying his career high (25 HR in 2023)...has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 games @ Chase Field and recorded a RBI in 5 of his 6 games in August.
- Geraldo Perdomo recorded his 400th career hit in the first inning (1B off N. Cortes)...reached base safely (1 H) in his eighth straight game and 19th straight home game.
- Alek Thomas has recorded a RBI in 4 of his last 5 games.
- Tyler Locklear has reached base safely in 5 of his 6 games.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 13 of his last 15 home games.

SNAKE BITES:

Geraldo Perdomo’s 19-game on-base streak at home (since June 27) is the longest active home streak in the Majors, ahead of Jorge Polanco/SEA (15)...he looks to become the only player in the Majors within this season with multiple 20+–game home on-base streaks (also: 21 from March 27-May 9)...his career long home on-base streak is 23 games (Sept. 28, 2024-May 9, 2025).

- In their last 5 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 18 earned runs in 21.0 innings (7.71 ERA) while hitting .309 (25-for-81)/.416 OBP/.543 SLG/.959 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers and 14 walks...their .416 OBP and 14 walks vs. opposing starters since Aug. 2 rank best among NL teams.
- Against lefty starting pitchers, the D-backs’ 17.7% strike-out rate ranks lowest in the NL while their 1.97 K/BB ratio ranks second in the NL, behind the Padres (1.87).
- Geraldo Perdomo’s 43 hits vs. lefties rank tied for third in MLB (also: 2 others), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (45) and Ernie Clement/TOR (45).

TRENDING BATS:

Over his last 8 games (since July 29), Geraldo Perdomo is hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.378 OBP/.424 SLG/.802 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 6 walks...has struck out 1 time in his last 35 PA.

- Alek Thomas, over his last 7 games (since July 29), is hitting .409 (9-for-22)/.462 OBP/.682 SLG/1.143 OPS with 2 homers, 4 RBI and 2 walks...his .409 AVG ranks 10th in MLB.

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST:

The D-backs are 16-14 (.533) vs. NL West opponents this season, tied for the second most interdivision wins with the Padres, behind the Dodgers (19).

- In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.815), SLG (.485) with the most homers (54), extra-base hits (115), runs (155) and stolen bases (20).
- Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 25 of his 29 games vs. NL West, batting .324 (35-for-108)/.395 OBP/.519 SLG/.914 OPS with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 14 walks (15 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 10 straight games vs. NL West (2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 8 BB) and in 25 of his 29 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .283/.392/.632/1.024 with 7 doubles, 10 homers, 20 RBI, 17 walks, 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- Both Marte and Perdomo have reached base safely 49 times, which ranks tied for second in most times on base in head-to-head play, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (1st, 51).

LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS:

Corbin Carroll’s 5 leadoff triples tie for the most by any player in a season since the expansion era (1961), with Nyjer Morgan/WSH (2010), Curtis Granderson/DET (2006), Marquis Grissom/ATL (1996), Darren Lewis/SF (1994), Willie Wilson/KC (1985), Alfredo Griffin/TOR (1980), Omar Moreno/PIT (1980), Ralph Garr/ATL (1975) and Don Kessinger/CHC (1975).

- Carroll’s 5 leadoff homers are tied for fifth with C.J. Abrams/WSH.
- Since 1961, Carroll is the only player to collect 5+ leadoff triples and 5+ leadoff homers within their first 100 games of a season...he is 1 of 3 players all-time to do so in an entire season:

HITTIN’ AT HOME:

Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 19 straight home games (since June 27)...is batting .414 (29-for-70)/.512 OBP/.543 SLG/1.055 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 13 RBI, 12 walks (6 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 3 stolen bases.

- Corbin Carroll, has reached safely in 7 of his last 8 home games (since July 19), batting .333 (11-for-33)/.343 OBP/.727 SLG/1.070 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 2 stolen bases.

ON-BASE MACHINE:

Geraldo Perdomo’s 59 times on base since July 1 rank second in the Majors, behind Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (62) and Nick Kurtz/ATH (59).

- Has reached base in 28 of his 31 games since July 1, hitting .321 (36-for-112)/.434 OBP/.446 SLG/.880 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 20 walks (11 K).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (4-7, 5.53)

- Won his last start on Aug. 3 @ Athletics, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits over 5.0 innings.
- Earned the win in his last start vs. Rockies on Sept. 18, 2024, allowing 2 runs over 6.1 innings on 5 hits with 1 walk and 11 strikeouts.

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 24th start (12th home).

- Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs thru the first 5.0 innings in 4 of his last 7 home starts (team is 3-1 in those starts).
- The D-backs have won 7 of his last 11 starts vs. Rockies dating back to October 2, 2021...he has 6 quality starts and is 7-0 with a 4.14 ERA (29 ER in 63.0 IP) and 71 strikeouts during that span.
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 5 of his last 6 starts (team is 3-2).
- The D-backs have won in each of his 8 quality starts in 2025.
- His 7 starts of 100+ pitches rank third in his career, behind 2022 (9), 2023 (8) and 2021 (8).
- Is 1 of 16 active starting pitchers with 60+ wins since 2019.
- His 966 strikeouts as a D-back are fourth in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065)and Robbie Ray (998).

LAST START: Earned the win on Aug. 2 @ Athletics (2 ER in 6.0 IP, 0 BB, 3 K).

- Was his first win and quality start since July 7 @ Padres.

VS. ROCKIES: 18th career start, 10th @ Chase Field.

- Has gone 1-0 in 2 starts in 2025 (11.70 ERA)...the D-backs have scored 10+ runs in each of the 2 starts.
- In his last 7 starts, is 5-0 with a 4.62 ERA (20 ER in 39.0 IP), 8 walks and 47 strikeouts...in his 5 starts prior to this season, had a 2.17 ERA (7 ER in 29.0 IP).
- Had a 4-game win streak from Aug. 13, 2022-March 28, 2024 (1.50 ERA).
- Is 5-1 with a 3.24 ERA in 9 starts (5 quality) @ Chase Field and 8-1 with a 3.53 ERA in 17 career starts (10 quality).

VS. NL WEST: Owns a 3-game win streak, going 3-0 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER in 18.0 IP), 2 walks and 24 strikeouts.

- In 6 starts in 2025, has gone 3-1 (team is 4-2) with a 5.66 ERA (22 ER in 35.0 IP) and 40 strikeouts.
- In his last 3 seasons, from 2022-24, vs. NL West, in 30 starts, was 13-4 with a 3.37 ERA (69 R-66 ER in 176.1 IP), an opponent .212 AVG (137-for-645)/.630 OPS, 50 walks and 201 strikeouts.

AT HOME: Over 3 starts from April 13-May 6 (team went 2-1), went 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (6 ER in 18.0 IP), opponent .175 AVG (11-for-63) /.532 OPS, 8 walks and 17 strikeouts.

AT HOME VS. NL WEST: Won his last start on July 1 vs. Giants (1 ER in 7.0 IP, 10 K).

- In 2023-24, in 8 starts, went 7-0 with a 2.45 ERA (13 ER in 47.2 IP).
- In 18 home starts vs. NL West since 2022 (team is 13-5), is 9-2 with a 3.51 ERA (41 ER in 105.0 IP), opponent .230 AVG (89-for-387)/.693 OPS, 33 walks and 115 strikeouts.

MAKING TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Throwing his knuckle curve 24.6% of the time...42.5 whiff rate is currently his second-highest whiff rate on any pitch in his career, behind his changeup in 2020 (43.8 whiff).

- Dating back to May 1, 2021, holding the Rockies to a .095 AVG/.298 OPS off his curveball...in his last 7 home games, Colorado is just 1-for-27 (.037).

INNING BREAKDOWN: In Inning 4 over his first 12 starts, had a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .100 AVG (4-for-40)/.413 OPS, 1 walk and 11 strikeouts.

- In Inning 5 over his last 14 starts, has a 2.57 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 14.0 IP), an opponent .204 AVG (11-for-54)/.579 OPS with 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- In Inning 5 over his first 8 starts, had an opponent .174 AVG (4-for-28)/.457 OPS with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

LIGHT WHEN LOADED: Holding batters to a .125 AVG (1-for-8) with 2 strikeouts with the bases loaded.

1,000-STRIKEOUT CLUB: Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on July 21 vs. Astros in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews).

- Second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 1,009 strikeouts are 10th...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,276), Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241) and Luis Castillo/SEA (1,183)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is seventh.
